SUBJECT: Tires for A.C. Mining Division;

TO : Liaison Officer, (M.M.I.A.), Allied Commission,
Sardinia.

1. Reference is made to Routing Slip, Hq MTOUSA, dated 18 July 1945 and to informal note from Col. Kerr dated 20 July 1945, subject as above.

2. Tires and tubes in question were obtained from the 9th Air Force Ordnance Depot under authority of letter Hq AGS, dated 22 April 1944 through regular Supply channels. Tires and tubes (600 x 16), applying to the above mentioned letter, were delivered on Shipping Tickets, 9th Air Force Ord Depot, Vouchers Numbers, OD-9-5287-44 and OD-9-5298-44 and signed for by an Officer of the Mining Division, Allied Commission.

3. Written authority has been obtained from Headquarters A.C. to sell the tires to Mining Companies in Sardinia at prices from 1200 to 2000 lire each depending on condition.

4. Certificates of ownership have been prepared giving complete description of the tires and the vehicle upon which they are to be used. These certificates are signed by an Officer of the Transportation Sub-Commission, Allied Commission, Rome.
