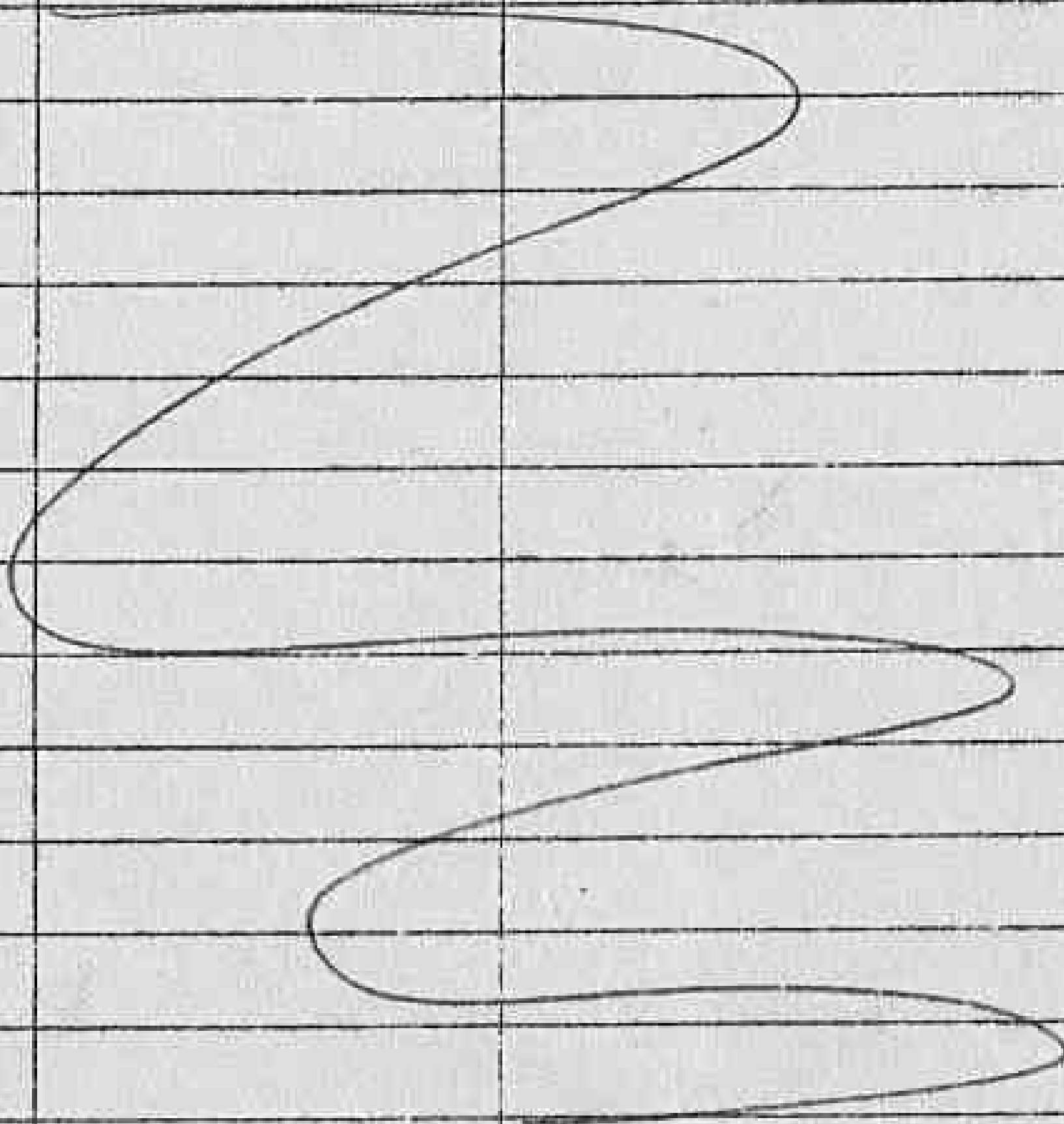

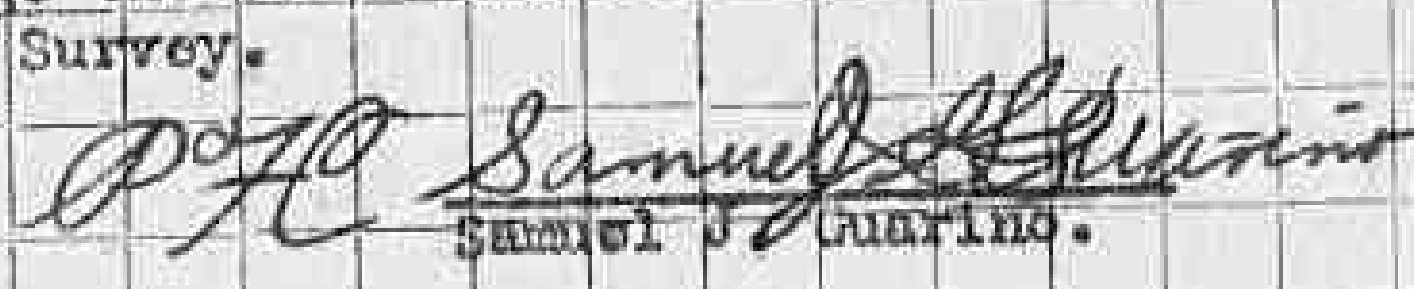

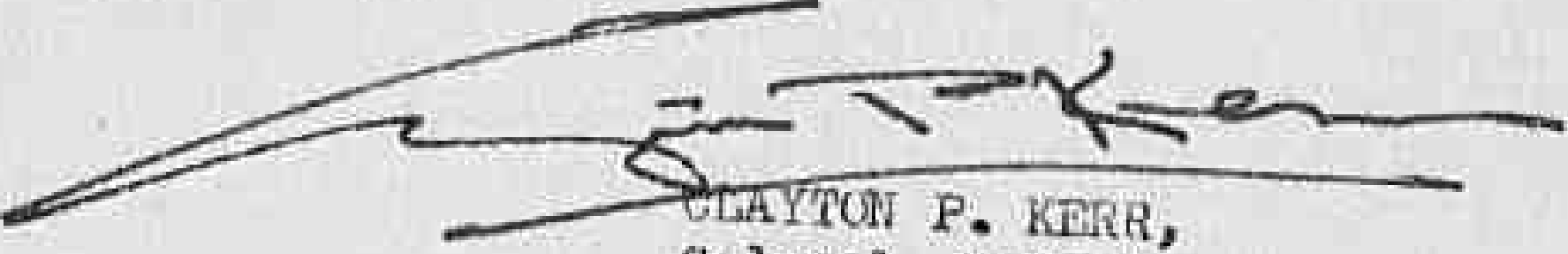

STATEMENT OF PFC. EDWARD F. JABER 16005285

"My name is EDWARD F. JABER, 16005285, Private First Class, 2691 AMIA Co.

On 14 August 1945 Lt. RODINO gave me permission to use 1/4 T. car No. 20624704 for recreational purposes. I took my girl-friend (RAPHAELA LA VITA) to a dance in Rome during the evening. At about 2500 hrs that night, when the dance was over, I took my girl-friend to her sister's home and stayed for a short time.

From there I took my girl-friend to her home at 80 Via Catania, Rome. I parked the vehicle in front of the house, turned the wheels toward the curb, and locked the steering-wheel with a chain and pad-lock. My girl-friend stood next to the vehicle while I was doing this.

We then went into the house. My girl-friend looked out the window, about ten minutes after we had entered the house, to check on the vehicle. It was there. About 20 minutes later after I had had a cup of coffee I started to leave. My girl-friend looked out the window and said that the vehicle was not there. We both went down to the street, looked around in the immediate vicinity but could not see any trace of the vehicle.

I telephoned to the garage and asked Pvt. WILSON, the duty driver, to pick me up. We looked around the neighborhood, but could not find the vehicle. We went to a station of the 281st Military Police to inquire if the vehicle had been picked up. They suggested that we go to MP HQ, Piazza Venezia.

At about 0300 hrs, 15 Aug we reported to the MP HQ; however, the vehicle was not there.

Believing that someone may have taken the vehicle to take the wheels and tires, we thought that it might be found abandoned outside of town. We then went about 20 kilometers out Highway 5, but could not find the vehicle.

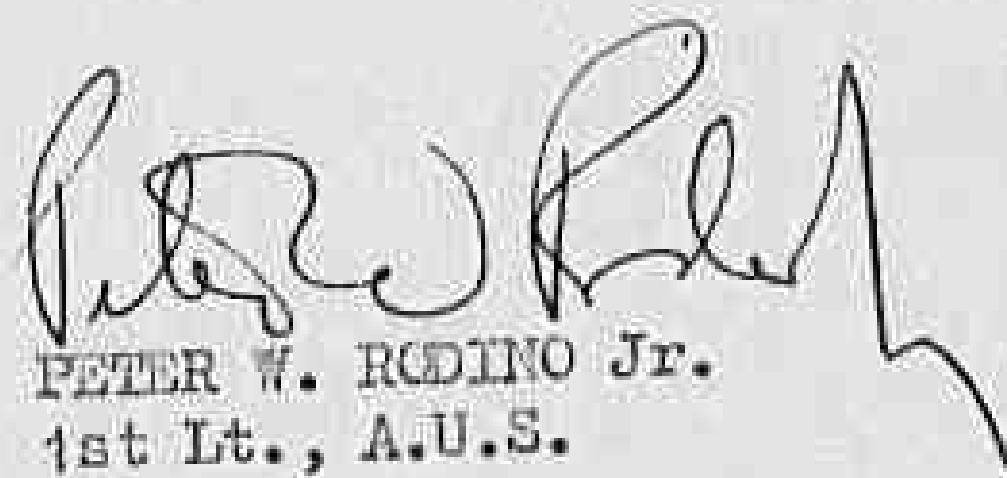

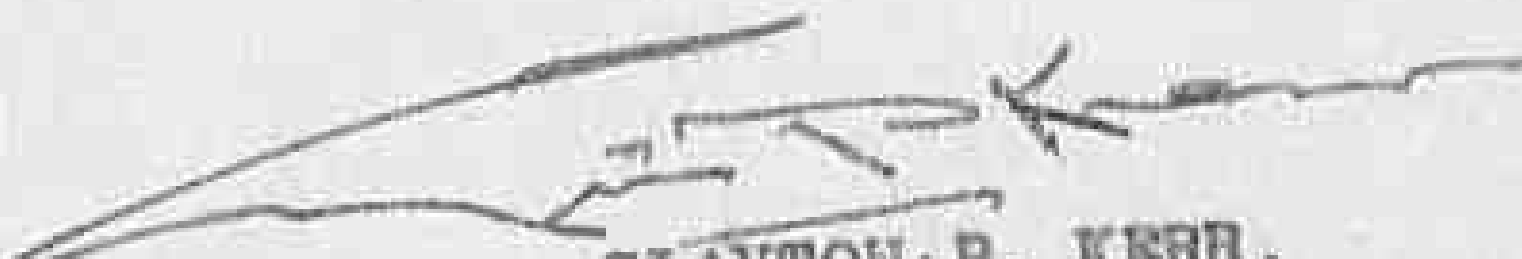
