

TO : MINISTRY OF WAR

Our Liaison Officer with 3 District and HQ 3 District have informed us that the Chief Signal Officer of 3 District, to increase the efficiency of two Italian Signal Coys., requested that six Italian junior officers be transferred because considered unsuitable in their present employment.

The Chief Signal Officer made his request known to the proper Italian military authorities requesting that the necessary changes be made. The Italian military authorities have refused to take action stating that the request should be forwarded through British channels.

Please advise the competent Italian military authority that the instructions of MMIA letter A.C2C of 23 March 1945 clearly state the course that is to be followed. The case in question is dealt with by Paragraph 5, instructions for Grade III officers. The action of the Chief Signal Officer is absolutely correct and you will please instruct the Italian military authority to act accordingly.

I have investigated this case, in which a good deal of confusion seems to have been caused by the receipt of conflicting orders by the parties concerned.

2. Land Forces Sub Commission letter AO/11 dated 26 Nov 44 asked if C.S.O., No. 1 District were willing to release Major FENOCILIO from his command of 171 Big Coy as he had volunteered for service with combat tps and further stated that Capt. NOTTI would assume command in his place.

Colonel DENHOLM-YOUNG replied that he had no objection to this arrangement.

Major FENOCILIO was interviewed at this office on arrival in the District and stated that Capt. NOTTI and 2/Lt. TERRILE had reported to his Coy in error. He was informed that Capt.
