1. The question of supplying drivers from units in Sardinia has been discussed with Comando Militare della Sardegna, who have submitted the following observations:

- a. 250-300 drivers cannot be supplied monthly without greatly affecting the Calabria, Cremona, Granatieri, and Bari Divisions, which are already understrength in drivers.
- b. If however the Bari Division is to be broken up, about 500 men could be trained as drivers in about 2-3 months. It is not considered that they would be efficient in a shorter time.
- c. 10 officers and 280 other ranks are immediately available and awaiting shipment (Serial 106A on List 7).  
A further 75-100 could be assembled in a short time from the XIII Motor Group.

2. To sum up, the supply of drivers depends upon the future role of the Divisions. Since the Bari Division is to be broken up to form guard battalions I am instructing Comando Militare della Sardegna to begin training 500 drivers forthwith, in accordance with their suggestion. Half these could be shipped early in October and the balance at the end of October or beginning of November.

3. I suggest that the 75-100 men referred to in para 1 c above be allotted a serial number on List 7 and despatched at the end of this month or beginning of September.

Elena - Capoterra) are employed in clearing mine fields. Each platoon is about 60 strong, and have only recently been formed to replace two Engineer Stoppage Companies sent to the mainland.

3. The attached sketch-maps show location of known mine fields. These fields are said to contain the following approximate number of mines:
