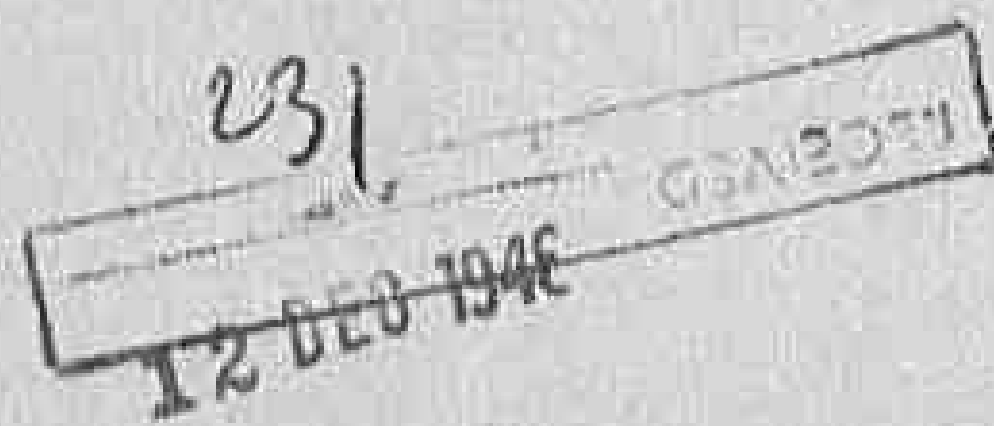

FREQUENCY ALLOTMENT NO. 1

1. This frequency allotment supersedes CSO 13 Corps Frequency Allotment No. 21 effective 1 Jan 46 and CSO 3 District's Signal Instruction No. 38 dated 30 Sep 46 which will both be destroyed by fire.
2. Frequency allotments as at appx 'A' and the layout of GHQ CMT wireless links at appx 'B' are effective from 1 Dec 46.
3. The minimum power output necessary to provide satisfactory communication will not be exceeded. Some sets (e.g. SCR 299) are equipped with power reduction, while the radiated power of all sets can be limited by reducing the size of the aerial. Specific powers of frequencies have been allotted which will not be exceeded, rather a lower power should be used if it will get through.
4. The SCR 211 is the standard frequency meter throughout CMT. All control station frequencies will be established with the aid of SCR 211 or other wavemeter which has been recently calibrated against an SCR 211. Frequency deviation will not be made.

5. (a) No 18, 38 and 48 sets may operate over their entire frequency ranges providing the use of channels is co-ordinated by formation Sig Officers with other formations in the immediate area. Frequency bands 30 - 40 Kc/s wide will be allotted to users. The control station will select the quietest spot in the allotted band and set outstations to this frequency.
- (b) The 19 B set may use the entire band 230 - 250 mc/s.
- (c) SCR 194 (US) may use the entire band 27 - 39 mc/s.
- (d) SCR 195 (US) may use the entire band 39 - 52 mc/s.

1. This frequency allotment supersedes CSO 13 Corp. Frequency allotment No. 21 effective 1 Jan 46 and CSO 3 District's Signal Instruction No. 38 dated 30 Sep 45 which will both be destroyed by fire.

5. (a) No 18, 33 and 45 sets may operate over their entire frequency ranges providing the use of channels is co-ordinated by formation Sig Officers with other formations in the immediate area. Frequency bands 30 - 40 kc/s wide will be allotted to users. The control station will select the quietest spot in the allotted band and set outstations to this frequency.

(b) The 19-B set may use the entire band 230 - 250 mc/s.

(c) SCR 194 (US) may use the entire band 27 - 39 mc/s.

(d) SCR 195 (US) may use the entire band 39 - 52 mc/s.

(e) SCR 508, 509, 510, 528 and 293 may use the entire band 20.1 to 27.9 mc/s at even 100 kc intervals.

(f) SCR 608, 609, 610 and 628 may use entire band 27 - 38.9 mc/s at even 100 kc intervals.

6. Two copies of the sub-allocation of frequencies by formations and units will be sent to this GHQ and all subsequent changes of allocation will be notified immediately.

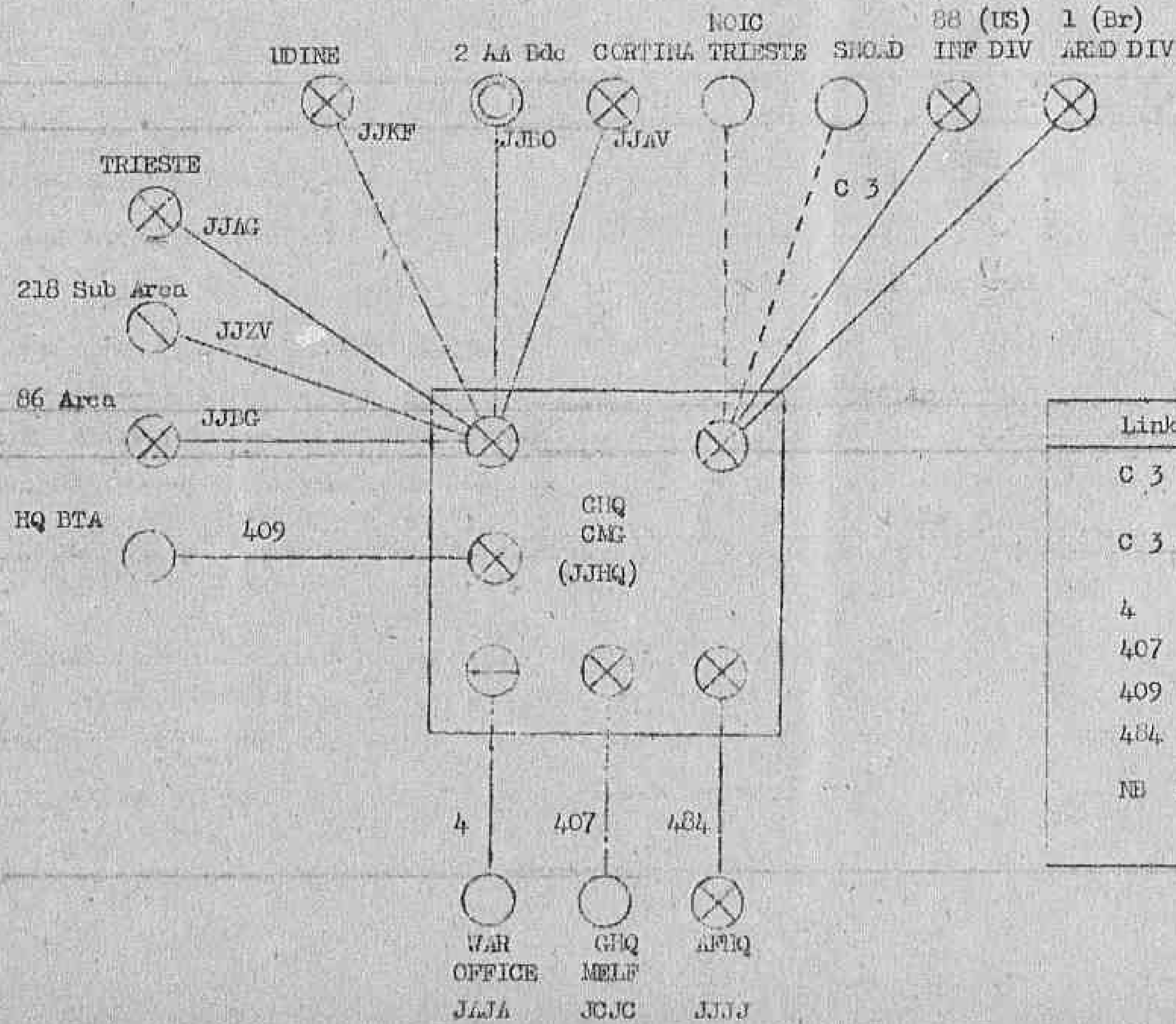

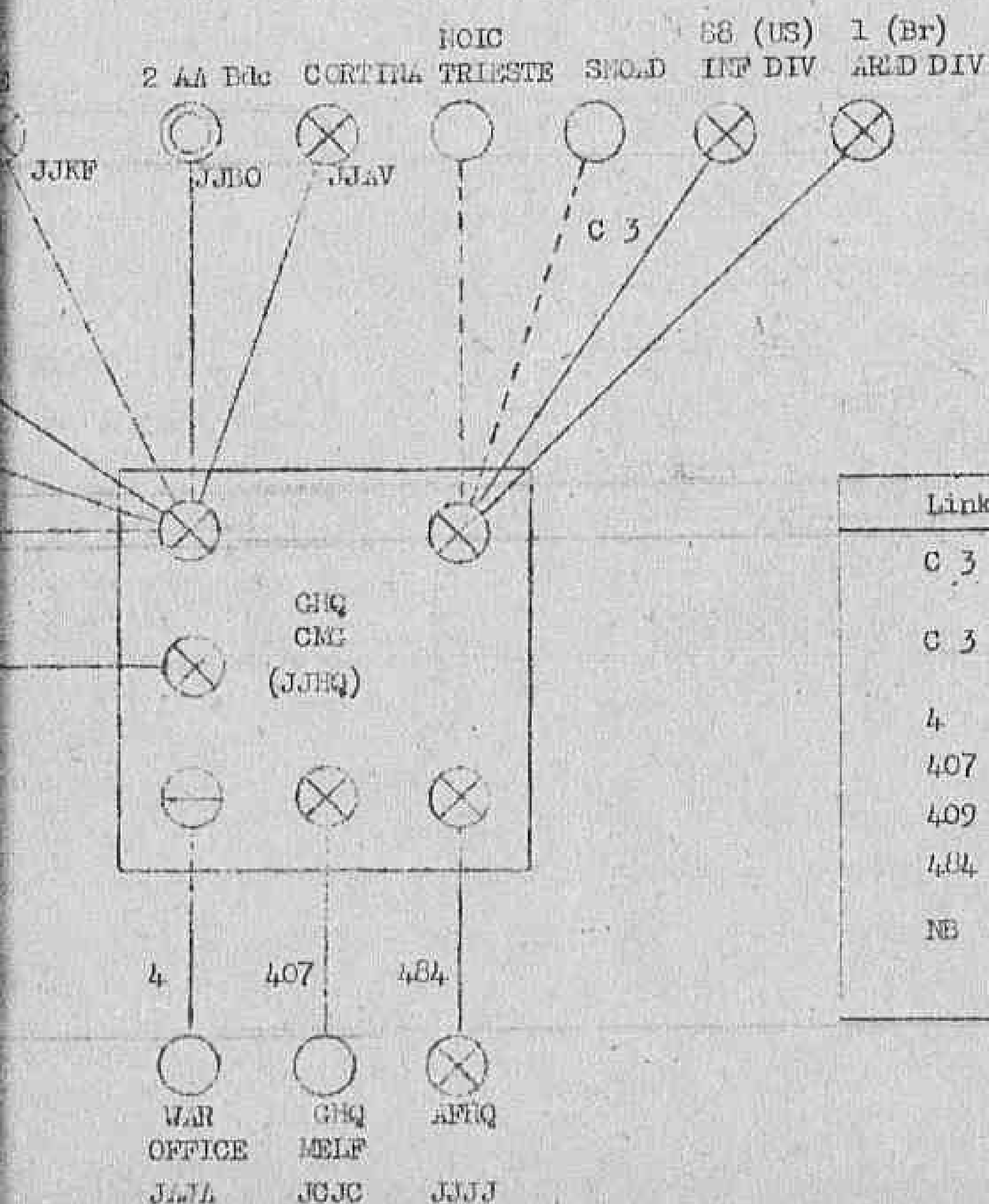

1. Several interesting paragraphs have recently appeared in B.L.U. Progress Reports covering welfare activities in Territorial Commands. A meeting has been held between representatives of H.Q. M.M.I.A. and officers of the welfare branch of the Ministry of War. It is felt that the time is now opportune to ask B.L.U.'s for a welfare report on activities generally and on the following points in particular.

2. The following information is available and further details are required from B.L.U.'s on the matters mentioned.

- a. Welfare Hostels - are known to exist in certain commands and to provide lodging and entertainment for troops on leave for certain periods. Details or nil reports are required.
- b. Voluntary Welfare Workers - are known to have organised welfare committees in some Commands and to be engaged in club, canteen entertainment, intellectual and other activities. It is believed that they in some cases combine with the C.A.P. Details as to the extent to which these activities are proving successful, of any difficulty due to political bias and of the extent to which the command Welfare Officer and the voluntary workers are pulling together, would be appreciated.
- c. The S.A.P.A.M. Organisation - is reported to be functioning in some commands but to be hampered by lack of capital with which to procure material. Has the possibility of a loan or credit from either manufacturers or bankers been considered? What is the present position and actual value of this organisation?
- d. Hospital welfare - is non-existent in some hospitals, whereas in others it is believed that very good results are being obtained from the efforts of the O.G. Hospital and of the voluntary workers. Please report particularly on the hospitals in your command.
- e. Entertainment - appears to be well organised; these should be no overlapping between the welfare and the public relations aspect. Entertainment by the troops for the troops is a welfare matter. Entertainment involving civil and either as performers or as audience is a public relations affair. Please report the situation.
- f. Welfare Officers, Staff and Transport - please report the present situation and whether satisfactory or not.

2. The following information is available and further details are required from B.L.U.'s on the matters mentioned.

- a. Welfare Hostels - are known to exist in certain commands and to provide lodging and entertainment for troops on leave for certain periods. Details or nil reports are required.
 - b. Voluntary Welfare Workers - are known to have organised welfare committees in some Commands and to be engaged in club, canteen entertainment, intellectual and other activities.  - e. Entertainment - appears to be well organised; these should be no overlapping between the welfare and the public relations aspect. Entertainment by the troops for the troops is a welfare matter. Entertainment involving civil and either as performers or as audience is a public relations affair. Please report the situation.
 - f. Welfare Officers, Staff and Transport - please report the present situation and whether satisfactory or not.
3. Any other subjects of interest should be included.
4. Although the British army idea of army welfare has been most readily accepted by the majority of the Italian Army Officers concerned, it may be that there are still some of the old school who regard it as quite unnecessary, or often detrimental. It is felt that you will have the full support of Territorial Commanders if, on finding any such attitude you will bring it to their notice. Your opinion on this matter generally should be included in the general report which should reach H.Q. M.M.I.A. by 18th October 1946.
