In view of the fact that British Army Signals are no longer operating in Milan, and in accordance with the present GHO C&P policy of reducing all local telephone service to an essential minimum, it is felt that the Italian Army should now assume responsibility for the provision and accounting of all BLU telephones.

4. Will you please forward your comments on this suggestion and if in agreement, arrange in conjunction with CC 1 L of G Sig Regt for the telephones concerned to be transferred from British Army to Italian Army accordingly.

1. Congestion on telephone lines within the AC building has become serious and is interfering communications from headquarters. This has been brought to the attention of most subscribers by their inability to get an outside line when dialing "00".

2. There are two reasons for this congestion. One is the large number of unofficial calls, particularly by divisions. The other, and most important, is the excessive number of lines on the AC exchange. A reduction of 20 percent of lines now operating is necessary for proper traffic flow.

3. The AC telephone exchange has two blocks of lines. One, the unrestricted (300-599), the subscriber can call all numbers in the building, and he can also call all numbers available to the home exchange by dialing "00". The other block, the restricted (600-799), can call all three digit numbers in the building, but cannot call outside.

4. It is requested that you review unrestricted numbers in your section least urgently needed, and have telephones carrying a high percentage of intra-building traffic changed to restricted numbers.

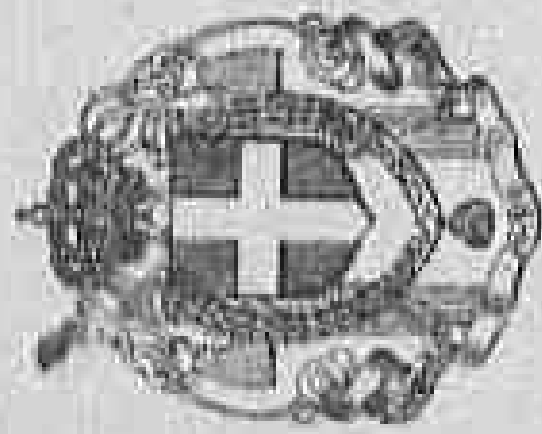



1. Several cases have been brought to the attention of this office where "urgent" long distance calls have been placed over the military wire network which, when monitored, cannot be considered to warrant a precedence of "urgent".

2. Specific reference is made to the following call:

a. Telephone call placed by Captain CRAIG, Allied Commission, Supply and Transportation Liaison, Naples 53878, to Captain MILES, Rome 489081, Ext. 526, on 12 March 1945 at 1656 hours, relative to stock records on military vehicles and availability of Italian truck drivers.

3. It should be realized that telephone operators are required to interrupt established connections which may have a precedence of "operational priority" or "priority", where necessary, in order to complete an "urgent" call. As the highest precedence which can be given an administrative call is "priority", it is evident that the call referred to in 2 a above cannot properly be considered as "urgent".

4. It is requested that necessary action be initiated to prevent any recurrence in the assignment of excessive precedence to long distance telephone calls by personnel of the Allied Commission.

1. The following amendment and addition to Office Memorandum No. 9 (originally published as Administrative Instruction No. 2 Adv Hq, 5 July 1944), is published for the information and guidance of all concerned.
2. In accordance with Signal Instructions from Allied Force Headquarters, the following additional instructions are published for the guidance and compliance of originators of outgoing cables:
 - a. Originators will include the security classification as the first word of the text of all classified messages, i.e., Restricted, Confidential, Secret and Top Secret (TOPSEC).
 - b. Messages franked "In clear by any means" will not have those words as the first groups of the text, but "In clear by any means" will be shown in the normal position in the heading of the message.
3. Sections and Sub-Commissions will receive all incoming cables with the security classification shown as the first group or groups of the text, whether the cables are classified or not. This function will be performed by the Adjutant's Department in the processing and distribution of incoming cables.

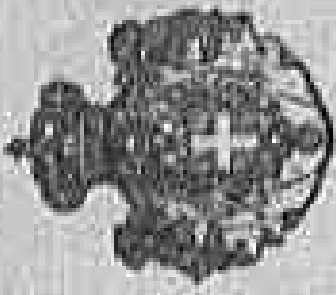



2. 1. 3. All commanders, army, navy and air, of all echelons therefore requested to take positive action within their commands:

a. Restrict Long Distance (or Toll) service to the staff officers or agencies requiring such service for the performance of essential operational duties. It is obvious that if numbers of telephones have access to Long Distance, then staff officers really needing the lines will find them "Busy" or "Engaged" when they are needed.

b. Informing and instructing all personnel as to:

- (1) Critical shortage of Long Distance or toll facilities
- (2) Necessity for BREVITY of calls.
- (3) Importance of making notes beforehand as to subjects to be covered, to permit prompt completion of call.
- (4) Necessity for remaining immediately accessible to telephone after a Long Distance call is initiated.

4. Insofar as AFHQ-NATOUSA Headquarters is concerned:

a. Long Distance service on all AFHQ-NATOUSA installations and long distance service for all headquarters served by FREEDOM exchange will be limited to 40% of the total local lines installed.

b. The Chief of each general and special staff section of AFHQ-NATOUSA, C-in-C, MED, and C-in-C MAAF (including Macaf), will submit by 1200 hours, 27 July 1944, a list by FREEDOM numbers, insofar as practicable, of the phones installed or being installed for to be allowed access to long distance facilities in accordance with the above policy.

5. Monitoring service on Long Distance calls is being inaugurated at once. Violations of the provisions of this directive, as indicated by unnecessary calls, unofficial calls overly classified as to urgency, ~~xxx~~ etc., will be reported through command channels to proper commanders for necessary corrective action.



18/7ACC HEADQUARTERS TELEPHONE INSTALLATIONS AND ALLOCATIONS

1. The telephone installation in the Ministry of Corporations Building is considered adequate for the needs of ACC Headquarters. However, there is need for economy in the installation of telephone, as traffic in a Headquarters such as this is heavy, and extensions to existing control office equipment may be difficult of accomplishment.

2. The Headquarters Commandant has therefore made an allotment of telephones to each Section or Independent Sub-Commission. Assignment of telephones from this allotment to individual members of Sections or Independent Sub-Commissions will be made by the Senior Officer of each Section or Independent Sub-Commission.

3. Requests for installation of telephones will be made in duplicate on the attached form, which can be obtained at Room 10, 1st Floor.

4. There are three kinds of telephone service available. All three require use of dial.

a. Connection to ACC switchboard - unrestricted service:

Can by dialing number desired call any telephone connected to ACC switchboard. By dialing "zero" is connected to Telephone Company network and can then dial any number connected to each network. All incoming calls from outside are handled by the ACC operator.

b. Connection to ACC switchboard - restricted: Can make and receive calls to or from any telephone connected to ACC switchboard but cannot make or receive calls from city network.

c. Direct connection to Telephone Company Ross City system: This permits calling other units whose switchboards have dial numbers or any telephone connected to city network. However, to call a telephone connected to ACC switchboard, the switchboard number must be dialed and operator asked for desired party.

5. All requests for telephone service must be signed by Senior Officer of Section or Independent Sub-Commission or his authorized delegate. (Requests from individuals cannot be accepted). Name of delegated officer should be furnished promptly to the Communications Officer, Room 10, 1st Floor.

6. The number of personnel available to install telephones is limited, so that, with the large number of telephones to be installed, it will not be possible to give service as rapidly as may be desired. Every effort will be made to expedite installations.

Subject: RAAC Signal Administrative Instructions.

To: All units within the Rome Allied Area Command.

1. All allocations of Rome Allied Area telephone and teletype circuits will be made by the Signal Officer, RAAC. This includes all local Rome Allied Area installations and long lines except for those tactical long distance requirements of Armies and Base Installations, or commitments of Long Lines controlled by CSO, L of C, Italy.

2. Unit Signal Officers (American and British) will contact Signal Officer, RAAC, for connection to Rome Communication System, and for installation, rehabilitation, and maintenance of any part of the civil communication system which may serve them. Units having no Signal Officer will request service at the office of the Signal Officer, RAAC. The following information must be presented with all requests:

- a. Name of unit or individual (Directory listing).
- b. Address by street and number and/or coordinates.
- c. Description of building; i.e., factory, hotel, warehouse, etc.
- d. Description of telephone system in the location; i.e., is it PEX, telephones, etc.
- e. Dial numbers of lines into buildings occupied.

3. Telephone directories are prepared and distributed by Signal Officer, RAAC. Additional Copies may be procured at the Signal Office. Any changes or corrections should be brought to the attention of Directory Clerk, Dial 66019.

4. RAAC Signal Center is established on 1st floor, RAAC Hq. Units within Rome Allied Area as defined in Incl 2 #1 0 may avail themselves of this service by contacting Message Center Officer, Duplex 11.

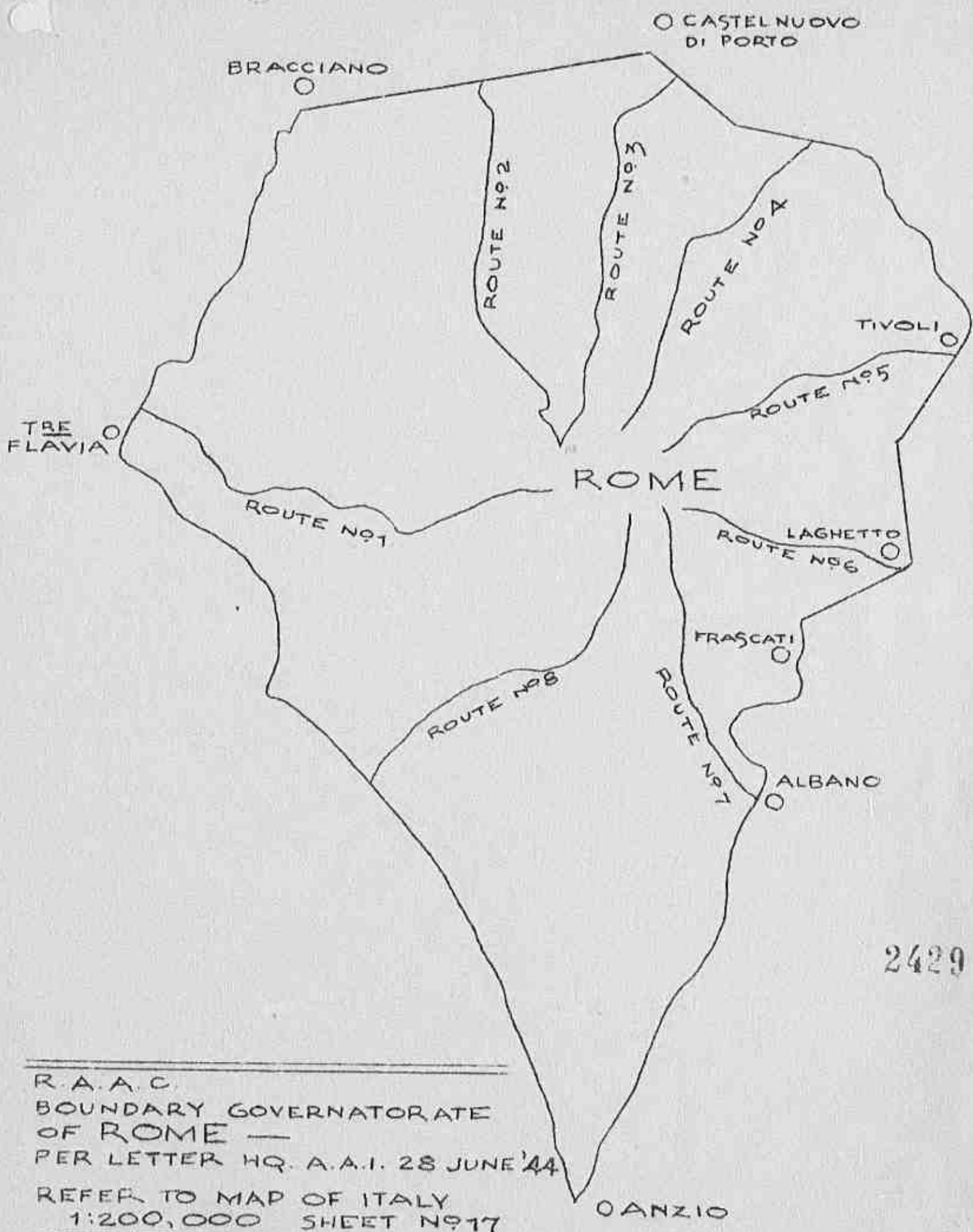
