Esso è stato causato dal fatto che gli autocarri che trasportavano gli uomini del secondo turno non poterono transitare sul ponte girevole perché lo stesso era stato eccezionalmente aperto fuori dell'orario normale. Gli autocarri dovettero così attendere per un'ora prima di poter transitare.

Ciò non si è più ripetuto e non si ripeterà più, in quanto ne dispetto che gli uomini che hanno terminato il turno di lavoro, rimangono sul posto finché non vengono rilevati dagli uomini del turno successivo.

Mi sono recato più volte sia sul luogo di scarico del piroscampo, sia al Deposito Centrale Viventi, al quale già da oltre 10 giorni stò inviando da 180 a 210 uomini al giorno, men- tre cerco con tutti i mezzi a disposizione di far fronte alle richieste che vengono fatte dalle autorità inglesi.

Giornalmente ho numerosi contatti con il Ten. GRAMFORD e con il Ten. TRILAND, entrambi della M.M.I.A. che sono sul luogo, e gli stessi mi hanno dichiarato che sono soddisfatti del come procede il lavoro e degli aiuti che sollecitamente ho dato perché il piroscampo sia scaricato al più presto possibile.

Continuerò ad esercitare speciale sorveglianza fino a che siano ultimata le operazioni di scarico e di sistemazione delle merci.

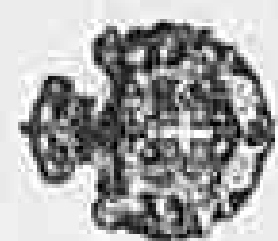

(c) It is agreed that Italians give receipts for stores as actually received only.

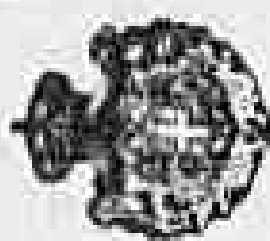

4. When these stocks are warehoused, the issues to the Italian Forces from British B.S.D's will cease, except that, in the Combat zones, forward Italian Units will be maintained from British Depots.

5. Arrangements are being made for all such issues as at para 4 above to be reported to AFHQ in order that compensating amounts may be drawn from Italian Depots for transfer to British B.S.D's.

6. The date on which this change of maintenance is to take place, will have to be mutually agreed, but it is considered that it could operate not later than seven days after the berthing of the first Vessel.
