3. You are further directed to explain in detail, by indorsement hereon, the reason or reasons for your failure to comply with specific verbal instructions to return to your proper station not later than 16 August 1944.

21 August 1944.

TO: Colonel F. L. SIMONS, O-100037, Infantry.

1. Upon the receipt of the cable referred to in the <sup>base</sup> communication, I saw Major Marion Smith of the Allied Garrison of Sardinia for the purpose of arranging air transport to Rome on 11 Aug.

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He said, that there would be no planes on 11 August, but he would try to get me a ride on a plane leaving from one of the groups. At 5:30 P.M. on the 9th of August he told me to be at Base Operations, 319th Bomb Group at 6:30 A.M., 10 August to proceed to Rome on a B-26. Major Smith said that a signal would not reach you in time to enable you to meet the plane at Rome. I was there at 0615 hours. The plane left the field at 0830 hours. Arrived at Rome 1000 hours.

2.a. On the morning of 15 August, I saw Colonel Kerr and informed him that I was leaving to go to Naples to load the jeep on the Scipione Africano which was arriving there that morning. Colonel Kerr said that the document that MIA had been awaiting from the Combined Chiefs of Staff had arrived. He said that he wished to study it and that my comments he had to make would be given to me in writing to carry to you. He said to report back in the morning.

b. On the morning of 16 August I reported to Colonel Kerr ready to leave. Checking with G-3 operations MIA, I was told that the Scipione Africano had not left on the night before but would leave that evening. Colonel Kerr said that Lieut Colonel Shipley was then preparing a memorandum on "Clothing for the Italian Army in Sardinia" based on the Combined Chiefs of Staff decision, that he wanted me to take back with me. I reported to Lieut Col Shipley and told him that I was supposed to take the Scipione Africano that night so as to be back in Sardinia the following morning. He said, "All right, I'll have this done in a half hour. This clothing situation is very important in view of this decision that has just come down. This memorandum has got to get to Colonel Simmons right away". I set in Colonel Shipley's office until noon before he finally got the rough draft worked out. The final draft was typed, signed by Colonel Kerr at approximately 1730 hours and handed to me by Major Ross at 1800 hours.

c. I left Rome at 0745 hours on 17 August and arrived in Naples at 1330 hours. I stopped at Capodichino airport and saw "Lil Woman", the C-47 piloted by Lieut Jasnowski of the 42nd Bomb Wing. A sergeant told me that the plane would not leave before 1500 hours. I checked in with Major Smith, the head of the MIA office in Naples. I asked him if he would accept the responsibility for the loading of the jeep on an Italian cruiser for shipment to Sardinia. I told him I could get a ride immediately on a C-47 and that I was carrying a paper that was necessary to get to Colonel Simmons as soon as possible. He said, "No, he did not care to accept the responsibility and that he did not care to delegate the job to any other one of his officers". There were no Italian cruisers leaving for Sardinia on that day. I went down to the "Water Transport Office" 8th Port and saw Captain Blanchard to ascertain if there was any movement of water transport to Sardinia. He said, "He had a freighter leaving on Sunday, 20 Aug for Cagliari, and to have the jeep at his office Saturday night at 1800 hours ready for loading. He was unable to obtain any information

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on the movement of Italian cruisers. He gave me his phone number, Vacant 524, and told me to keep in touch with him for any earlier movement of surfboat transport to Sardinia. I returned to our MMIA Naples office, and was informed that they had just received an E.P.A. on the Scipione Africano for the morning of 19 August.

d. On 18 August at 0900 hours I called Captain Blanchard at the 8th Port, Water Transport Office. He said that the Italian cruiser Duca D'Aosta had just come in and he did not know and was unable to find out where she was going from Naples. I immediately went down to the port to see the captain of the D'Aosta. He said that he did not know where he was going from Naples, but if I would take him to the Italian Admiralty he would try to find out. At the Admiralty, he was told in my presence that he would proceed to Cagliari, Sardinia on the night of 19 August. I returned to Captain Blanchard's office with this news and to make arrangements for the loading of the jeep. He told me exactly what to do and where to have the jeep. I called the Naples MMIA office and informed the British major there in charge of movements exactly what I had done. He said he would give the information to Major Smith.

e. At 1000 hours on 19 August I was at Capodichino hoping to get air passage to Sardinia. At 1100 hours I met Lieutenants Ward, Cobin, and Jasnowski who had just arrived. Lieut Jasnowski said he would give me a ride back to Sardinia and that he was leaving at 1500 hours. At 1300 hours I had the jeep at Bari No. 1, Pier No. 1, Naples ready for loading. The captain in charge of the pier said he would load the jeep at 1400 hours on a lighter to take it out to load on the Duca D'Aosta. So that Pvt Merli (I), my driver, could take me to the airport and then re-enter the port to load the jeep. Major John R. Glynn, assistant S-4, 8th Port secured a pass for him from the 8th Port Provost Marshal. Pvt Merli (I) took me to the Capodichino airport. I left the airport at 1500 hours and arrived at Rimas airbase at 1720 hours with pilot Lieut Jasnowski. I immediately delivered the papers to our office.

d. The jeep was unloaded from the Duca D'Aosta on the morning of 20 August. Pvt Merli (I) reported to me at 1100 hours this date. Pvt Merli (I) performed his duties exceptionally well and was of great value to me.

3. I feel that at no time was there any delay in returning due to any dilatory tactics on my part. My late arrival was caused by orders from officers senior to me in this organization with which I felt compelled to comply. Circumstances above and beyond my control caused me to do the best I could in this situation.

4. As per my letter orders, Allied Garrison of Sardinia, dated 9 August 1944, I report, mission completed.

SUBJECT: Delayed Sailing of Raimondo Montecucoli

MEMO TO: Colonel Simmons

1. On 13th May 1944 at 10:30 AM Captain Mitchell notified me that the cruiser Raimondo Montecucoli would be delayed 48 hours.
2. I immediately saw Commander Speer on the sailing of the Giuseppe Garibaldi. He refused to sail it alone with Nembo men on it. I pointed out the fact that it had only 500 Nembo men composed of Division Headquarters and for the most part non combatant troops, with personnel of other units totaling 750 men. He said he had orders from JINC MED not to sail it alone with Nembo men on it.
3. I reported the matter to Major Smith who referred it to the general. The general had Colonel Conine call Commander Speer to find out if he would sail the Scipione Africano with it. Commander Speer reported that the Scipione Africano was down for repairs and could not sail until night of the 14th.
4. After talking with Colonel Conine, the general decided the best thing to do was to unload Nembo personnel and equipment, substituting other personnel for the Nembo. Commander Speer agreed to leave Nembo equipment on board with 20 officers and 48 men as escort. The Giuseppe Garibaldi sailed as scheduled.
5. It was decided by the general and Col Conine to hold the Scipione Africano for an additional 24 hours; load Nembo personnel and sail it with the Raimondo Montecucoli. Commander Speer agreed.
6. At 5:00 PM on 13 May 44 Col Conine notified me in person at his office that the Raimondo Montecucoli would not sail for 10 days. In view of this Col Conine and I agreed to load the Scipione Africano for Duke and notify the Navy to maintain her schedule. Commander Speer agreed.
7. It was further decided, between Col Conine and myself, that the two cruisers upon their return would be loaded for Duke with remaining personnel of Nembo Division and be sailed together. Commander Speer agreed.

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8. For my part, I argued the point of not losing any more lifts than necessary. It is my opinion that the action taken was in the best interests of evacuating Italian personnel from the island with the least possible delay.
