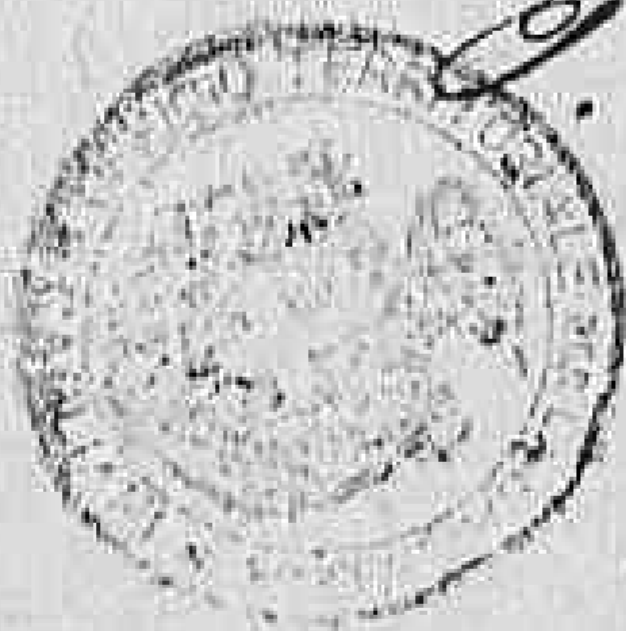

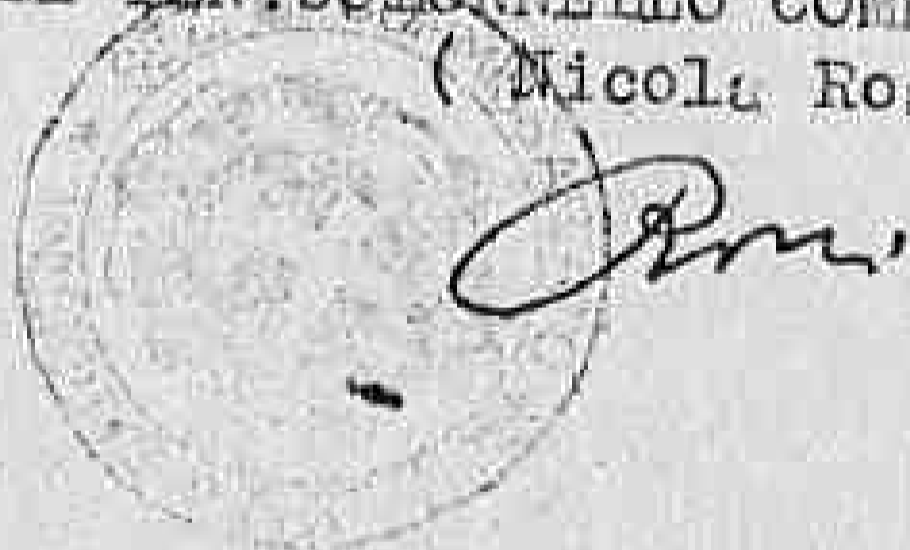

REPORT ON MATERIAL RECEIVED BY THE CLOTHING DEPOT OF CAGLIARI WHICH WAS SHIPPED FROM THE CLOTHING DEPOT OF NAPLES

The Year 1945, 18 September in Cagliari

BE IT KNOWN

that on 18 September 1945 the below Commission appointed by the local Commissary Section has gathered today at the Clothing Depot of Cagliari with a delegate of MMIA to check the quantities that arrived from the Clothing Depot of Naples on the S/S Abbazia and were unloaded today.

All the bales were intact and sealed.

After a check of the weight and of the contents, the following discrepancies were found between what was received and manifested.

Shoes repaired from Allied sources 792 pairs with a difference of 8 pair. The difference has been found in the following bales:

Sack No. 2-17 pair instead of 20 manifest weight 33 kgs  
actual weight 28.100 kgs  
Sack No 40-16 pair instead of 20 manifest weight 33 kgs  
actual weight 26.500 kgs  
Sack No 16-19 pair instead of 20 manifest weight 33 kgs  
actual weight 31.800 kgs

Among the shoes received there is one pair unuseable and the depot of Cagliari will turn in to the Salvage Center for repair, if repairable.

Shirts flannel and shirts dyed green - 1047 with a discrepancy of 3 shirts less. The discrepancy has been found in bale No 84 containing 57 shirts instead of 60. The weight has been found to be 29.800 kgs, the same as manifested.

Drawers wool Italian new - 450 of which 4 are torn.

Shaving soap in pieces of 500 grams be nominal weight. Received 1597 pieces with a discrepancy of 3 pieces less. The discrepancy has been found in case No. 72 containing 43 pieces in lieu of 46. The weight of the case was 24.500 kgs while the manifest said 25.500 kgs

Am of the opinion that this letter is now obsolete, as you will recall I brought to Rome an inventory of Barrack Stores held in depots outside of Cagliari and you stated the items you desired shipped to the mainland which was towels, mattress covers and stools. All the other Barrack Stores which includes approximately 190 tons of iron beds, a quantity of blankets, sheets, mattresses, pillows, sentinel coats, wooden tables are to remain on the Island. In regard to previous shipments of barrack Stores and to the ones that will take place from Sardinia to the mainland, we deem it opportune to bring the following to your attention:

In letter No. 1/561E/Serv. dated 23 December 1942 from SMRE and No. 5052/v dated 3 January 1945 from your Ministry, it was ordered that shipment to the mainland of all barrack stores exceeding the need for 12,000 men destined to remain in Sardinia and for an additional 10,000 men as a reserve stock for call-ups.

SMRE in message 3/418/Serv. dated 6 February 1945 confirmed the formation for a reserve of 10,000 bed sets.

Your Ministry, in endorsement No. 860/C dated 17 February 1945, forwarded a list of equipment to be shipped to the mainland, compiled by the Land Forces Sub Commission A.C. (MMA).

Since said list included all the primary important material available at the warehouses, the following was written by the formerly Military Commissary Directorate of Sardinia with letter E. 3/659/C.8 dated 22 February 1945:

"Since your Ministry in endorsement No. 860/C dated 17 February 1945, upon instructions from MMA, ordered to alert and ship **15** to the mainland all the equipment of primary importance existing on the Island, it will not be possible to neither form the forementioned reserve stock nor to meet the need for the normal change of bed stores to units in Sardinia, since at the warehouses there will be nothing left but unserviceable material not suitable for further use and a limited quantity of equipment to be readjusted".

As far as blankets are concerned, the Commissary Directorate of Sardinia supplied a detailed status in letter No. 3/539/C.8 dated 12 February 1945.

Your Ministry in message No. 834/C dated 28 February 1945 in reply to previous letter, instructed the formentioned Commissary Directorate to reach direct agreements with MIA Liaison Office Sardinia.

In consideration of the above and due to the fact that the MIA requested the shipment to the mainland of all barrack stores with no distinction existing with the warehouses on the Island, your Ministry is kindly requested to clarify the following:

- (1) whether or not the undersigned has to comply with the complete shipment of barrack stores.
- (2) whether the allocations of sets for 12,000 men as well as the reserve stock of 10,000 bed sets previously ordered is to be considered cancelled.
- (3) if and how the barrack stores service is to be ensured in the case that all such material is to be shipped, and above all as far as the normal change of bed stores to the units in the Island is concerned.

In regard to equipment in possession of the units, it is to be kept in mind that most of it is not recoverable since it was transferred to the mainland together with the units.

The undersigned recommends:

- (1) that a final arrangement be given to those servicemen destined to remain in Sardinia, issuing the proper bed set to those who are not in possession of same,
- (2) that authority be granted to substitute for straw mattress covers in possession of the men with mattresses.
- (3) that authority be granted to form a reserve stock with the special barrack stores depot of Cagliari for at least 5,000 complete bed sets both to meet the normal change of bed stores than for any other need.

Your Ministry is kindly requested to issue necessary instructions keeping in mind that the matter is of a most urgency considering the actual continuous shipment of stores to the mainland and to avoid the shipment of material which could become necessary later on on the Island.

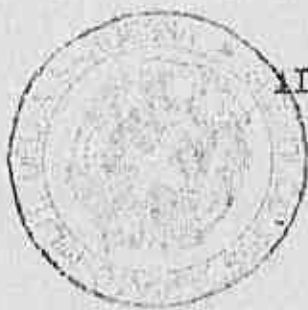


