SUBJECT: Forage Ration.

TO : Commanding General, Italian Forces in Sardinia
Attention: Director of Commissary.

1. On 7 February 1945, 94 tons of tiben unloaded from the SS "Carlton" were inspected by Captain Lawrence E. Spong, Veterinarian, U.S. Army, in company with Lt. Colonel Cesano. They found that about 40 tons were totally unsuitable for use because it was mouldy. They found that 30 tons were in good condition. The remaining 24 tons were found to be partly mouldy.

2. It is therefore recommended that the 24 tons, which are partly mouldy, be issued at the rate of two pounds for one pound on the regular ration. Units receiving this tiben can discard the mouldy portion.

3. An Analysis Commission will witness the destruction of the 40 tons of tiben which were judged to be totally unsuitable for use.

4. Request that this office be furnished a copy of your instructions to Forage Depots on this matter.

TO : Commanding General, Italian Forces in Sardinia.
Attention: Director of Commissary.

1. In reply to your letter 1/117/F of 6 January 1945 and further to our letter F/6 of 28 December 1944, on above subject, it is pointed out that since forage is supplied from Allied sources, the forage scale issued by Allies should be adhered to. Since many animals are now under nourished, it is the intention that all horses, except those of C.C.R.R. and Remount Depot at Monorva, be fed the full scale for "Horses and Mountain Artillery Horses" to better their condition.

2. Paragraph 2 of your letter refers to letter 11446/S/1 of 30 October 1944 from War Ministry. This letter states that ration will be fixed in agreement with M.M.I.A. in Sardinia. Therefore, the above mentioned ration scale will be used. However, this scale does not prevent the substitution of decayed biscuits, in the proper proportions, or the use of hay if these items are locally available. Salt should be issued at 2 ozs. per day. Bedding should also be issued as authorized.

3. Request that this office be furnished a copy of your instructions implementing the above Forage Ration Scale.

1. There are at present in Sardinia the following animals:
(a) 857 horses of Italian Army, fed on Full Ration.
(b) 500 horses of Carabinieri, fed on 2/3 Ration.
(c) 54 horses for Allies, fed on Full Ration.
2. (a) As of 6 November the following stocks were in Sardinia:

164 tons grain
451 tons tinned.

(b) No information is available here regarding any further consignments of forage to Sardinia.
3. It is reported that the 500 horses of the Carabinieri, being fed on 2/3 ration, are in poor condition.
4. Forage from local resources in Sardinia is not sufficient to maintain these animals.
5. The maintenance of any of the 857 horses belonging to the Italian Army (par. 1 (a) above) is unnecessary as the small number of Italian Army troops on the Island are equipped with sufficient motor transport.
6. It is not known what is desired regarding the retention of the horses of the Carabinieri as this is a matter for the Regional Commissioner's decision. If these horses are retained it will be necessary to ship forage from the mainland.
7. Urgently recommend that the 857 horses of the Italian

NO RECORD HIG AFHQ/12/54/ST.1 (D) of 2 NOV 44

Army be turned over to farmers in Sardinia and that no further forage be shipped for them. If this recommendation is accepted, steps will be taken by us to have this handled between the Allied and Italian authorities on the Island.
