Only bona fide members of the present Italian Army are entitled to subsistence from Italian sources. Therefore, the Italian Military will be unable to issue subsistence to these 14 officers after October 15, 1944 as requested in your letter.
3. If we can be of any assistance to you concerning this matter, please be free to call on us.

To : See distribution below:

1. The 541st and 543rd Service Companies with a strength of 117 and 123 respectively are ~~to~~ ^{be} ~~discontinued~~ ^{discontinued}. These Companies are not carried on our strength return as assigned to AGC. Col Ferron of AGC told us this morning that AGC did not want these Companies any longer.

2. I called Major Friedberg of AAJ and after a conference with Lt Col MacQueen, Major Friedberg telephoned me that these two Companies are being taken from AGC and assigned to PMS as reinforcements, and when PMS picks them up, 541 and 543 Service Companies will cease to exist. This is being confirmed by signal.

3. I called Colonel Leaf at ASA this afternoon and Col. Leaf said that they would arrange to pick these men up and incorporate them into the 21st Division. I do not know exactly when this will be done, but Col. Leaf said that he would get it done as quickly as possible. These Companies have been drawing rations from the Rome Depot and I understand that they have several days' rations now on hand, which will probably suffice until they are picked up by PMS.

4. The following action is required:

a) The Minister for War is to be notified that the two Companies are no longer under AGC Command and are assigned to PMS, and when collected by PMS, the personnel will be incorporated into the 21st Division, and the two Companies as such will cease to exist.

b) Drop 541 and 543 off our records.

c) Authority for rations from Rome Depot to cease when the two Companies are picked up by PMS.

1. Ref this Headquarters RAAC/9/47/G3(Br) of 6 Aug para 4 (a) and (b), and RAAC/9/71/G3(Br) dated 31 Aug para 6 on the supplies to Italian Troops detailed for Guards Duties within Rome Area.

2. The a/m paras are hereby rescinded, and the policy as outlined below will become effective immediately.

3. (a) All supplies for Italian Troops will now be provided by the Italian Supplies Depot (equivalent to British DID) now located off Via CAVOUR (7466).

(b) The policy of British DIDs supplying the recently termed "Basic" Ration element is cancelled. Rations will no longer be drawn from British sources.

(c) Italian Coys of Granatieri will be responsible for drawing own rations in bulk and the distribution to detachments on duty at VPs.

(d) Officer Commanding 1 Battaglione Speciale Granatieri di Sardegna will be required to submit application, together with Coy strengths to the Minister for War (Italian) in order that requisite supplies may be released through MMIA.

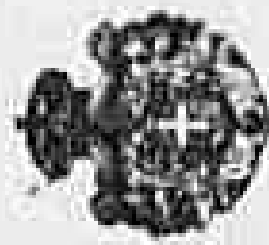

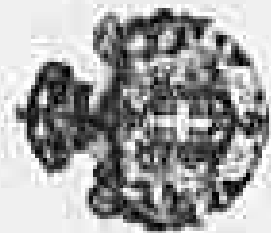

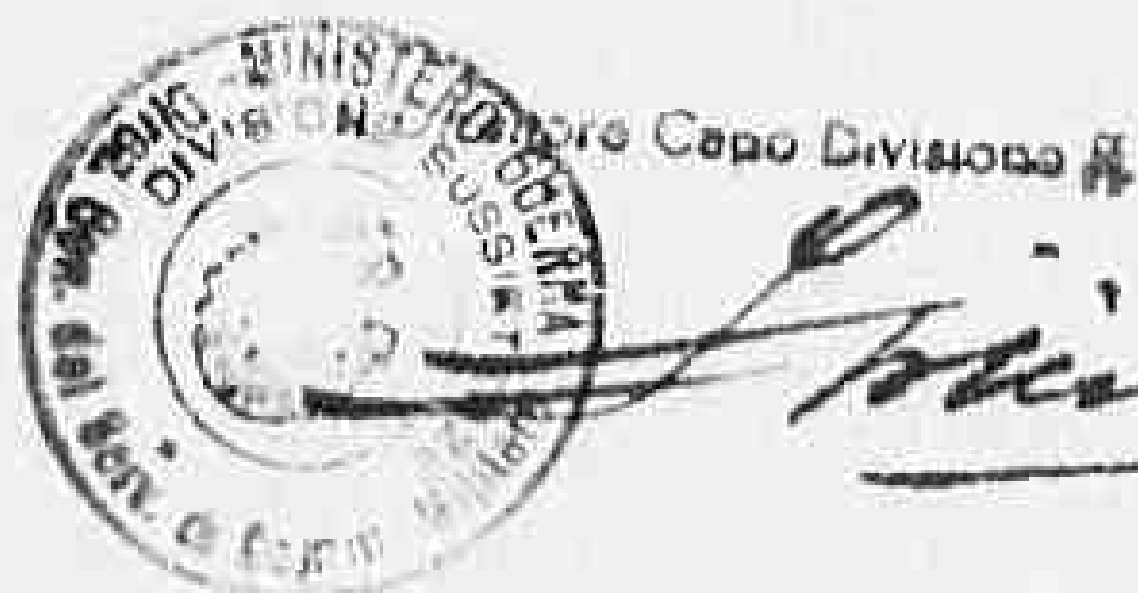
