It is understood that further BL's will be authorised in the near future for movement to the LAMCOV and PITTIOMO Gruppi d Combattimenti respectively. It is anticipated that they will constitute one form in the SAN GIORGIO area.

3. Captain J.H. Greep and Lt. N. Leach were selected as the R Signals Staff Officers within the BL WE for 'A' and 'B' BL's. They were despatched to the Signals School and Depot to supervise the formation of the first two Rear Link signals. By arrangement with you Capt R.J.M. Goldsmith has been made available as the 30 & R Signals for 'C' BLU. He have initiated LS action at this HQ in respect of all three officers. The remaining three staff officers are being earmarked and you will be notified when the selections are made.

4. It was agreed that the School of Signals would be a convenient location for all the formations to be carried out and that 3 District should be the supervising authority.

5. The personnel for 'C' BL were provided from 11 resources, the GLs being posted from L of C Signals. Those who replaced, by arrangement, Lt. A. T. A. Signals for 'A' BL was found up to strength and has joined its formation. Lt. ... is being asked to confirm that this is correct.

6. It is intended to provide the personnel for 'B' BL and our 450 GLs of resources and you to do so. It is not clear what progress has been made. In the meantime, do ask to contribute personnel for the formation of 'C' and 'D'

- 1. It is understood that a proposal is being considered to post personnel, the - theatre replacements for 'A' trades trainees to form Rear Link Signals. This is not considered to be a practicable solution since a definite assurance was given to CSD's when asked to nominate personnel for trg in 'A' trades that replacements would be provided for all personnel taken for such trd.
- 2. The Groups are however required in the field on a high operational level, and it will be necessary to form this Rear Link Sigs from Rfts and other existing resources within the theatre. Your observations are requested as to how this can be done.

1. If the formation and training of six Italian Gruppi which is at present under review is agreed, it will be necessary to commence the training of Italian Signal Instructors in the use of British Equipment at short notice. It is understood that the proposed concentration date of the first Italian Gruppo is 1 Sept.

2. In order to clarify the position as at present the proposals discussed during the visit of M G II (Trg) to your HQ on 8-10 Aug are enumerated below.

- (a) It was agreed that the first batch of Italian instructors must be available to commence training in their units by the first week in Sept.
- (b) In view of the problem it would be necessary for the training to be carried out at the School of Signals and in order that the necessary instructors and accommodation can be made available at least one RSI course would have to be cancelled.
- (c) It was suggested that No 4 Inf RSI course due to commence on 21 AUG should be cancelled and that DT be asked to do this now.
- (d) Three courses of two weeks duration each for forty students should be held at the School of Signals. Training thereafter would be carried out either in units or at the Italian Signal School.
- (e) In addition, a British training team consisting of three British NCOs should be attached to the Italian Gruppi during their initial training. These training teams would work under the 30 III (Signals) whom it has been proposed should be on the staff of BLU with each Gruppo.
- (f) It would be necessary for the adm of the Italian students while at the School to be carried out by Italian personnel.
- (g) It would be essential for Italian students attending the course to possess translated versions of British training pamphlets. These pamphlets should be made available for use within the Gruppi for their own training.

3. These proposals have now been discussed with MIA with the following results:

2. In order to clarify the position as at present the proposals discussed during the visit of Mr C II (Trg) to your HQ on 8-10 Aug are enumerated below.

- (a) It was agreed that the first batch of Italian instructors must be available to commence training in their units by the first week in Sept.
- (b) In view of the problem it would be necessary for the training to be carried out at the School of Signals and in order that the necessary instructors and accommodation can be made available at least one RSI course would have to be cancelled.
- (c) It was suggested that No 4 Inf RSI course due to commence on 21 Aug should be cancelled and that IET be asked to do this now.
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- (e) In addition, a British Training team consisting of three British NCOs should be attached to the Italian Gruppo during their initial training. These training teams would work under the SO III (Signals) whom it has been proposed should be on the staff of BLU with each Gruppo.
- (f) It would be necessary for the aim of the Italian students while at the School to be carried out by Italian personnel.
- (g) It would be essential for Italian students attending the course to possess translated versions of British training pamphlets. These pamphlets should be made available for use within the Gruppi for their own training.

3. These proposals have now been discussed with MTA with the following results.

- (a) Forty Italian students have been earmarked for the first course. Thirty of these students will come from the first Italian Gruppo to be formed. The other ten students will be potential instructors from the Italian Signal School and it is proposed that they remain at the school for a further two weeks to increase their general signal knowledge. Students have been selected from all arms as follows:-

(b) Provision will be made for Italian Arm Personnel to be attached to the School during these courses. It will not be possible at the moment to provide tents or other equipment from Italian resources.

(c) The translation of the necessary Signal pamphlets is now in hand. It is doubtful if all pamphlets will be completed by 20 Aug as there are commitments from other arms. Priority has been given to the pamphlets on the 18, 22 and 19 sets and these should be completed by the required date.

(d) The establishment which has been drawn up for the Italian Engineer Signal Company includes eighteen wireless maintenance personnel. It is requested that a course be arranged for trg these personnel in the maintenance of British equipment. It is agreed that a total of six which is the maximum the School of Signals could instruct at one time will fill immediate needs.

(e) A minimum of four interpreters will be available for trg at the Signal School. It may be possible to provide extra interpreters when all commitments are known.

4. Two officers have been selected from within AAI to fill the appointment of SO III in the WUs with the first two Italian Gruppi. It is intended that these officers should, after a short attachment to MTA, here, go to the School of Signals to assist with the training.

5. The Comdt of the School of Signals has no suitable HQCs available from Rfts to make up the trg teams. These will therefore have to be found from AAI and steps are now being taken to select suitable personnel.

6. It will be necessary to form a Rear Link Detachment R Signals for each of the six Gruppi. A copy of the proposed establishment for these dets is attached at Appendix 'A'. The first of these should be formed and available by 1 Sept, the second by 15 Sept and the remainder about a month later.

Since this is an entirely new commitment which cannot be met from existing resources, it will be essential for the R.Signals ceiling to be increased accordingly. Since the employment of these Italian forces will be limited to 12 months, this will impose

resources.

- (c) The translation of the necessary Signal pamphlets is now in hand. It is doubtful if all pamphlets will be completed by 20 Aug as there are commitments from other arms. Priority has been given to the pamphlets on the 18, 22 and 19 sets and these should be completed by the required date.

(d) The establishment which has been drawn up for the Italian Engineer Signal Company includes eighteen wireless maintenance personnel. It is requested that a course be arranged for trg these personnel in the maintenance of British equipment. It is agreed that a total of six which is the maximum the School of Signals could instruct at one time will fill immediate needs.

4. Two officers have been selected from within ATI to fill the appointment of SO TII in the BHUs with the first two Italian Gruppi. It is intended that these officers should, after a short attachment to MTA, here, go to the School of Signals to assist with the training.

5. The Comdt of the School of Signals has no suitable NOCs available from MTA to make up the trg teams. These will therefore have to be found from ATI and steps are now being taken to select suitable personnel.

6. It will be necessary to form a Rear Link Detachment R Signals for each of the six Gruppi. A copy of the proposed establishment for these dets is attached at Appendix 'A'. The first of these should be formed and available by 1 Sept, the second by 15 Sept and the remainder about a month later.

Since this is an entirely new commitment which cannot be met from existing resources, it will be essential for the R Signals ceiling to be increased accordingly. Since the employment of these Italian Forces [will presumably permit an overall decrease in British formations, this small increase would appear amply justified.

This aspect of the matter is being pressed also through staff channels at this HQ.

7. As it seems probable that little time will be available to arrange training when the final decision to form and train these Gruppi is made, it is requested that the necessary action be now initiated in order that training may commence at the School of Signals on 20 Aug 44.
