2. As already brought to your notice it was the original intention for this ship to be brought to BARI where the bulk of the cargo was required. She was diverted to TARANTO, where the supplies were stated to be required, at the specific request of a representative speaking on your behalf at the Nov. Hq. A.A.I. Diversion Meeting.
3. Your request to divert this ship to BARI was received after she had sailed and some trouble has been caused in arranging the diversion, it also necessitated breaking wireless silence at sea.
