1. It has been brought to our attention by Allied authorities that the Italian Military at Bari and Taranto have placed, and received tonnage bids for shipment of fruit from Sicily and Calabria for use of the Italian Military.
2. The bids mentioned seem to be in excess of the actual needs of the Italian Military in the areas where the fruit is delivered. Also, it has been reported, but not as yet confirmed, that the Italian Military has permitted civilian agencies to use the tonnage allocated for Italian Military purposes to transport fruit from Sicily and Calabria for civilian use.
3. You will please investigate this matter immediately, informing us as to the quantity of fruit which has been transported from Sicily and Calabria from the period 1 January 1945 through 23 February 1945. Also, determine if all items were used by the Italian Military, or if some of the items so transported were diverted to the civilian market. We wish to inform you that we are also having this matter investigated by officers of this Headquarters.
4. Please acknowledge receipt of this letter, informing us of an approximate date on which we may expect to receive the report covering your investigation.
