On 28 October at 0030 hours at Iglesias at a dance which was given at the cinema Olympia a tall red headed British Captain, a W.O., a sergeant and a soldier who said that they belonged to the British police in company of an Italian Air Corps Lieutenant crashed into the dance. All were drunk. Angry because the ladies whom they invited refused to dance with them, the captain grabbed a young man by the neck, who unintentionally bumped into him, and shoved him against some women who were sitting on chairs along the wall. The people were angry at this behavior and surrounded them with the intention of beating them up. The CC.RR. and the Questura Agents saved them from a beating. The British officer, RM and Italian officer left, without being identified, in a British car number XAF 108025 - 63 S.P.

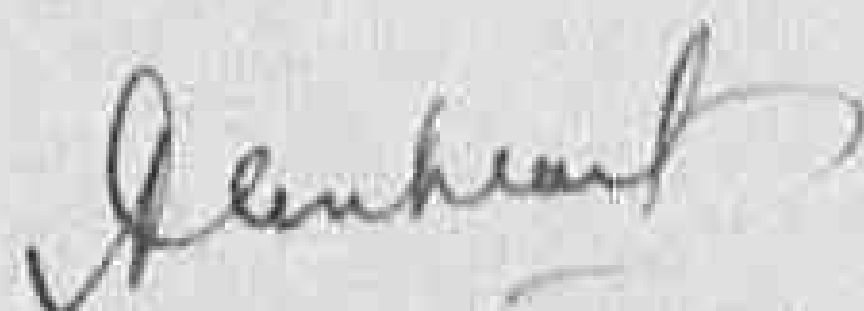

(d) Logs, various	40 each
(e) Salvaged timber	100 tons

We repeat that the above numbers are approximate. For the foreseen needs on the Island that is for packings of material to be shipped to the mainland and for other various small works, we estimate to use a few cubic meters of the above timber. Therefore, the above figures will undergo slight invaluable changes.

You must consider that the timber in question is out in the open exposed to the weather from some years and therefore we estimate that a part of it can not be used.

Reference verbal request, you are informed:

1. There are no sectional huts in good or fair condition save one, the dimensions of which have been reduced to 6 X 20 meters. This hut, for which Ministerial authorization has already been received, is stored and is to be turned over to the XIV Mobilization Center of the Italian Red Cross, located at Cagliari.

2. Available are only odd sections of huts returned by the units, the assembling of which has been suspended due to orders received concerning the shipment of materials to the mainland.

It is, nevertheless, believed that from said material, after appropriate repairs, more than ten huts of about 6 X 32 meters dimensions can be recovered.

3. No huts have been shipped to the mainland nor are any huts ready for shipment.

4. On the basis of information received there is a total of 97 huts (6 X 32 meters) still erected on the island of which it is believed that about twenty complete huts of the same measurements can be drawn upon dismantling, withdrawal and repairs.
