

The 14th Special Food Depot in Cagliari in regard to information requested by your detachment in letter P/4 dated 22 May, informs us that weight of forage recorded referred to the amount actually received and not to the amount loaded at Naples; in fact for the quantity received, a proper receipt SARP 7 dated 13 April 1945 was released.

It is our opinion that the discrepancy between the forage loaded and what was received here, is due undoubtedly to the breaking of sacks with consequent losses during the trip as well as to the various loading and unloading operations for which an error in weighing the forage received is to be excluded.
