SUBJ CT: Foreign Relations for Animals in Sardinia.

TO : Commanding General, Italian Army in Sardinia.

1. Reference is made to your letter file #25656, dated 23 August 1943, subject same as above.

2. The figure of 860 animals to be retained by the Italian Army in Sardinia is correct but of this number, only 800 are to be fed the full ration. The remaining 60 will be fed 2/3 of the ration.

3. In view of the fact that your Headquarters has advised the Sardinian Headquarters of the ABC that all animals to be disposed of have been disposed of as of 15 August, it is felt that your interrogatory in paragraph 2 b, of the above referred to letter, has already been answered.

SUBJECT: Forage rations for animals in Sardinia.

TO : Allied Garrison of Sardinia. (Ref. to ltr No. 464.9 dtd 14 Aug 44)

1.----- With letter No. 1046/1/91 dated 23 May 1944 (copy attached) the Allied Armed Forces Headquarters in Italy fixed the following forage rations for the animals in Sardinia:

- a-- Animals at the disposal of the Italian Army:
 - 800 with full rations,
 - 401 with 2/3 rations;
- b-- Animals about to be embarked to the mainland:
 - 897 with full rations;
- c-- Animals to be slaughtered or released on credit to farmers:
 - 673 with 2/3 rations.

The aforesaid has also been approved by Captain Stancil

With the letter referred to above, your headquarters informs that the foraging of animals in Sardinia was to be according to the following plan:

- a-- Full rations: all animals awaiting embarkation to the mainland;
- b-- 2/3 rations: horses to be held for the Italian Army;
- c-- 2/3 rations: all animals which are to be killed or given out;

Therefore, taking into account the present number of animals on the island, forage rations should be as follows:

- a-- 2/3 rations: to the 850 horses at the disposal of the Italian Army;
- b-- Full rations: to all animals about to be shipped to the mainland (at present 40 horses and 16 mules).

2.----- In consideration of the difference between the contents of letter No. 1046/1/91 dated 23 May 1944 and what was approved by your headquarters with letter No. 464.9 dated 14th of this month, you are requested to specify as follows:

(LETTER CONT'D)

a-- What rations are to be given to the 800 horses which were left at the disposal of the Italian Army.

b-- Where any distribution of Allied rations is to be immediately discontinued for the animals which are about to be killed or released on credit to farmers (the above release was initiated at Cristano on the 15th of this month) as shown by paragraph 7 of the letter referred to above.

3.----- As to the increase of the number of full rations as distributed in the 2 weeks, 31 July - 6 August and 7 - 13 August (one thousand instead of eight hundred) it is informed as follows:

a-- From 26 June to 23 July last, in consideration of the fact that the animals to be released on credit to farmers had not yet been gathered at Cristano and that therefore the distribution of the two different rations (full and 2/3) was difficult to be made, since selected animals and those about to be released were mixed up with the units and also taking into account the remarkable fractioning of animals with the various units, only the reduced rations were distributed to all animals alike.

b-- With the purpose of bettering the condition of the animals, most of which were still emaciated, the number of horses rationed in full, which amounted to 800 in the period 24 - 30 July, had been increased to 1,000 for the above two weeks with a larger consumption of 84 quintals of barley and 112 of straw, which were widely compensated by the quantity of forage (448 quintals of barley and straw) gathered in consequence of the distribution of a lower ration in the period of time as per paragraph a.

The equalization with the number of due rations has anyhow been effected in the last week as follows:

- Full rations to 800 horses
- 2/3 rations to (215 horses
(75 mules.

4.----- As far as the Carabinieri animals are concerned, it is hereby assured that directions were given for the foraging with 2/3 rations, and they will appear separately in the next weekly status report.

1. Colonel SIMMONS visited this headquarters on 22 May 1944 and gave the following status of animals in Sardinia. The figures are different from those given in paragraph 4(B) of letter, this headquarters, file 1046/1/Q1, dated 31 May 1944, and in paragraph 3 of letter No. 1046/1/Q1, dated 12 May 1944. The figures refer to the status of 22 May and thus they are more recent than those previously given:
 - a) left at the disposal of the Italian Army in Sardinia:

1081 draft-horses
120 saddle-horses
 - b) available for the mainland:

612 mules
285 saddle horses
 - c) to be slaughtered or released on credit to farmers:

673 horses over 15 years old

2. The animals as per paragraph 2(B) will be available from 1 June on.
3. It has been agreed with Colonel SIMMONS that the rations will be distributed as follows:
 - a) left at the disposal of the Italian Army in Sardinia:

800 with full rations
401 with 2/3 rations
 - b) animals about to be embarked:

897 with full rations

 - c) to be slaughtered or released on credit to farmers:

673 with 2/3 rations.

4. Disposition of these animals should be made as soon as possible. Col. SIMMONS is requested to contact Capt. ABROT, RAVC, 13th Field Butchery, located near Cagliari. Capt. ABROT will see as to which animals are to be slaughtered and which are to be released to farmers.

5. It has been decided that the A.A.I. will provide for the shipment of forage to Sardinia and that AFHQ will presently issue instructions on the matter.
