SUBJECT: Stores to be Shipped to Mainland.

TO : Commanding General, Italian Army Forces in Sardinia.

1. Enclosed herewith is a list of stores to be prepared for shipment without delay and made available for loading at the port of Cagliari by 1 July 1945. Items listed in Priority I should be made available before Priority II.
2. MMIA Rome has directed this office to direct you to use sufficient personnel of the Calabria Division to supplement the preparation and transportation of the above mentioned stocks in order that all said stocks will be available without fail for shipment to mainland by 1 July 1945, and this assignment to have priority over any other assigned duty.
3. Sufficient MT and railroad cars will be made available to expedite the movement of stocks to Cagliari.
4. Radio equipment will be plainly marked "FRAGILE" on outside of crating.
5. Beginning 11 June and each Monday thereafter, until the movement of stocks to Cagliari is complete, you will submit a report to this office as to the items (giving quantities) arriving at Cagliari up to the previous Saturday and the depot from which they come.
6. You will advise this office when all of the above mentioned stocks have arrived at Cagliari Port.
7. Instructions regarding movement of ^{balance of} clothing to the Cagliari Sub Clothing Depot to follow.

SUBJECT:- SOLDIER BROOK FOR MILITARY TRANSPORT.

The role of military escorts for the transportation of materials, rations, etc. is governed by the orders in our 653/319 of 22 Jan, copy attached for MEMO.

In accordance with the orders referred to, Military escorts must accompany the transport - whether by rail or ordinary means - from the place of departure to the destination.

Therefore we ask the Comandi Militari Territoriali to give orders so that the difficulties quoted by MEMO should cease, which are due to the system adopted by various units allowing a change of escort during the journey. Such difficulties are known to be prevalent in Catania.

We ask the Territorial Commands to acknowledge this letter.

TO THE MILITARY ADMINISTRATION DURING TRANSPORTATION
SHIPMENTS UNDER ESCORT.

This Ministry is frequently informed, by various units under its command, of deficiencies in materials, rations, etc, belonging to the Military Administration, which are discovered on the arrival of the goods, whether despatched by ordinary means or rail.

It should be borne in mind that such deficiencies would not take place if the units concerned arranged a more efficient escort for the transport, and also it should be remembered that in accordance with our order No L189 of 17 August, the transportation of goods on the State Railways is accepted only at the risk of the consignor. In order to guarantee the transportation of the goods belonging to the Military Administration and to check up upon the eventual responsibility of units held responsible this Ministry considers it opportune to call the attention of all to the relevant orders, which are reiterated below:-

1. Whatever the means of transportation may be, whether by rail or ordinary means, the unit responsible is obliged to see that the safety of the load and the discipline are guaranteed by means of arranging a suitable escort, having first come to an agreement with the local Allied Authorities on their armament (See Min of War - Cabinet - circular No 305777/2/CA of 7 Dec 44). This is both in the utmost interest of the transportation and also to avoid any impression that the Allied Authorities may get of lack of interest on the part of the Military Administration.

2. The escort must be found out of personnel who can be absolutely trusted.

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2. The escort must be found out of personnel who can be absolutely trusted in their ability and character, and when possible it should be formed out of the unit receiving the goods. The escorting personnel, by order of the Allied Authorities, will wear a red distinguishing band on their left arm, to be supplied by the consignor unit. Personnel not wearing these armbands will not be recognised as escorts by the Italian or Allied railway authorities, and will be removed from the railway wagons. Personnel escorting railway wagons must always be in possession of the regular 3rd class ticket, both for the outward and return journeys.
3. When goods of a certain value are sent, it will be necessary to make an NCO to be in command of the escort. He will assist in and be personally responsible for the loading, and for ascertaining the weight, number and type of goods, and he will also assist in the sealing. The unit concerned of course will give

precise instructions to the commander of the escort party, so that he makes certain during the halts that the load has not been tampered with and that the seals attached when the railway wagon was closed are still intact. The nearest Garrison, Carabinieri, Military or station authority should be told at once if there is any suspicion of the goods having been tampered with or any abnormality during the journey which could endanger the rest of the transport.

4. When the truck or railway wagons are uncovered, the escort must be adapted to these circumstances and must take post at the back of the truck or wagon, so as to be in the position to intervene for the safety of the wagon, the goods and the escorting personnel.

5. Any irregularities whatsoever must be reported at once in writing at the time of the arrival of the transport to the Mil Territ unit concerned, and to this Ministry and the consigning unit for information.

6. Any deficiencies discovered must be certified with all urgency, in the form laid down by Article 17 of our "Administrative Instructions for Troops in the Field". In such case, the receiving unit will at once provide for the compiling of the prescribed report by the commander of the escort, bearing in mind that the same report, before the Authorities concerned are to decide if the charge has to be made or not, should be sent to the Mil Territ unit under whose command is the unit sending the transport, so that it may be able to examine the escort commander's reasons and excuses. When units are under command of different Mil authorities, the question will be sent to this Ministry for a decision.

7. When a determination of the causes has been reached, a detailed report of the crime must be supplied at once by the unit concerned for the Tribunal which is to deal with the person held responsible.

Addressees must give the maximum amount of publication to these rules which corroborate those in our Circular 329/98 di prot of 8 Dec 1944. Everyone must be reminded that the Commanders are held responsible if these rules are not carried out exactly.

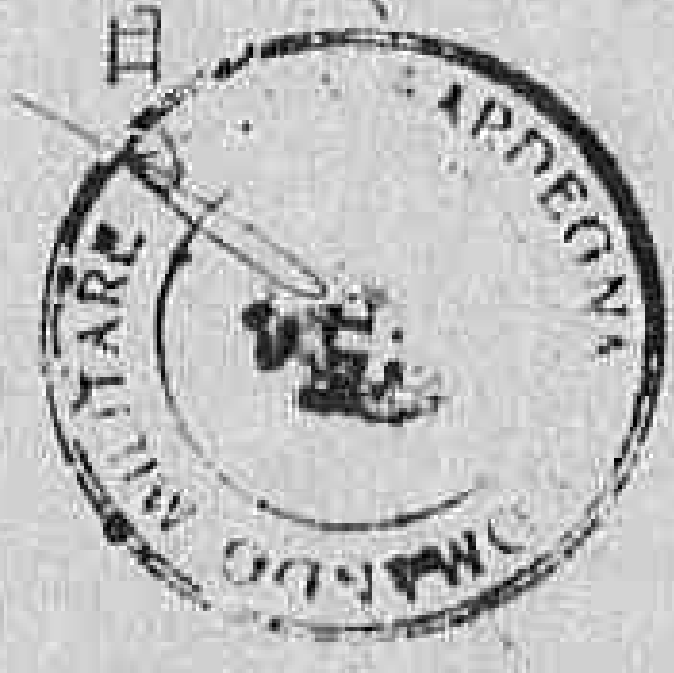
