

Subject: PATRIOTS TRANSIT CENTRE rations withdrawal and issue.

Via Montebello - Florence

- This Patriots Centre is drawing rations from Q5/41 and each time for a period of 10 - 15 days.
- 2. Additional items from Italian sources are drawn from 210th Division Dump on the basis of the same strength of the telegram used in Q5/41.
- 3. Incharged with rations is Capt Limbert (AMG)
- 4. Rations, both from American and Italian sources are kept in the depot of the Centre.
- 5. Daily rations are withdrawn from the Centre Depot on the basis of the strength morning report copy of which is given to Capt. Limbert.
- 6. Strength. The strength of the Centre is very incostant, from a minimum of 100 to a maximum of 680 daily men. Today, 23rd/2/1945, the strength was 200 men.

- It is suggested that, as the Centre is drawing military rations, ST/8 forms should be used for rations daily withdrawals from the depot and all the copies should be forwarded every 10 days to Sr. MMIA L.O. with 5th Army (as 210th Division Dump is doing) in order to justify how rations are spent and the daily strength fluctuations.
- 2. A great care is to be taken in a daily control of the strength owing to its incostancy (Inspections during meals distributions).
