1. It is the responsibility of the ST IO when arrangements are made by this office in writing to the Italian War Ministry for the despatch of Supplies to SICILY, SARDINIA or CORSICA (copy of which is forwarded to the IO concerned) to:-

- a. Contact the local Head of Italian Commissariat to ensure that the supplies are put aside at the Italian Depot concerned, ready for calling forward for shipment.
- b. Keep in touch with Allied Nov Shipping Branch to obtain information of arrival of the vessel in order that Italian Commissariat can be informed when the vessel docks and is ready for loading.
- c. Assist the Italian Commissariat with regard to obtaining Road Transport to move the supplies from Depot to ship's side.
- d. Ensure that the supplies and quantities as laid down are actually loaded.
- e. Ensure that necessary shipping documents (e.g. Shipping Advice & Delivery Notes (AF.W.5175)) are prepared and handed over in accordance with requirements of Allied Port authorities. One copy of such documents to be forwarded to HQ, MMIA, ("ST") for retention.
- f. Inform this office and MMIA IO at receiving Island, by signal of the

c. Assist the Italian Commissariat with regard to obtaining Road Transport to move the supplies from Depot to ship's side.

d. Ensure that the supplies and quantities as laid down are actually loaded.

e. Ensure that necessary shipping documents (e.g. Shipping Advice & Delivery Notes (AP. 11.5175)) are prepared and handed over in accordance with requirements of Allied Port authorities. One copy of such documents to be forwarded to HQ, MHA, ("GT") for retention.

f. Inform this office and MHA LG at receiving Island, by signal of the departure of the ship; the commodities and amounts loaded.

2. Any difficulties should be communicated to this office by the quickest means possible.

ORDERS FOR D.A.D.S. SUPERVISORY L.O. IN SECTIONS.

1. The D.DST Supervisory L.O. in Section will be responsible for the Inspection and guidance of Italian Army, Navy and Air Force supply organisation and all "ST" associated Allied advisory personnel in the following phases:-

- (a) Port Reception of Supplies.
- (b) Bulk Depots, Distribution Supply Depots and Petrol Depots.
- (c) Italian Unit Receiving and Interior economy, Supply and Distribution.

2. In regard to Port Reception the D.DST Supervisory L.O. will ensure that a satisfactory organisation operates to carry out the following functions:-

- (a) That the Allied Port Detachment L.O. obtains advance information of the arrival of Ships including details as per Ships Manifest, that he informs the local Head of Italian Carabinieri and communicates same to "ST" HQ, MSL.
- (b) Identification and physical reception of supplies.
- (c) Safe transit and storage of supplies into Italian Bulk Depots.
- (d) Salvage and repair of broken cases carried out as and when necessary.
- (e) Creation of an agreed out-turn report of supplies received by Italian Port Detachment from each ship. He will ensure that such statement is made out in triplicate and signed by the Italian Officer in charge and countersigned by the Allied Officer. He will forward original to Italian War Ministry, copy to MSL, HQ.

(f) That the duties of the Italian Port Detachment are carried out in accordance with SU/4/2 dated 17th Feb 1944 - copy attached.

(g) He will ensure that handling of supplies from Port to Italian depot is carried out economically both in labour and in transport.

3. In regard to Bulk Depots and supply installations, the D.DST Supervisory L.O. is responsible for inspecting and guiding the Italian Army on all aspects of Depot procedure, and specifically:-

- (a) Premises.
- (b) Weighing Facilities
- (c) Prompt off-loading and on-loading.

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(e) Creation of an agreed out-turn report of supplies received by Italian port Detachment from each ship. He will ensure that such statement is made out in triplicate and signed by the Italian Officer in charge and countersigned by the Allied Officer. He will forward original to Italian War Ministry, copy to MEL, HQ.

(f) That the duties of the Italian Port Detachment are carried out in accordance with GE/1/2 dated 17th Dec 1944 - copy attached.

(2) He will ensure that handling of supplies from port to Italian depot is carried out satisfactorily both in a boat or in transport.

3. In regard to Bulk Depots and supply installations, the DADST Supervisory L.O. is responsible for inspecting and running the Italian Army on all aspects of Depot procedure, and specifically:-

- (a) Inspection.
- (b) Receiving Facilities
- (c) Receipt off-loading and on-loading.
- (d) Layout
- (e) Handling and Stacking.
- (f) Salvage and Repair.
- (g) Local procurement intake.
- (h) Accounting of Supplies.
- (i) Bills for issues.
- (j) Consolidated accounts.
- (k) Stocktaking and Stock Reports.
- (l) Observations on Warranty, Expiry Dates.

4. In the case of Uncoordinated Supply Depots particularly, the DADST Supervisory L.O. is responsible for ensuring that issues procedure is watertight, and that Supplies are in fact being issued to Italian units, in time and in kind, then their actual strength warrants, on the basis of the approved scale.

5. In regard to the Italian Units' numbers, the DADST Supervisory L.O. is responsible for ensuring that the best possible use is being made of supplies provided by the Allies as to the manner of presentation, avoidance of waste, etc. He will also see that the Italian Soldier does in fact receive his full ration as far as is possible.

6. The DADST Supervisory L.O. is responsible to the Senior Army Sub Com L.O. of the Area for all matters, and in the A.M.E.F., Army Sub Com's representative in the Sector.

7. The established principles governing the relations between MEA and the Italian Army will at all times be observed by DAFST Supervisory L.Os.
8. The DAFST Supervisory L.O. will during every month visit in his Sector:-
 - (a) All Italian Bulk Depots once a week.
 - (b) All Italian Distribution Supply Depots once a week.
 - (c) All Italian Petrol Depots three times a month.
 - (d) Not less than six Italian units, choosing different ones each month, with a view to checking Morning and Interior economy Supply & Distribution.

An inspection Report after each Depot or Unit visited will be submitted to A.D.S.C., Army Sub Comm, as soon as after inspection is made.

9. The DAFST Supervisory L.O. will be called upon to take physical stock of certain commodities in Depots at a certain time, whenever he will be required to check stocks against Railway claims and reconcile it with issue and receipt vouchers.

Supplies are now arriving in Allied Ships for the maintenance of the Italian Armed Forces on the mainland of Italy.

The procedure for the accounting for these supplies (both rations and clothing, and other equipment) will be as follows:-

1. Each Port, Bari, BRINDISI, NAPLES, TARANTO, will have an Italian Port Detachment consisting of 2 Italian Officers, 3 Warrant Officers and 12 Other Rates.
2. Their duties will be to liaise with Allied Movements Shipping so as to obtain advance information of the arrival of ships loaded with Italian supplies, and obtain from Allied Movements the cargo manifests of such ships.
3. They will be responsible for seeing that all supplies marked 'ITI' are handed over to the Italian Port Detachment.
4. All such such supplies will be checked off ship and into the transport provided for their movement to Italian Ports. They will ensure all such transport is guarded and escorted by Italian personnel.
5. A record will be kept of all supplies as they are off-loaded from the ship.
6. All checkers reports will be consolidated daily on a statement by the Italian Officer in charge, and all reports will be attached to this consolidated statement.

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2. Their duties will be to liaise with Allied Movement Shipping so as to obtain advance information of the arrival of ships loaded with Italian supplies, and obtain from Allied Movements the cargo manifests of such ships.
3. They will be responsible for seeing that all supplies marked 'ITT' are loaded over to the Italian Port Detachment.
4. All such supplies will be craned off ship and into the transport provided for their movement to Italian Depots. They will ensure all such transport is guarded and escorted by Italian personnel.
5. A record will be kept of all supplies as they are off-loaded from the ship.
6. All checkmate reports will be consolidated daily on a statement by the Italian Officer in charge, and all reports will be attached to this consolidated statement.
7. At the completion of off-loading of each ship a consolidated statement of all supplies off-loaded will be forwarded to the Italian War Ministry, a copy to MMIA.
8. To assist the Italian Port Detachment in the duties of above an Allied Detachment will be available consisting of 1 Officer, 2 NCO's, 1 Clerk. They will settle any disputes or queries that may arise, and certify with the Italian Port Detachment the actual amounts off-loaded from each ship.
9. The consolidated statement at completion of off-loading will be signed by the Italian Officer in charge, and countersigned by the Allied Officer.
10. MMIA will at the completion of the off-loading of each shipment forward to Italian War Ministry Army Form G.1033 (Issue and Receipt Voucher) in triplicate for signature of receipt. Original and duplicate copy will be returned to MMIA, third copy will be retained by Italian War Ministry.
11. Will you please form the Italian Port Detachments as outlined above and issue them the necessary instructions.
