1. With circular 1940/OM dated 15 September, War Ministry gave new instructions regarding distribution of tires and tubes.

Therefore:

1. All tires and tubes will be replaced at the 14th Repair Unit.
2. The unit concerned must:
 - a) Fill out and send to this office form C (Attached).
 - b) On communication from this office, the vehicle which must have tires replaced or changed should be sent to the 14th Repair Unit.
3. The C.O. of the 14th Repair Unit, when he receives from this office form C signed by the MTA Transportation Officer, must:
 - a) Ascertain that the vehicle is on N/S of Army Unit (check windshield label number).
 - b) Have the workshop director ascertain that the tire or tube to be changed is not fit to be used any more.
 - c) Change the tire.
 - d) Fill out another 3 copies of the a/m form C for own use.
4. The 14th Repair Unit:
 - a) After having made the entries on Tire Register as per No. 5 - paragraph III of a/m circular will also enter in the vehicle booklet the date, place, size, serial number and make of the tires changed.
 - b) Will use exchanged tires as indicated in paragraph I - No. 3 of a/m letter.
5. The C.O. of the 14th Repair Unit will not change the tires if the Workshop Director says that the tires can still be used.
6. All other directives on this matter are rescinded.

7. Vehicle booklet and form C will be issued later. In the meantime every vehicle should have a card which will show all movements of tires.
8. Hq Calabria Division will give same instructions to dependent units.

SUBJECT: Instructions for Conservation, Supply, Accounting, Transfer and Distribution of Tires.

TO : OMITTED

1. The availability of Army tires is limited to the quantities on hand at spare part warehouses and at Repair Units and from those which will be gradually recovered or bought on the free market. For their conservation, supply, accounting, transfer and distribution, the directives of this letter will be adhered to.

I-CONSERVATION

2. In the tire section of the warehouses the tires must be divided:

- by type (tubes, tires, hard tires).
- by state of use (new, used, repairable, to be recapped, vulcanized, not usable).
- by sizes.

3. Those which are declared not usable, by the usual procedure, will be salvaged.

Those which are repairable with a simple vulcanization will be repaired at the repair Units or civilian firms and then passed to the "used" class.

Those which must be recapped will be sent monthly to the 8th H.R. Auto.

II-SUPPLY

4. The warehouses are supplied:

- a. by transfers, ordered by War Ministry.
- b. by receiving tires from recovered vehicles or by tires turned in by units.
- c. by receiving recovered tires or from other sources.
- d. by buying them on free market.

III-ACCOUNTING

5. Besides the normal registers the warehouses must keep a tire register in which the tires must be registered separately by type(tires, tubes, hard tires), and by class (new, used, repairable) and listed by sizes with respective serial numbers.

For every change an entry must be made.

6. So that this Ministry may follow carefully the tire situation the repair units will forward the following returns:

a. Form "A", in duplicate, on the 1st of each month and must refer to the tire situation at 1800 hours of the last Sunday of the previous month.

b. Form "B", in duplicate, must be forwarded on every Monday and contain all changes of the week up to 1800 hours of each Sunday.

IV-Transfers

7. When tires or tubes are shipped from 1 warehouse to another a committee must be appointed which must write out a statement specifying the condition of each tire.

V DISTRIBUTION

8. The change of tires will take place at the Repair Units.

Before changing a tire the C.C. of the Repair Unit must:

a. Ascertain that the vehicle is on W/R of Army unit.

b. Have the form "C" filled out.

c. have the form "C" signed by the MTA LO.

The tires will not be changed if the tires can still be used.

9. The units, once the tires have been changed, will make proper entries in vehicle booklet.

VI-DEMANDS

10. Requests for tires and tubes must be sent to Ministry on 15th and 30th of each month.

11. Circulars No. 25100, 7300, 9800, 14800 and 3800 are rescinded.

7. When tires or tubes are shipped from 1 warehouse to another a committed must be appointed which must write out a statement specifying the condition of each tire.

V DISTRIBUTION

8. The change of tires will take place at the Repair Units. Before changing a tire the C.O. of the Repair Unit must:

- a. Ascertain that the vehicle is on W/E of Army unit.
- b. Have the form "C" filled out.
- c. Have the form "C" signed by the MMIA LO.

The tires will not be changed if the tires can still be used.

9. The units, once the tires have been changed, will make proper entries in vehicle booklet.

10. Requests for tires and tubes must be sent to Ministry on 15th and 30 th of each month.

11. Circulars No. 25100, 7300, 9800, 14800 and 3800 are rescinded.





In compliance with message referred to, forwarded herewith are the charts concerning the existence of tires at the dependent warehouses.

It is pointed out that the 13th Auto Park took the census of all the worn out tires instead of the "used tires to be rebuilt". This is due to the sizable number of worn out tires (more than 5,000) piled up at the warehouse for which the selection of each one to establish its possibility of being repaired would require a long time and the use of many men which are not now available.

It is estimated that 35-40% of the tires can be repaired.

The inner tubes which can be profitably repaired are around 65-70%.

It is to be kept in mind that the removal of tires from vehicles is continuing, and it is believed that more than 4000 tires can still be removed.

In regard to the fact that tires and inner tubes reported as usable must be left untouched, this HQ brings to your attention that 95% of such material is coming from vehicles turned over to the Park, being repaired by the Park, and the Park, consequently, cannot return said vehicles if there are no tires in good condition. In addition numerous agencies are requesting authorization to change tires which are in such bad condition as to render the vehicles inoperative.


