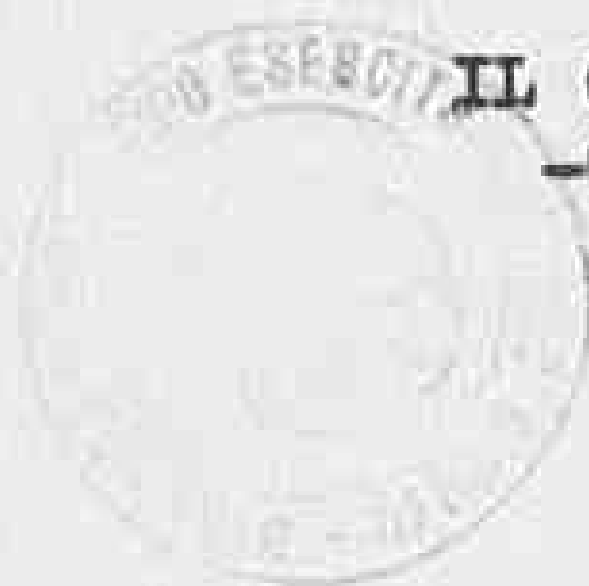

SUPPLY AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SIGNAL STORES.

1. Classification.

In a theatre of war, British signal stores are classified as "uncontrolled" or "controlled".

Uncontrolled stores are those generally required to equip units to operational scales or to carry out work projects. Such stores as cannot be mass-produced e.g. carrier or multi-channel equipment, are inevitably included in this category. Stores temporarily in short supply may be included for a limited period.

The Chief Signal Officer at the Supreme Allied Headquarters is responsible for the control of all signal stores in the theatre. In his staff are officers who forecast theatre requirements on which home production is based, and control the distribution of stores in readiness for present and future operations.

Uncontrolled stores are those for good supply, generally expendable, which require no discrimination between the relative importance of unit demands e.g. "X" cells or wireless receiving valves.

2. Demand.

The unit authority for demanding stores may be either

(a) the Table of War Equipment (A.F. 61095)

or (b) the War Office Equipment Scale

or (c) the War Office Scale authorized by D.C.C. of the

A.F. In the case of the 1st Army School this is

given in War Letter D.F. 28/4/21 of 2 Feb 45.

Demand for uncontrolled stores are submitted through

Radio channels on A.F. 6094.

Demand for controlled stores are submitted by letter

to the D.C. of the formation or District in which the unit is situated.

D.C.'s generally demand a monthly review of unit deficiencies of controlled stores, so that the relative priority of issues may be decided.

2. Demand.

The unit authority for demands stores may be of three

(a) the Table of War Equipment (TWE, 31098)

or (b) the War Office Equipment Code

or (c) any other code authorized by G.O.C. of the

U.S. In the case of the signal school this is

given in the letter D.2/28/44, MT 1 of 2 Feb 45.

Demands for uncontrolled stores are submitted through

radio channels on M.T. 1994.

Demands for controlled stores are submitted by letter

to the G.O.C. of the formation or District in which the unit is situated.

G.O.C.s generally demand a priority nature of unit's requirements of controlled stores, so that the relative priority of issues may be decided.

3. Issues.

The G.O.C. is responsible for the distribution of signal

equipment to units.

All stores are assigned to the Base Ordnance Depot (BOD)

on arrival in the theatre. The BOD holds reserves sufficient to meet

at least one month's needs without replacement. *24/4/45*

Depots (BOD) receive stores from the BOD into the zone of operations.

All tactical formations down to and including Divisions have Ordnance

Field Parks (OFP). At the Army O.P. 10 days' storage of all stores for

the Army is held. O.P.s at lower formations hold 10 days' storage of

vital stores only.

To enable urgent demands to be met, it is usual for

certain signal stores to be diverted to "Signal Parks" instead of to

O.P.s. These Parks are staffed by signal personnel and are controlled

directly by G.O.C.s of formations. They exist at Army Group, Army and

Corps levels, and may often furnish divisional detachments where it is

required to hold stores well forward for impending operations.

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Sheet 2.4. Defects.

Where a major engineering work is to be carried out for the benefit of the theatre as a whole, it is customary for the unit or units carrying out the project to receive a specially authorized bulk issue of stores based on exact computation of quantities required. Construction or rehabilitation of long telephone routes or installation of multi-position switchboards are usually classed as "projects".

5. Control.

Control of signal stores at all levels is exercised by the CSO concerned working in consultation with the equivalent staff officer in the Ordnance branch.

6. Maintenance Spares.

The organization outlined above deals with the supply of complete equipments and essential first-line maintenance spares.

All other repairs are carried out by telecommunication personnel or REMS, who obtain spares from the BOD or MOD through REMS channels.

Mobile repair facilities are provided by the "E" detachment and workshop lorry, which is equipped for the inspection and realignment of apparatus and the execution of minor repairs. Items beyond local repair are passed back to the static workshop on which the detachment depends. If this workshop cannot repair the item, it normally hands the unit a "Revolving Local Repair Certificate" (RLR) and returns the equipment to Base Workshops REMS for major repair as and when possible, after which the item is handed back to the BOD for release.

It is not necessary for the unit to await the return of its equipment once the "RLR Certificate" has been obtained. Application must be made to the appropriate source of supply accompanied by the certificate, whereupon a new item will be issued when available.

7. Surplus Stores.

ready current of apparatus and the execution of minor repairs. Items beyond local repair are passed back to the static workshop on which the detachment depends. It is not necessary for the unit to await the return of its equipment once the "BLR Certificate" has been obtained. Application must be made to the appropriate address of supply accompanied by the certificate, whereupon a new item will be issued when available.

7. Surplus Stores.

Surplus stores must be returned to the nearest Returned Stores Depot or Signal Park. They must be securely packed, and marked with the designation of the stores and their condition i.e., "serviceable and fit for release", "for repair", "deficient", or other description.

8. Salvage.

The salvage of serviceable components and materials is of great assistance to a nation's war economy. All equipment damaged beyond possibility of repair and all expended items e.g. batteries, must be returned to the nearest Salvage Depot or Signal Park for disintegration.

9. Technical Vehicles.

Release of technical vehicles is authorized by the "AG" section of the Quartermaster (Q) Branch of the Supreme Headquarters in the theatre of operations, on the advice of the GSO. The RAG distributes the vehicles to Vehicle Parks from which units collect on receipt of L(AR) authority.

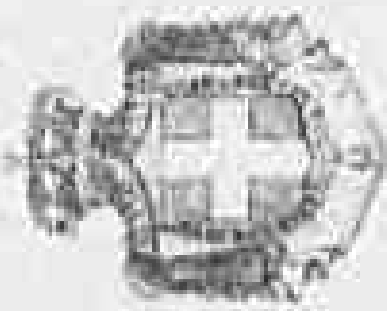

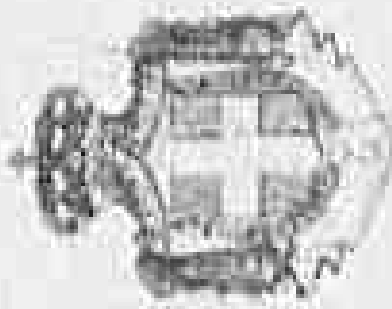

The Italian Signal School has been established at the Italian Military Academy for the purpose of training personnel from the various Italian branches of the armed forces in cryptology.

it is, however, proving very difficult to carry out efficient training at this school owing to the shortage of signal equipment and transport.

A certain amount of equipment has already been issued under your letter 157/177/IT II of 20.07.67 but this is proving quite insufficient for the convenience of the school, which has to cope with 100 - 200 students per month.

This shortage of equipment is seriously hampering the training of the Grouped Division, and if the training schedule is to be adhered to it is of the utmost importance that the school be lavished with further special stores.

A list of names required is attached. These names will enable the Council to carry out the course already planned.

As agreed at the conference at U.S.T.A. today, attendees by U.S.T.A., the question of establishing a larger school is under review. Detailed requirements for this will be forwarded in due course.

The position as regards the replacement of expendable stores for the School is not clear, and it would be appreciated if this office could be informed as to who is to be responsible for such replacement.
