SUBJECT : Local Leave Br. Staff M.M.I.A.

This HQ letter A 281 dated May 45 is cancelled and will be substituted by the following with reference to G.R.O. 974/45.

1. LOCAL LEAVE (i.e. leave in ITALY) will normally be for 6 days, not more frequently than once in six months. In special circumstances the length and frequency of this leave may be extended.
2. In view of the spirit underlying G.R.O. 974/45 viz. That the 13 days leave is NOT a right but a privilege, which will be given ONLY in special circumstances, with due consideration to the following:-

- (a) The existing volume of essential work which MUST be done.
- (b) The shortage of staff due to I.I.A.P. etc.
- (c) The generous weekly time-off allowed.

Local Leave may be granted as follows:-

I. 7 days Local Leave, every 6 months may be given by Heads of Branches as herebefore and Camp Commandant notified through "A" Branch.

II. 13 days Local Leave, or any Local Leave more often than once every 6 months (in accordance with G.R.O. 974/45) will require G.O.C.'s approval through Col. A/Q.

3. Heads of Branches or Services (including Camp Commandant and Outstations) will each maintain their own Leave Rosters.
4. The Camp Commandant will be informed of all leave granted as far in advance as possible, in order to arrange pay etc. and where requested, by the individual, to make advance booking of accommodation at Leave Centres, or Rest Camps.
5. The Camp Commandant will maintain a record of all leave granted.

With regard to the attached letter which I received on my return to Abbassanta last night, I would ask you if you would be so kind as to consider sending a wire to Rome saying it is essential for a reinforcement to arrive before Pegg, my driver/batman departs. He is essential for the following reasons

- ① I require a driver/batman and therefore a civilian driver would not fill all requirements.
- ② I require an English soldier for liaison with the D.I.D. and NAAFI in connection with rations and in addition he is also the liaison link with the kitchen staff at

the villa.

- ©. Due to the fact that I live 80 miles from the nearest Allied personnel it is a great help to my mental stability to have one Englishman at hand!

In addition to the above request I would be very grateful if you could put in a plea for the retention of Peggy as a special case.
