My Dear

1. This is just a very brief recorded impression of my recent visit to the following MANTOVA units: 76 and 114 Infantry Regts, 155 Arty Regt, 104 Sup and Tpt Coy, 79 Engineer Coy.

2. There appear to be three main problems facing the MANTOVA which are (i) the shortage of drivers and other specialists at this stage of training (ii) the considerable numbers of young untrained volunteers who have been posted to the group to make up its numbers (iii) the shortage of coy comds.

I shall get a better picture of how (i) and (iii) can be put right when I see the Group again next month (see also my visit and re shortage coy comds) and will discuss these points with you. (ii) is a disadvantage which cannot be righted but which is already having a delaying effect on training and which may I believe prove an embarrassment in battle.

3. Discipline, morale and state of interior cooking are all good in 114 and 155. If the remainder of the Gp were up to this standard I should say things were going well. As it is, which I think the other units inspected were either only just average or below average. I have taken all round things are quite obvious. Getting better by day and the change which has taken place since I last inspected the MANTOVA in CAIARELLA is astonishing.

The trouble is that it is now a fight against time.

I am too little training to be able to judge its progress but as you know DDD and Increment are by and large satisfied.

4. I believe the two senior officers need changing but I deal with this better on my return to MMA by which time Aubrey Gibson will either be agreed or disagreed with my views.

6. The SIU and Training Increment are, I consider excellent. They both work very hard and relations with the Italians are most cordial. They all tend perhaps to be a bit too optimistic and I have been endeavouring to curb this tendency.

Gibson sometimes has difficulties with Bologna who can as you know be both awkward and petty and whom I consider he handles very well.

7. In conclusion I believe that the MANTOVA has made great progress. But I rather doubt whether it is sufficiently advanced to keep pace with the programme laid down (I understand) for releasing the GLORE and bringing it into battle. This state of affairs can and I hope will be remedied. Again I will discuss when in Rome.

8. Other minor problems for discussion when I am next in Rome are:

- (i) Shortage of NCO's
- (ii) Desertion
- (iii) Leave
- (iv) Welfare

A stinking cold has been sabotaging my enjoyment of this pleasant climate but I'm bearing up and tomorrow I leave for Hall's chateau.

MEMORANDUM:

TO: Brigadier General Robert M. Webster
Commanding General, U. S. Forces in Sardinia

1. Major General Arthur R. Wilson, Commanding General, Peninsular Base Section, has orders sending him to Sardinia and Corsica for various investigations related to PBS activities, - particularly those related to the employment of Italian Army units in PBS, and the further recruitment of such units from Italian Army personnel in these islands.
2. In his party for this trip will probably be included General Antonio Sasso, Commanding General, FF AA, Campania, (formerly Italian Commander in Sardinia), the undersigned as PBS Chief Liaison Officer and others of both General Wilson's and General Sasso's staffs, with interpreters.
3. If other matters permit this party will probably fly to Cagliari from Naples on Sunday, 11 June 44, - or if delayed, then on the following day. One day's time should suffice in Cagliari, and then another day probably be spent in visiting Corsica - though more time may develop to be necessary.
4. It will be appreciated if your headquarters could arrange in advance so that appropriate Italian Commanders, and those of your own staff who might be interested in this program, could be ready to meet this party, on this schedule. It is particularly desired that arrangements be worked out for screening and selecting desired skills and qualifications in the men and officers to be shipped to Campania (under MMIA orders) and to arrange for their proper equipping and supply prior to their shipment. The resources available for such purposes are particularly desired for survey.
5. The undersigned looks forward to renewal of very pleasant associations in Cagliari, - remembered from a visit made last January. General Wilson will appreciate the opportunity to visit your island area, and to make those same contacts, - as have been described to him. It is not desired to interfere in any way, or to burden your staff, in connection with these items, - which are only of prime interest to PBS, in view of the new leads recently placed on it, and the necessity of greater reliance upon Italian units as guard, labor and service troops.
