 Allied Control Commission, APO 394, U.S. Army. (ATTN: Army Sub-commission and Air Force Sub-commission.)

1. For your information, the following chronological data is furnished on the movement of Italian radio equipment from Sardinia to Italian mainland.

2. The paraphrased extracts of messages pertaining to above equipment are as follows:

a. This headquarters was advised by AFHQ that nine (9) Italian Air Force transmitters were being released by FATIMA, cite message AFHQ to FATIMA and FATIMA, 18 February 1944. (Exhibit 1).

b. Information on storage points, time required for shipment and following type Italian Air Force sets available was furnished AFHQ and info FATIMA by our message AGS JIG 49, dated 25 February. Sets were one each RT-1000, three each RT-800 and five each A-350/1, (350 watt). (Exhibit 2).

c. Message AGS JIG 58, dated 10 March, advised FATIMA that Col. Elliot, Air Force Sub-commission on 9 March, verbally informed this headquarters that release for the equipment had been sent, but that release for sets had not been received. (Exhibit 3).

d. Instructions for the shipment of the transmitters were received from 8CS NATOGIA on 14 March, cite SIG-214. (Exhibit 4).

e. Further instructions from 8CS NATOGIA in message dated 15 March, cite TBN 254 stated that if transportation were not available to DUKO equipment was to be loaded on first available transportation to North Africa for trans-shipment to Italy. (Exhibit 5).

f. FATIMA again was informed by this headquarters on 16 March, cite AGS JIG 67, that release on transmitters had not been received. (Exhibit 6).

g. AFHQ message to FATIMA info ZALCON, 19 March requested the release of one additional RT-1000. (Exhibit 7).

h. Release on the original nine transmitters plus the additional BT-1000 was received from PATINA on 25 March, cite Air Force Sub-commission, Bari, SURAR 49. (Exhibit 8).

i. On 26 March, when Italian Air Force transmitters were being prepared for shipment, it was learned that the five A-350/1 sets were only 100 watt sets. However, transmitters A-350/1 but 300 watt type were located in Italian Army stores. These sets were requested of the Italian Army by AGS to permit compliance with wishes of AFHQ and were being prepared for shipment.

j. On 5 April, AFHQ was informed that the five Italian Air Force sets and the five Italian Army sets would be shipped to Oran in near future, cite AGS JIG 79. (Exhibit 9).

k. Shipping instructions were again changed and equipment was to be sent direct to Italy. Since a release had been received for the five A-350/1 from Italian Air Force and not from the Italian Army and the five A-350/1 were army equipment, Col. Simmons, AGS, Army Sub-commission informed us that these sets would not be shipped without authority from AAI. Message 10 April, to UNIA, PATINA, FLAMBO and AFHQ from Col. Simmons at VALCON, cite AGS YOKL 83 requested permission to substitute the five A-350/1 for the Air Corps sets. (Exhibit 10).

l. Col. Simmons was advised by AAI by message 18 April, cite XRAY 1466, that the five A-350/1 sets would not be obtained from the Italian Army. (Exhibit 11).

3. When the ship left Sardinia 27 April, only the five Italian Air Force sets were aboard and the five Italian Army sets are now stored in an Allied warehouse. No further action will be taken on Army sets until receipt of further instructions.
