1. Reference is made to your letter dated 12 December, same subject.
2. Information requested in said letter was immediately passed to the Autonomous Military Maritime Headquarters of La Maddalena, which in turn informed the Naval Ministry of the matter.
3. Naval Ministry stated that no information has yet been received from the War Ministry and therefore no agreement has been reached in this matter. Consequently they are unable to issue orders concerning the employment of the specialized personnel in question.
4. In such circumstances this headquarters regrets being unable to supply the information requested. It is recommended that the aforesaid agreement between Ministries be requested and that this matter be cleared directly between your Subcommission and the Naval Ministry.



1. Following on the disbandment of Italian Anti-aircraft and Coast Defence batteries a number of Italian Naval personnel have become available for disposal. Amongst them are 700 men now in SARDINIA.
2. You are requested to arrange direct with the Ministry of War for these men to be screened by a Ministry of War representative, with a view to selecting any specialists suitable for inclusion in the Italian Army, and re-allocation to the Combat Groups.
3. Please inform WLA in due course of the numbers so selected and where they are located. WLA will then bid for shipping priority to the mainland.
4. Non-specialist personnel are not required and will be disposed of by the Ministry of War.
