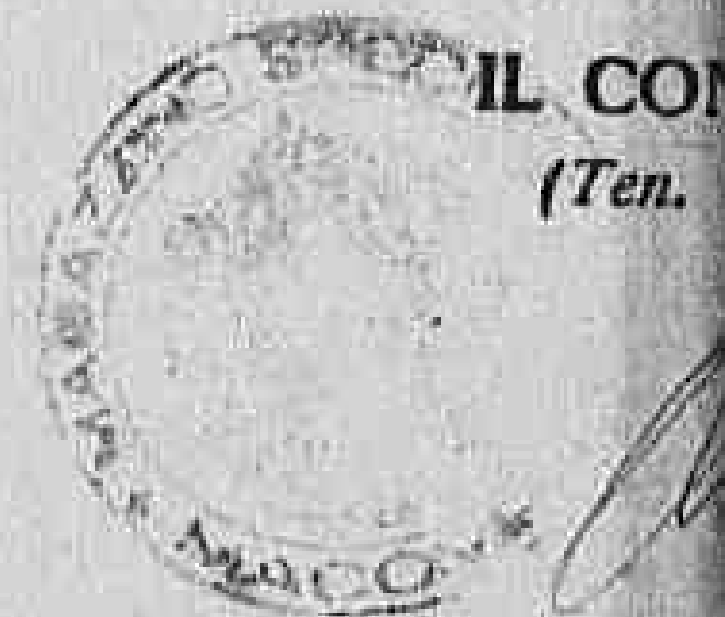

2. For belly bands tubular, on last months stock state, the Clothing Sub-Depot reported the incorrect figure as the closing stock. Instead of 998 it should have been 8 as shown on the opening stock of this report. Shortages of 780 pairs shoes, 256 drawers wool, 612 shirts cotton and 1990 drawers cotton cannot be made up from stocks in depots on the island and must be shipped from the mainland. Other shortages can be made up from stocks in Sardinia. 379 pairs shoes have been authorized to the CCPR and were not drawn as of 25 June 1945. 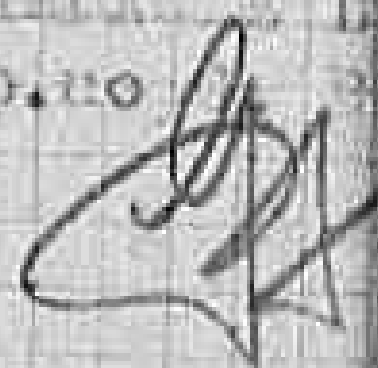
