SUBJECT: Recall Personnel and Servicemen Awaiting Shipment.

TO : Commanding General, Land Forces Sub Com A.C. (MMIA).

1. Inclosed herewith is a copy of my letter to Commanding General, Italian Forces in Sardinia subject Callups dated 27 May 45 with instructions to terminate the callup program in Sardinia in accordance with your verbal instructions given to me at Rome last week (Conference of Col Kerr, Col Hooker, Major Stainton and myself). Note in par 2 of my above mentioned letter I also informed them as you instructed me verbally re issue of rations to military personnel on leave waiting here at port to return to Mainland. I also informed them verbally that the Reinforcement Company at Cagliari of page 52 of Italian Army Strength State No. 2/S was not authorized after being informed verbally by MMIA Rome in reply to par 3 of 1st Ind to my request for clarification of authorized units in Sardinia 30 April.

2. Also inclosed herewith letter from Headquarters Calabria I.S. Division No. 1202/B-2/Ord subject as above dated 28 May to Military Territorial Headquarters of Rome for your information. Inviting your attention particularly to the large number that came on the cruizers from mainland on leave during April and May. Your Headquarters was previously advised about this.

3. Request to be advised, in view letter mentioned par 2 above, if any change is made to existing instructions.

4. Request reply to our 1st Ind dated 30 April to letter from Military Territorial Hq of Rome, Sardinia Office, No. 243/Serv R.M. subject Units for Services in Sardinia dated 28 April 1945.

SUBJECT: Callups

TO : Commanding General, Italian Forces in Sardinia.

1. Confirming conference 26 May in my office. No callups of any of the three phases will be shipped to the mainland after the first cruiser in June, which is scheduled to sail 4 June. Any callups returning from hospital, AWOL etc after that date will either be absorbed in the authorized strength in Sardinia or sent home on indefinite leave to be called up later to fill in losses that may occur in the authorized strength.

2. After 4 June rations will not be issued to any military personnel in Sardinia waiting shipment for return to mainland, being here on leave. All rations issued must come within the authorized strength less rations for unauthorized personnel - on leave etc.

TO : Lieut Colonel Lester R. Albert  
MMA Liaison Officer for Sardinia Cagliari

Reference letter dated 27 May 1945, subject "Call-ups".

I informed the Military Territorial Headquarters of Rome with letter, copy of which is herewith enclosed, of measures that your MMA would like to take in regard to recalls, recruits and servicemen awaiting shipment, effective 5 June 1945.

Considering:

That the Complement Company of Cagliari is included in Form 2/6 of the MMA;

That servicemen awaiting shipment are part of the authorized strength of units to which they belong;

That the time required to cover the trip from places where the furlough was spent to the proper stations of servicemen concerned, is to be considered as a real and proper duty;

The particular conditions in Sardinia as far as traffic to the mainland is concerned;

The morale and disciplinary repercussions that the thorough execution of measures outlined by your MMA would provoke;

I kindly request you to recommend to MMA Rome that the Military ration be distributed to servicemen during their stay in Cagliari, properly attached to the Complement Company

SUBJECT: Recalled Personnel and Servicemen Awaiting Shipment.

TO : Military Territorial Headquarters of Rome.

I was informed by Lt. Colonel Albert - MHA Liaison Officer in Sardinia - with letter, copy of which is herewith enclosed, that effective 4 June 1945, date on which the last shipment of troops from Sardinia will take place, the following measures will be taken:

(a) No recalls and recruits will be further shipped to the mainland. They would have to be either absorbed by the Calabria I.S. Division and Territorial organizations up to the authorized strength or sent back home on unlimited furlough and recalled on service from time to time in accordance with personnel needed to fill up vacancies in the authorized strength;

(b) No military rations will be further issued to military personnel awaiting shipment for the mainland upon expiring of furlough of any type as well as for transfer because exceeding the authorized strength (servicemen discharged from hospital and fed with civilian rations, servicemen recovered from the North, patriots who have reach their respective units etc.)

In this regard I point out the following:

1) Recalls and Recruits: Considering that, if in Sardinia, upon last shipment of recalls and recruits (about 300) which will take place 4 June, about 1000 men to be recovered will be left behind because on furlough sick in hospitals and AWOL, such measures will be thoroughly taken. It would have a noteworthy morale repercussion since it will be not possible to absorb everybody in the authorized strength of units on the Island (deficiency in regard to authorized strength is of about 100 men) and we would facilitate in that way (excluding personnel recovered from hospital and furlough) those recalls and recruits that reported to service with delay for the own personnel benefit or who went over the hill at the time of departure.

It will be therefore my opinion to: insert the most deserving recruits and recalls (priority to the former) with units on the Island to meet possible discrepancies; to retain in service the remaining personnel recovered from time to time for later shipment to the mainland to the Presinone Training Center for further employment. Said personnel should be organized with the complement Company to be kept in operation/ 7471



2) Personnel Awaiting Shipment: Such measures thoroughly applied in Sardinia where the traffic with the mainland is bounded to the arrival and departure of surface craft, sea conditions, spaces available for Army Personnel, could originate some serious morale and disciplinary repercussions causing unrest by transit servicemen to whom, during their stay awaiting shipment for contingent necessities not subordinated to their will, no rations should be issued.

As known after 4 June the cruiser ferry service will be discontinued and the sole naval traffic with the mainland will be carried out twice a month by the Abazia on which 80 seats are reserved from the mainland to Sardinia and from Sardinia to the mainland.

The number of servicemen awaiting shipment and arrived to Sardinia with all possible means, was in the past few months increased a lot and the sole space allotted on the Abazia is no longer sufficient to cover the needs.

The following are the personnel arrived on Sardinia during the months of April and May:

who after some time, will report to the port of embarkation (Cagliari) in order to return to their stations, and there they will have to stay (often for several days) awaiting transportation.

So far, the material and morale assistance to those servicemen is displayed by the Autonomous Complement Company (shown in form 2/8 Italian Army strength as of 9 March 1945 with amendments up to 22 March 1945 issued by MIA category 6th page 21) which provide to feed them during their stay awaiting shipment. As a result of above reasons, the present strength of the Complement Company is of about 500 men and it is expected that it will be not changed much even after the shipment anticipated the 4th of June 1945.

In consideration that the MIA Form 2/8 authorizes the operation of the Complement Company, that most of servicemen awaiting shipment are part of the authorized strength of respective units of origin as well as the morale and disciplinary need of feeding transit personnel, it is necessary that the Complement Company be kept in operation (in this regard, see also letter 349/B-1/Ord dated 27 April 1945 this Hqs) and that the ministry of War be informed of the matter to obtain authority from MIA to continue to feed said servicemen with military rations. 7A In case that such request cannot be filled by the MIA due to superior agencies, it would authorize to supply said Company with civilian rations crediting the related expense to the Military Administration.

SUBJECT: Callups - Phase II

TO : Commanding General, Land Forces Sub Com A.C. (M.M.I.A.)  
Attention Major Stainton

1. Reference telephone conversation between Albert and Stainton 22 April re availability of Phase II callups.
2. Contacted Lt Col Costantino, Deputy Chief of Staff, CMS, and he stated they planned to call up 6300 and estimated approx 5000 would be obtained from this number. Allowing 1500 for physical rejects, hospital, AWOL, etc. He also stated that the Ministry of War advised him to call up a total of 6000 and the Ministry of War would advise him if a further number should be called up.
3. He further stated there were sufficient personnel in Sardinia to obtain the full 6000 for Phase II if required.
4. Request to be advised soonest full number required in Phase II.
5. Again informed Col Costantino to have the first 1000 Phase II ready for shipment 1 May and 1000 every four days thereafter until Phase II is completed.

The M.M.I.A. Liaison Office in Sardinia informed us that 1914 and 1915 Classes will not be recalled and that, consequently, the number of recalls to be shipped to the mainland is modified as follows:

No change in the 6,000 recruits of 1925 class concerning the II Phase.

On the basis of data experienced and supplied by Phase I which is about over, I deem it opportune to bring to your attention that it will not be possible to have 12,000 men to ship to the mainland out of recalled classes (1916-1924).

In fact:

In Phase I (1919-1924) the personnel to be recalled as per district and depot information were 15,000 men (round figure) from which there are 2,600 men for various exemptions and 600 men physically unqualified, equal to 22 per cent to be subtracted; 11,800 men remain.

In addition, considering the A.W.O.L.s and those hospitalized after the enrollment, equal to 10 percent and from which we cannot anticipate how many will be suitable for service (it will take a long time, of course), the personnel to be shipped to the mainland remain 10,700 men, 10,000 of which have already been shipped to the mainland as of 22 March.

Using the same percentage as a basis of anticipation in regard to the Phase III recalls (1916-1918), on the basis of information supplied by depots and districts, who muster 6,300 men, the personnel to be shipped to the mainland is 4,500 men.



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It results, therefore, that, between the I Phase and Phase III, recalls who can be sent to the mainland number 15,200 men (10,700 Phase I - 4,500 Phase III) plus those recoverable from those A.W.O.L. and from those hospitalized (1,700 men) for whom no antification can be made.

This is expected to produce about 100 results and have had about 100 in the Army before and will require basic training.
