I, Carlo J Dominiano, hereby state that while making an inspection with Lt Snider, at the Reggio-Calabria Food Distribution Depot, I had my bed roll pilfered from me.

It happened at the time we were leaving the ferry from Reggio-Calabria. Our gear was stowed in the back of the peep and as our vehicle started through the milling crowd which usually hangs at the boat landing to disembark at Messina I turned around to keep an eye on all the equipment. It was at that time I noticed the bed roll was missing, and due to the large crowd it was impossible to determine just who the culprit was. It happened so fast, as just before the vehicle started forward I still saw the bed roll in the back where I had placed it.

I certify that to the best of my knowledge the above facts are true and the bed roll was lost through no fault or negligence of my own.

1. Letter, this headquarters, file AG 370.5/476 QI-0, Subject "Clothing and Equipment for Personnel Leaving the Theater", dated 11 March 1945 is rescinded.

2. Notwithstanding previous instructions issued by this headquarters, enlisted personnel returned to the US are continuing to arrive improperly and insufficiently clothed.

3. War Department Circular 72 dated 7 March 1945, gives specific instructions as to the items that will be issued to each enlisted person returned to the US. The provisions of War Department Circular 72 supercede SOS NATCUSA Circular 92 of 12 August 1944 and Section I of SOS NATCUSA Circular 99 of 2 September 1944 both of which are being rescinded. It is desired that the provisions of War Department Circular 72, except as noted in paragraph 7 below, be strictly adhered to by all concerned.

4. It is first the responsibility of the organization from which the individual originates to prepare the "Clothing and Equip-

ment Adjustment Form" (see paragraph 11 of WD Circular 72, 1945) as to insure that proper clothing is in the possession of each individual prior to his arrival at the replacement depot or other staging installation.

5. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 4 above, it is the responsibility of the replacement depots or other staging installations to check individual clothing and equipment of personnel returning to the US, to issue any item that is short and to check accuracy of "Clothing and Equipment Adjustment Forms" which must accompany each individual.

6. It is the responsibility of addressees of this letter to implement these instructions so that all concerned may be conversant with War Department requirements and the respective responsibilities of the commands of this theater. Repeated violations of these instructions will be reported by the replacement installations, staging area and ports of embarkation thru command channels to this headquarters for corrective action.

7. Exceptions:

a. Delete from paragraph 5, a, WD Circular, Number 72, 1945 liner, helmet, with head and neck bands.

b. From 1 May 1945, to 1 September 1945, the following amendments to paragraph 5, a, WD Circular Number 72, 1945 will apply to enlisted personnel returning to the United States.

(1) Glove, wool, olive drab with or without leather palms are not required and will not be issued. If in the possession of the individual, the item may be retained.

(2) Drawers, wool and undershirts, wool are not required and will not be issued for the purpose of complying with WD Circular Number 72, 1945. One of each item may be retained if in possession of the individual. During the applicable summer period, the total issue of 4 each, drawers, cotton, shorts, and 4 each, undershirts, summer, sleeveless, is authorized.

8. The following information is furnished for the purpose of enabling addressees to clarify the instructions listed in paragraph 5 of WD Circular Number 72, 1945.

- a. Cap or Hat, herringbone twill.
 - (1) Cap, field, cotton, o.d.w/visor is a suitable substitute.
- b. Jacket, field, o.d.

- c. Trousers, cotton, khaki.
 - (1) Trousers, field, cotton, o.d., are a suitable substitute.
- d. Blanket, wool, o.d.
 - (1) Bag, sleeping, wool, w/cover is a suitable substitute for two blankets.
- e. Coat, wool, serge, o.d.
 - (1) Jacket, field, wool, o.d. is a suitable substitute, when in the possession of the individual.
- f. Overcoat, (or Mackinaw)
 - (1) From receipt of this directive until 1 September this item will not be issued individuals returned to US unless provided in movement orders or necessity is clearly established.

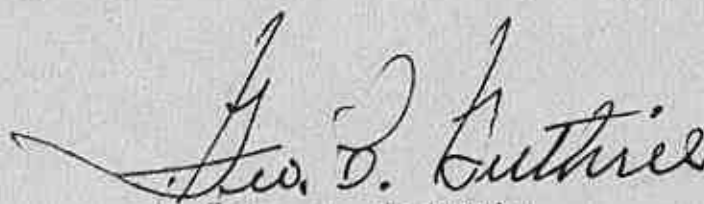
