Ref your letter of 11 May on above subject.

1. The detail of units shown as under command of the Allies in SARDINIA was provided by the Italian General Staff. AA defence is shown separately as under command of AFHQ.
2. Since you state that our information is incomplete please forward as soon as possible the details of Italian Army units requested in our G/11/1 of 2 May so that AAI may be informed. Please show AA units separately. For your information AAI had been allowing for a total of 20,000 in their proposals to AFHQ.
3. Our signal SD/27 of 24 March asked you for a bulk figure of all ranks employed by the Allies in SARDINIA to reach this HQ by 15 and 30 of each month. This was never received here.
4. The infirm is now required in detail and above signal can be considered cancelled.
5. This matter has become important because the units under command of the Allies (other than AA defence which is under AFHQ and counted separately) must be registered in the Order of Battle to count against the ceiling of 180,000 tons that AAI has proposed to AFHQ for employment by the Allies.
6. After the units under command of the Allies in SARDINIA have been correctly registered in the Order of Battle, any further requirements of the Allied Garrison in SARDINIA should be passed to AAI for approval and inclusion in the Priority List.
7. It is not known whether AGS have had any instructions from AAI in this respect but we were led to understand that this would be the procedure in future so that a proper check of the overall manpower situation could be kept.
8. If all the personnel employed by AGS are NOT in formed units, they should be formed into units (with the necessary admin HQ's) so that an Order of Battle can be prepared as on the Mainland.

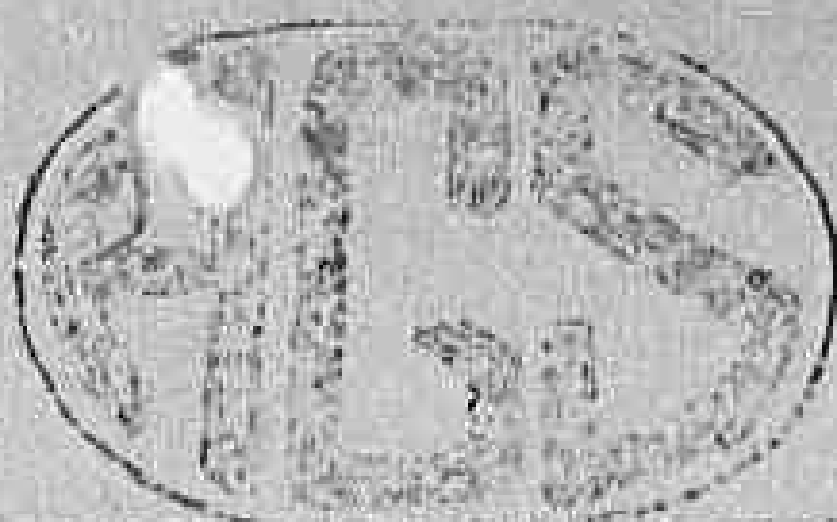

1. Three officers and 54 men of the Italian Army were detailed by General Webster, former Allied Garrison Commander, Sardinia, to recover Allied wire when the Air Corps evacuated Sardinia. At that time, this personnel was carried as a part of the 205 Division. On the transfer of the 205 Division to the mainland, this personnel remained in Sardinia on this work.

2. The time necessary to complete this work is not known exactly. It is therefore proposed to leave the personnel on this job until the work is completed, at which time the personnel can be transferred to the mainland. This will result in a temporary increase in the garrison, and the personnel can be carried in the ITI-ITI Category (Reinforcements) for the time being, as a temporary unit.
