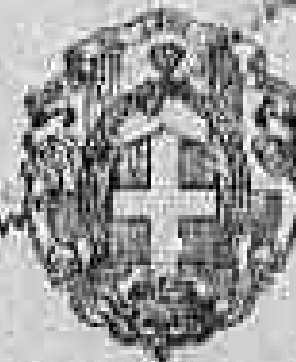

- to let us know the items which must be actually drawn so that we can give the necessary authorisation or sanction.

SUBJECT: Surplus Rations Held by Italian Navy.

TO : Commanding General, Land Forces Sub Com A.C. (MMIA).

1. Prior to receiving your ST/6 dated 11 May this office had contacted the Navy regarding the surplus rations they were holding in stock. This date they advised this office, effective 6 May, they had approx 40 days rations except rice and oil for the Navy personnel stationed in Gerdinia. We did not issue the Navy any rations for period 6-20 May. They claim this excess was accumulated due to the Ministry of Navy directing them to draw a certain number of rations and their strength did not warrant the number authorized.

2. Due to shipping facilities and lack of MT the Italian Navy here request they be authorized to issue 30 days rations at one time to personnel stationed a great distance from Cagliari. The greatest number of Navy personnel this effects is at Maddalena Island, approx 3400. Recommend approval.

3. They further request to hold at Maddalena 15 day surplus stock of rations due to lack of available scheduled shipping facilities and to supply emergency ships not based at Maddalena but due to being rerouted required rations. Recommend approval.

4. Recommend that no surplus stock of rations be held by the Navy at Cagliari for emergency ships, and no such ships be supplied with rations at Maddalena or Cagliari without authorization from MMIA through this office. Request this office be authorized to act on such cases where lack of communications or time does not permit contacting MMIA, however, MMIA would be fully advised of any such action taken.

5. All rations thus, drawn in par 4 above, be supplied from the Cagliari Bulk Depot to Navy under usual procedure.

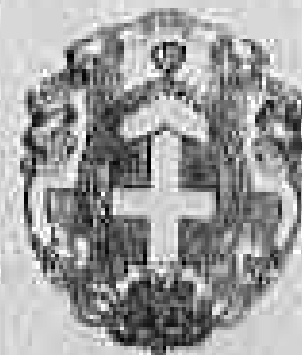

1. Reference your ST/6 same subject dated 4 April 1945.

2. In compliance with the above referred to letter, thorough inspections have been made, with a representative of the Commissariato, of all Food Depots in Sicily and also the one in Reggio-Calabria. In neither of the depots was food stuffs from Italian origin found where like or similar Allied items existed. However at the Caltanissetta D.D. we found forty four sacks of sugar and at the Catania Bulk Depot, thirty eight sacks of sugar, which could be considered as of doubtful origin and orders were given on the spot that this and any other doubtful items were to be issued first before any like items. The same order was given in reference to any items of Italian origin which may arrive in the depot.

3. It may be well to remark that a large quantity of foodstuffs arrive in the island which have been repacked in Italian sacks. These items are for the most part limited to Sugar, beans, coffee and macaroni. In each such instance the parcel was opened and the contents examined and although the general agreement was that the items were of Allied origin, orders were given that such items be issued before any like or similar item in known Allied packing.

4. No foodstuffs were found in any of the depots that had not been taken up on charge.

5. This office will continue its periodic physical checks of all depots in Sicily and the one in Reggio-Calabria to assure that instructions contained in your above referred to letter is complied with.

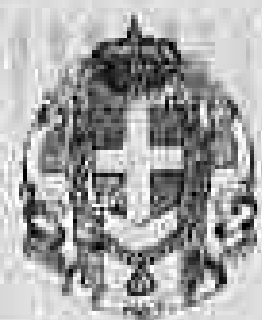

2. It is a well-known fact that, with the possible exception of dehydrated potatoes, this type of food is not liked by the Italian Armed Forces. HQ WIA letter ST/5/3 dated 7 Oct 1944, dealt with this point, and issued copies of AFHQ Pamphlet, giving advice on how to cook these vegetables to the best advantage, as it was thought the fault might lie in the cooking.

3. As far as this Bulk Depot is concerned, the following facts are put forward for your information: **6626**

(a) Italian Navy refuse to take their rations of Dehydrated Veg, with the exception of dehydrated potatoes. In this connection, O I/a Depot does NOT issue potatoes only, and still they prefer not to take their allotment.

2. It is a well-known fact that, with the possible exception of dehydrated Potatoes, this type of food is not liked by the Italian Armed Forces. HQ UNIA letter ST/5/3 dated 7 Oct 1944, dealt with this point, and issued copies of AFHQ Pamphlet, giving advice on how to cook these vegetables to the best advantage, as it was thought the fault might lie in the cooking.

3. As far as this Bulk Depot is concerned, the following facts are put forward for your information **6626**

(a) Italian Navy refuse to take their rations of Dehyd. Veg, with the exception of deh. Potatoes. In this connection, C i/o Depot does NOT issue Potatoes only, and still they prefer not to take their allotment.

(b) Ministry of War, in their weekly orders of despatch to other Sectors from the Bulk Depot, have only ordered certain small quantities of Dehyd. Potatoes to be moved, naturally preferring to move more vital and popular commodities. Consequently enormous stocks of these veg. are accruing, since

(c) Receipts into the Bulk Depot are based on daily strength of 75,000, so that receipts far exceed despatches.

4. Please may some action be taken in order to put this situation on a more satisfactory basis.

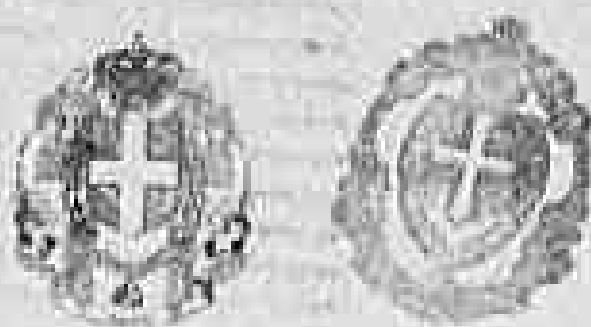

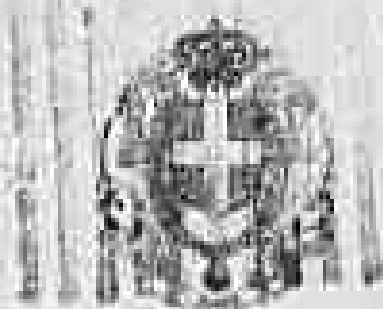

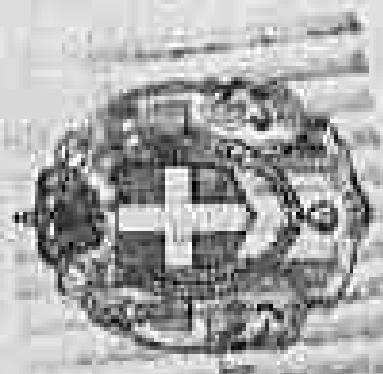

We assure you that we have given instructions on the distribution of foodstuffs of Italian with a precedence over those of Allied origin.

As the Italian goods start to fail, you will be informed.

As for the tins of meat produced in Italy, of which, except in SARDINIA, there exist a limited quantity, it has been ordered on the other hand that they be reserved for issue as travel rations, considering their especial aptitude for such an issue. They will therefore be issued, in precedence over Allied meat in the above special ration, always supposing that their state of preservation does not suggest the need for an earlier consumption.

As for small quantities which, for that reason, may be quickly exhausted, will you please sanction the determination of this Ministry as to how to dispose of them.

As for SARDINIA, on the other hand, there exist in the Depots of the Island notable amounts of tins, and we have given instructions that they be consumed with precedence over Allied meat, also as ordinary rations, and that only a small amount be kept back for issue to travelling soldiers.
