Reference your letter dated 3 August.

1. Your letter dated 3 July with dispositions for the disbandment of the platoon was received on 7 July 1945.

2. The platoon was disbanded on 9 July.

3. All the military of the platoon were attached to B1 Co of this Division and those who were to be absorbed by the 59 I.S. Regt have all reached the Regt except the following:

- a. Cpl Maj Moro Vittorio } in service with Italian
- b. Pvt Trinci Gerardo } Requisitioning Office
- c. Pvt Trinci Raul } driver with FWS.

The two servicemen in letters a and b were left temporarily at the disposition of the requisitioning office through request of Col Bertino of the Italian Air Corps. They will return to the 59th as soon as they will be substituted in the service they are performing.

For Pvt Trinci Raul this Bq had disposed that he should return to the 59th I.S. Regt on 8 July 45 but FWS having requested authorization to maintain him, and the authorization having not been given by MTA, his order to return was confirmed on 20 July 1945.

On 3 August the 59 Regt informed us that Sgt Tarantini of MTA had asked Col De Giudici that the position of said serviceman should be left in suspension until Col Albertin return.

On 6 August the order to return was reconfirmed and today he is with the 59 Regt.

Cpl. Maj Moro Vittorio and driver Trinci Gherardo are in the service of the Italian Requisitioning Office and were assigned by the Allied Hqs. to handle the services requested by the Allies. These servicemen were attached to the A.C. Service Platoon which has recently been disbanded. Pursuant to this, the Calabria Division Hqs has disposed that these men be returned to the 59th Infantry Regiment.

This office finds itself in the absolute impossibility to let this movement take place, because, with the recent discharges, the office has lost 3 drivers and has had to employ as a driver even the motorcyclist Moro.

The Air Corps, which has furnished the drivers to the vehicle unit (Auto-Gruppo) of the 65 S.P. , finds itself in the impossibility to substitute the two drivers which for the good services rendered are particularly useful, especially for the Requisitioning Office, because they know well the zones of Decimo and Villacidro.

As it is known this office is regularizing many requisitions of land and premises made for the Allies, especially in the zones of Decimo, Villacidro, Villasor and S. Sperate, consequently it has absolute need of its cars which due to the spare part shortage constantly need maintainance and care.

In conclusion, this office, due to the orders received from higher Allied Headquarters must regularize as soon as possible the numerous pending cases, cannot ~~give~~ as yet do without the drivers mentioned above.

Since Hqs Calabria Division informed me that the order was given by your office, request you inform the office concerned if movement can be effected when this office closes up, which is foreseen in the near future.

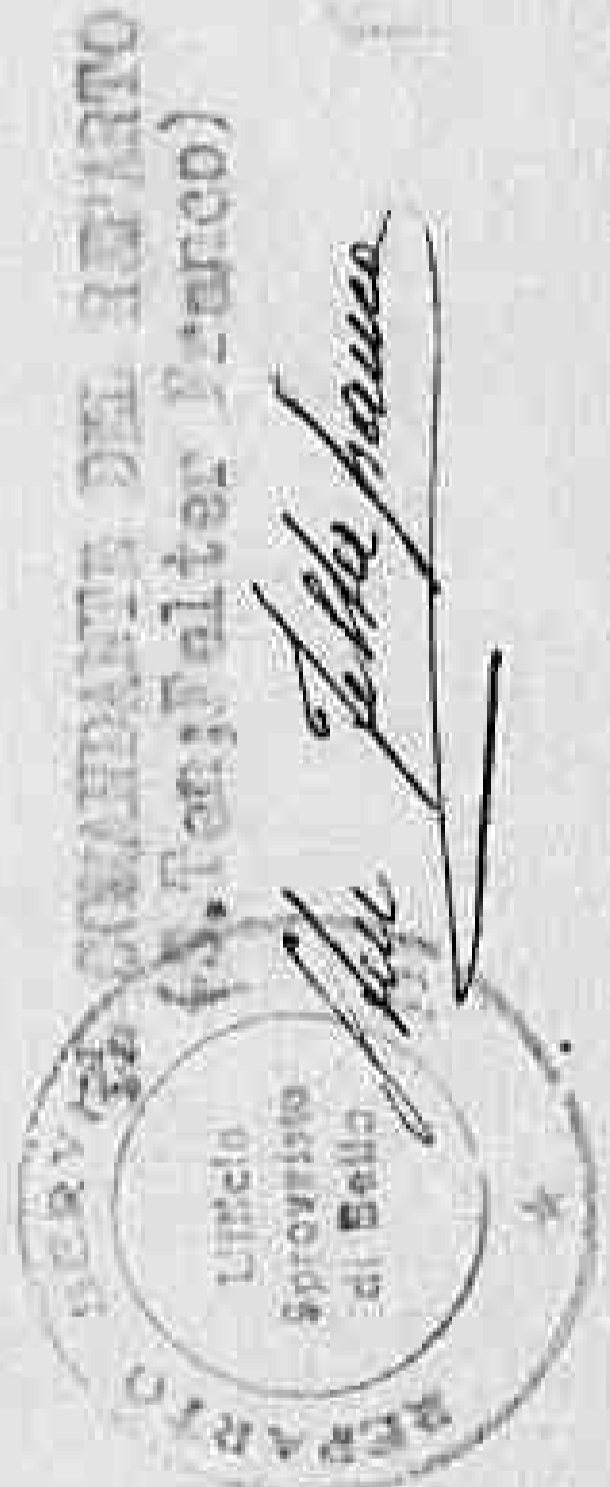

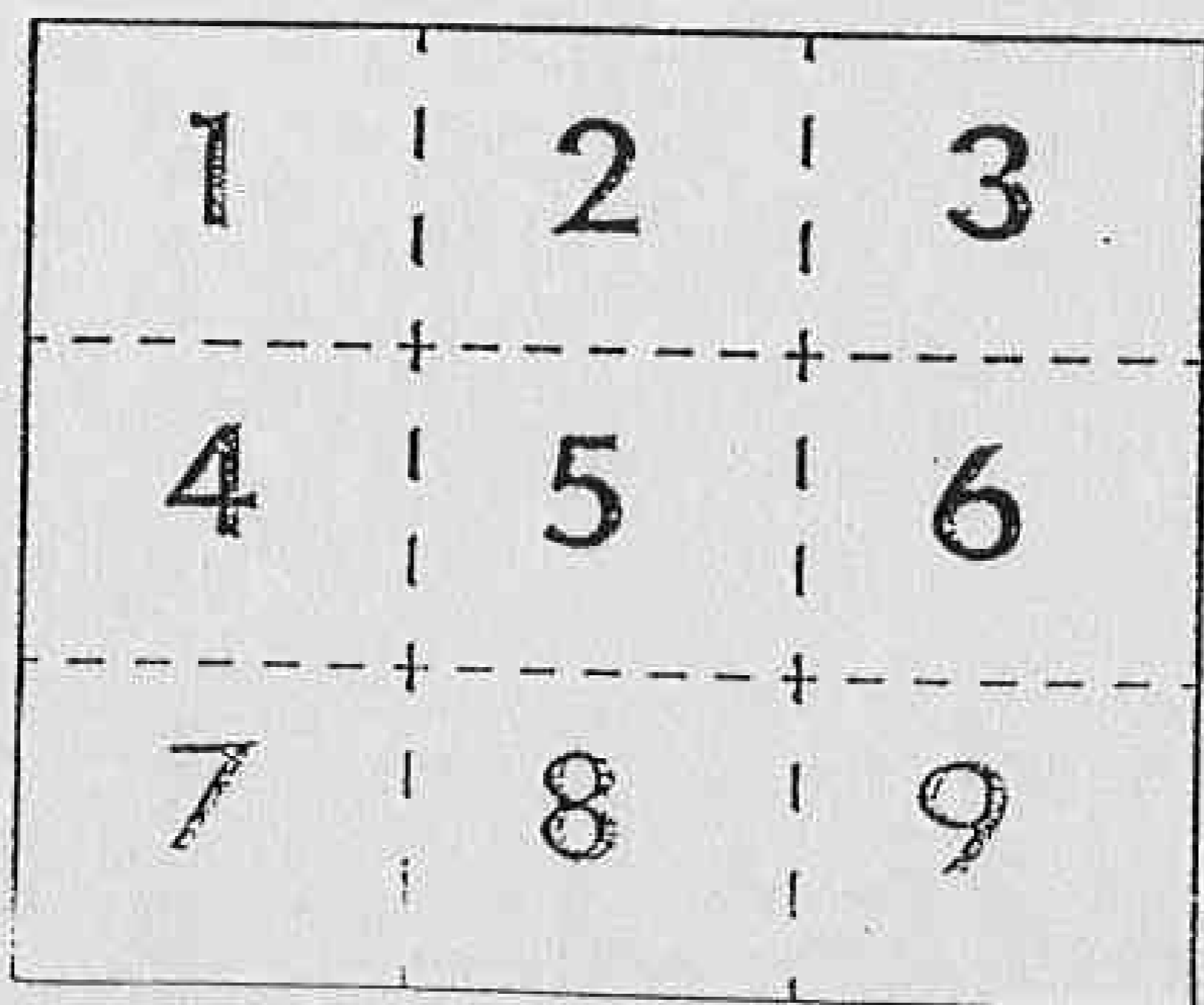
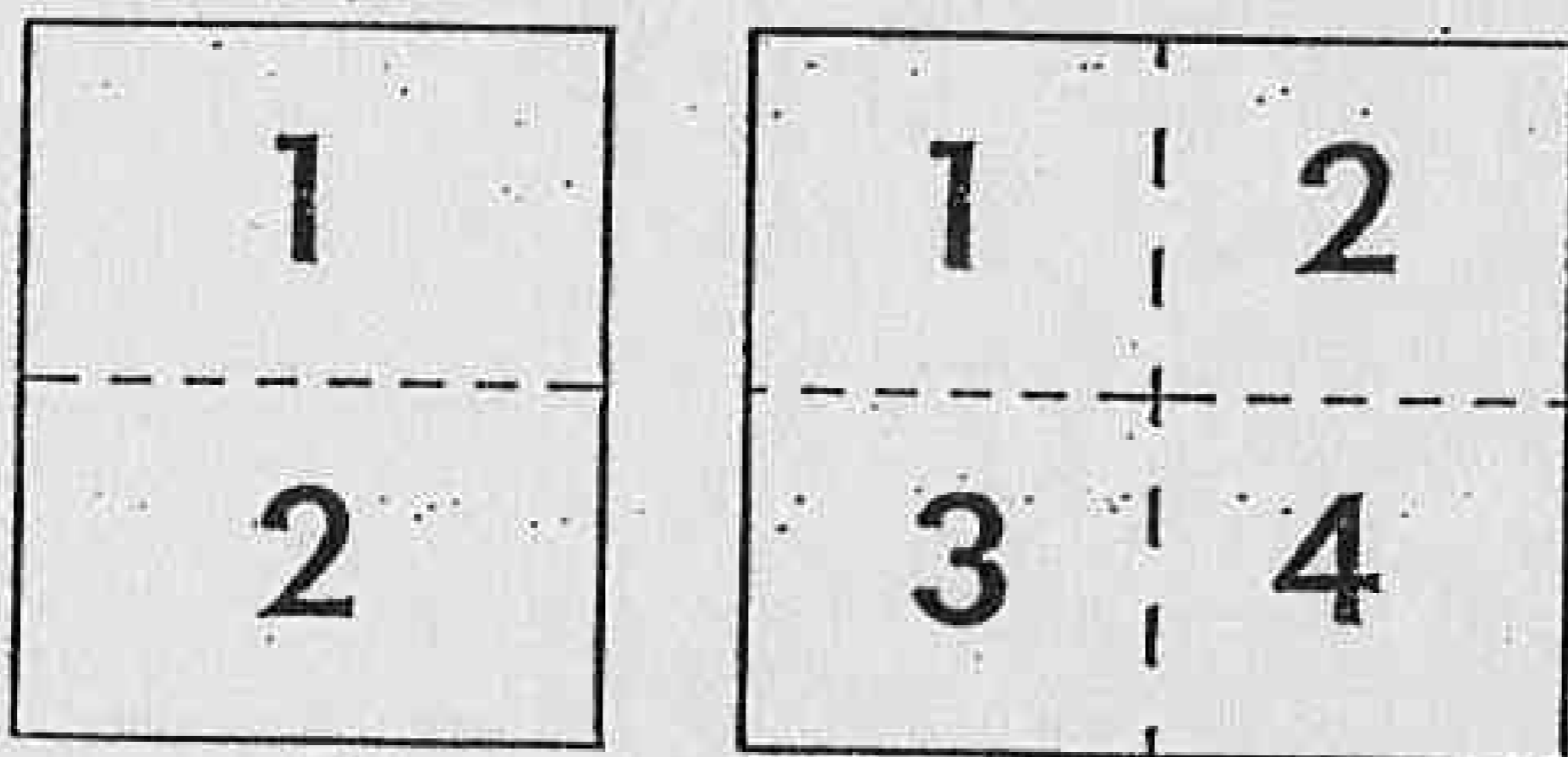

Request to be advised if this office took any action to have these 16 men, now 17, transferred to the strength of the Calabria Division and carried within the ITI-ITI category, as mentioned in paragraph 2 of latter communication above.

2. Will greatly appreciate any information you can give re this Detachment and thanks.

3. Am getting into the picture here. When AC moved, we requisitioned the building  $\frac{1}{2}$  block west of Villa and have our Enlisted Mens Mess on first floor and they live on 3rd floor. We move our office to the 2nd floor next Monday. Have established a motor pool on tennis court of Villa grounds. All in all it makes a nice set up. Captain Owens and Lieut. Woodnut live with us in the Villa. Come to see us sometime.

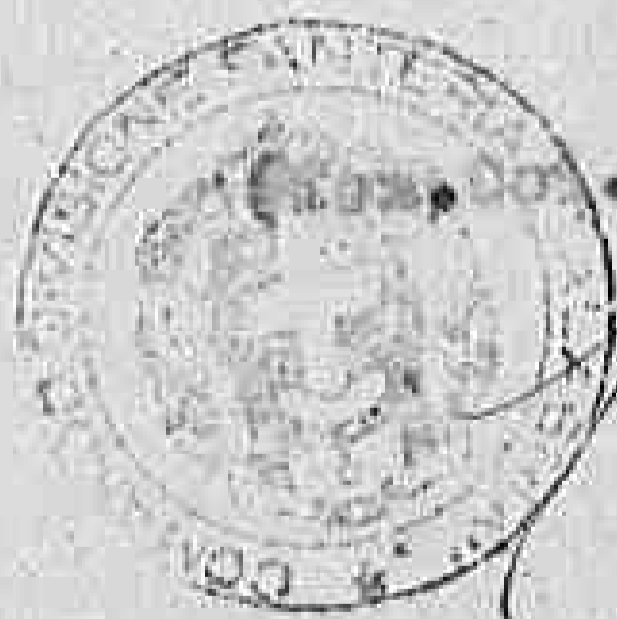

a. On 10 September 1944, he was assigned to a unit of the Calabria Division in Sardinia. As he spoke English he had been loaned by the Allied Garrison Commander for duty with the Regional Commissioner, ALGOM, Sardinia (Incl 2)

b. On 17 October 1944, the Regional Commissioner addressed a letter to the Calabria Division directing that the officer proceed to Rome (Incl 3), and on 18 October issued a travel order (Incl 4). The officer's Battalion Commander issued permission for the officer to obey the orders issued by the Regional Commissioner.

c. The officer traveled to Rome, and has since been working with the Commerce Sub Commission, AC. The officer has not been paid by the War Ministry since his arrival in Rome.

2. a. Since the officer was, on 20 October, a member of the Calabria Division and had been merely loaned to the Regional Commissioner, the order of the Regional Commissioner directed to the Calabria Division was not in fact within the province of the Regional Commissioner. On 20 October, the Calabria Division was under the Command of the Allied Garrison Commander, Sardinia, and not the Regional Commissioner. Any transfers, travel orders, etc., affecting the officer should have passed through proper channels.

b. On 15 October 1944, Italian personnel was authorized for service with the Allied Commission, Sardinia. The use of such personnel (as requested by you) is authorized

only in Sardinia (AFHQ letters, file AG 400/105 D-0 of 22 September 1944, and file AG 091.711/169 OCT-0 of 16 November 1944). It is noted that only one officer is authorized, as Platoon Commander.

c. This officer has been rendered "ineffective" by this "transfer" to Rome, and his pay and rations for the period since 30 October have been placed in jeopardy.

d. It is not the policy to assign Italian military personnel to duty which is not in fact military.

3. In order to regularize the position of this officer, he should be directed to report to the War Ministry and be returned to his unit in Sardinia. Should he then desire to be discharged from the Italian Army in order to accept a civil position, he should make proper application through Italian military channels.

4. Request information as to the date the officer will be released by you and returned to his proper duty.




