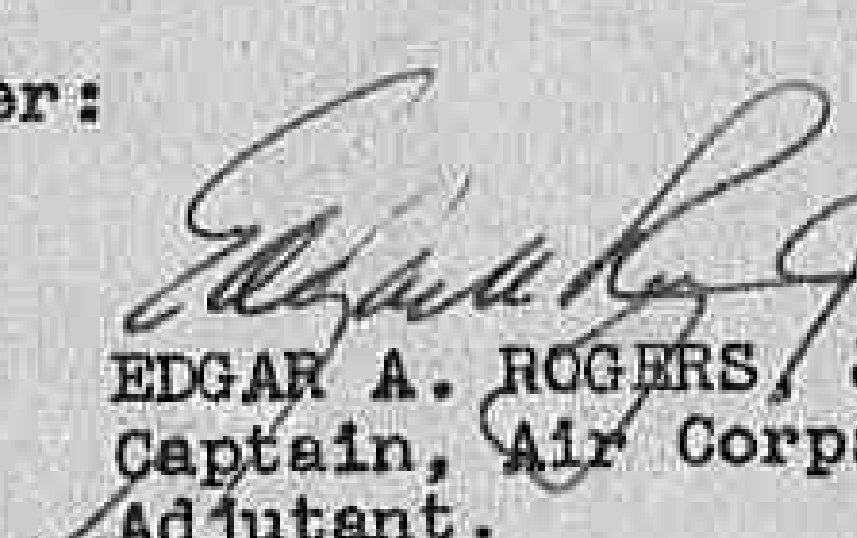

1. Reference is made to Memo 55-1, this Headquarters dated 5 December 1943.

2. Effective at once, "C" rations will no longer be issued to Italian civilians authorized rations under the provisions of the above Memo. In lieu thereof you will issue the following as a special ration to such Italians:

Meat and Veg. Stew,	1-30 oz can per 3 men; or
Vienna Sausage,	1-24 oz can per 2 men; or
Chili,	1-104 oz can per 8 men; or
Hash,	1-88 oz can per 6 men

Biscuits - Type "C" - 4 per man per day or the equivalent of biscuits contained in the "B" unit of the "C" ration.

3. In the event of cans of different size from those indicated, issue will be made so that each man will get approximately 12 oz of meat daily.

4. The type of meat to be issued will be decided by you.

5. Bread will be substituted for biscuits, upon further instructions from this headquarters.

6. Issue will be made from "C" Ration stocks.
