1. Reference is made to your letters ST/88 of 27 November, subject as above. The transfer of 87,000 pounds of coffee to the Quartermaster, Allied Garrison Sardinia was completed on 27 October and Shipping Tickets forwarded to your Headquarters by our letter R/5 of 31 October 1944. No outstanding amounts are due.

2. The transfer of 307,000 pounds of sugar to the Quartermaster, Allied Garrison Sardinia was completed on 31 August and Shipping Tickets forwarded to your Headquarters by our letter R/5 of 23 October 1944. No outstanding amounts are due. — 5

3. The transfer of 200,000 pounds of rice to the Quartermaster, Allied Garrison Sardinia was completed on 27 October and Shipping Tickets forwarded to your Headquarters by our letter R/5 of 31 October 1944. No outstanding amounts are due.

4. Also transmitted in our letter R/5 of 31 October, were two sets of Shipping Tickets for 15,000 comforters each, which were transferred to the Quartermaster, Allied Garrison Sardinia on 29 October. Reference your MMIA MAP 8201 and MMIA AQ 2039.

MEMORANDUM TO: Col Simmons

SUBJECT : Flour to be returned by A.C.C.

1. During the month of June there was a lack of flour available for feeding the civilian population in Sardinia. Major Sullivan (A), A.C.C. Regional Supply Officer for Sardinia in company with Lt Marena, Italian Naval Officer, who is a member of Combined Italian Armed Forces Supply Board, approached the Allied Garrison, Sardinia for a loan of flour.

2. At that time there was quite a surplus of flour in the Italian Armed Forces warehouse. All food supplies were controlled by Allied Garrison, Sardinia and issues were only made in accordance with instructions from Allied Garrison, Sardinia.

3. No written request for loan was made and only a verbal authority was given by Allied Garrison, Sardinia for the issue of flour on a promise to repay by A.C.C. when their new supply of flour was available.

4. During the months of June, July and August several issues of flour were made and the total of 2,000 metric tons to be repaid was arrived at after a conference to straighten out an involved series of issues and repayments.

5490

5. Issue of food by A.C.C. for the feeding of militarized personnel was also slightly involved in the process. Combined Italian Armed Forces Supply Board would issue food to militarized personnel and A.C.C. would repay when available. This practice was stopped on Sept 20.

6. The attached letter from Lt Col Chayton (B) present A.C.C. Regional Supply Officer states that it will be a long time before A.C.C. can repay the loan.

1. I checked with Capt. Sacks and found the following:

(a) There was no paper transaction for this loan of flour. It was a verbal agreement only.

(b) Capt. Sacks, acting for the A.G.S. commander, told ACC and the Combined Italian Supply Board that it would be alright to transfer this flour since an excess existed at the Italian Depot. All this was done verbally.

(c) It was agreed, as indicated **5486** correspondence in file, that the flour will be returned beginning on Nov. 1, 1944 at the rate of 250 quintals per day and it shall

be of the same consistency and color as that given.

3. After the above had been done, LT Marine from the Supply Board and Major Sullivan of ACC arranged to make the exchange.

TO : M.M.I.A.

1. I confirm the conversation held this morning with Major FOSSETT in which I acknowledged that A.C.C. received from C.I.A.F.S.B. during the months of June and July of this year stocks of flour for the feeding of the civilian population of SARDINIA amounting to 2,000 metric tons in all.

2. With regard to the promise of the repayment of this loan, it is confirmed that there is little likelihood that this undertaking can be honoured. A supply of wheat had been held back which would be sufficient to mill the quantity of flour owing. This wheat, however, was deteriorating quickly. It has, therefore, been allocated for immediate milling and consumption by the civilian population.

3. In the agreement for repayment it had been stipulated that the flour returned should be exactly the same type of flour as was borrowed. Local milling of Sardinian or imported wheat will not produce the type of flour specified. Repayment is, therefore, dependent of the future imports of flour surplus to civilian requirements. The present indications are that such imports are not likely to be forth coming, in any case, for several months.

1. This headquarters has been advised by the President, Combined Italian Armed Forces Supply Board that your organization has advanced the following items in the quantities shown to the Combined Italian Armed Forces Supply Board for the ration of 300 militarized civilian personnel for 30 days:

2. In addition to this the Combined Italian Armed Forces Supply Board has advanced for you Kg 11,143.800 of flour for the same purpose.

3. In view of the fact that the feeding of militarized personnel is a function of the ACC, the amount of flour noted above is now due by you to the Combined Italian Armed Forces Supply Board together with other outstanding amounts.

4. It has been agreed in the past that flour advanced by the Combined Italian Armed Forces Supply Board will be repaid pound for pound by a flour of equal mill, quality, consistency and color.

5. It is desired that this flour be repaid at the earliest practicable time.

SUBJECT: Flour due to Italian Army.

TO : Allied Garrison of Sardinia.
G-4, Attention: Capt. Sachs.

1. Reference is made to conversation Lt. Col. Chayton-Capt. Sachs, on 12th August in connection with flour due by A.C.C. to the Italian Army. A statement is attached hereto showing that of the quantity of 8,680.96 quintals lent to the Italian Armed Forces an amount of 356.48 quintals is still outstanding.

2. This amount could be set against the 2,000 tons due by A.C.C. to the Italian Armed Forces but it is proposed that this small account should be cleared by a transfer of flour thus leaving the balance due by A.C.C. at 2,000 tons. No stocks of flour are at present available in our warehouses to meet demands to be made by you for midshift meals for labourers working for the Garrison and this quantity would provide for this contingency.
