Reference your letter dated 21 January, 1946, in respect of the abovenamed officer.

1. According to the casualties received by me, the overissue as it stands, i.e. 23 Sept to 31 October £8.15.6d, is correct, as Capt. Eburah departed from C.M.F. area 23.9 and returned 2.11.
2. Mediterranean Allowance which had been paid for period 23 Sept to 31 October therefore became inadmissible. One day 1 November is also due for refund, as this was paid in the officer's emoluments for December.
3. Ration allowance was paid by me for period 25.9 - 27.10 on receipt of a casualty from 65 Transit Camp showing leave granted for this period. No further claim has been received by me, but in view of your statement that the officer did not report to 65 Transit Camp until 30 October, I will make a provisional payment of Leave Rate of Ration allowance for 23-30 October, pending receipt of a further casualty.
4. I thank you for drawing my attention to the duplication in payment of the increase of 1/- per day, for the period 4-30 September, and regret the error. I propose to deduct the sum of 7/- in Capt. Eburah's February account.

To: All Concerned

1. The intake of potential officers of all arms to British OCTUs has been reduced from 1435 to 600 per month for all arms. Consequent upon this reduction, the necessity to move from certain accommodation on high priority for release, and the gradual transition from war to post war methods of production of officers for the army, has made it necessary to reorganise OCTUs.
2. It has been decided by the War Office that OCTU training in UK for potential R Signals Officers will be organised as follows:-

- (a) Pre OCTU.
- (b) Basic OCTU. Can mil tra for all arms other than Inf and Pairs is to be given here.
- (c) OCTU Wing of School of Signals, Cottarrick Camp.

Appx 'A' attached shows the eventual organisation of OCTUs affecting R Signals.

3. PRE OCTU TRAINING.

Pre OCTU tra in the future will be in two phases:-

- (a) Phase A. Pre OCTU Tra - 148 Pre OCTU

- (i) All candidates for commissions, irrespective of the arm from which they are drawn or to which they have to be commissioned, will be required to pass through 148 Pre OCTU.

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(a) Pre OCTU.

(b) Basic OCTU. Gen all trf for all arms other than Inf and Pns is to be given here.

(c) OCTU Wing of School of Signals, Catterick Camp.

Appx 'A' attached shows the eventual organisation of OCTUs affecting R Signals.

3. PRE OCTU TRAINING.

Pre OCTU trf in the future will be in two phases:-

(a) Phase A. Pre OCTU Trf - 148 Pre OCTU

(i) All candidates for commissions, irrespective of the arm from which they are drawn or to which they hope to be commissioned, will be required to pass through 148 Pre OCTU.

(ii) At 148 pre OCTU cadets will be brought up to the standard of trained Inf pte soldier, and in addition will be given a basic D and M trf. This trf may take anything from 1 week upwards, being independent entirely upon the capacity, ability and skill of each individual candidate.

(iii) When the candidate, destined for R Signals, has reached the required standard, he will be posted to the Basic OCTU.

(b) Phase B. Arms Refresher Trf - School of Signals OCTU Wing

(i) All R Signals candidates will carry out a refresher period of arms trf at the School of Signals after completing their trf at Basic OCTU and immediately before starting the R Signals OCTU course.

(ii) The purpose of this refresher trf is to ensure that each candidate reaches the standard of a trained Sign before undertaking his technical trf.

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4. BASIC OCTU TRAINING

- (a) The Basic OCTU will undertake Gen Mil Trg (GME). Trg will last for 3 weeks.
- (b) Having successfully completed Basic OCTU, a candidate will normally, except in cases of disciplinary or medical grounds, be considered to have qualified for a commission, though this will not be granted to him until he has completed his course at the R Signals OCTU Wing.
- (c) Cadets who fail to complete satisfactorily the Basic OCTU Course will be referred to WOSB for decision as to their disposal or further training.
- (d) In order that knowledge of the capabilities of and progress of individual cadets in Basic OCTU is not lost sight of, a system of Class offrs is being introduced. (See Appx B, para 2.)

5. R SIGNALS OCTU WING, SCHOOL OF SIGNALS

Training will be carried out as follows:-

- (a) Refresher Arms Trg. The object of this is described in para 3(b) above.
- (b) OCTU Trg. The object of OCTU Trg is to turn out a fully trained junior offr capable of commanding the most junior offr's sub-unit in war and trg it in field trg.
Candidates who, for one reason or another, are unable to absorb the technicalities involved, will have their cases referred to WOSB for consideration as to which other arm they are suited.

6. RE-ORGANISATION OF OCTU TRG

Completion of the re-organisation shown in Appx A will be carried out as per details given at Appx B.

7. POSTING OF CADETS TO OCTUS

(a) Refresher Arms Trg. The object of this is described in para 3(b) above.

(b) OCTU Trg. The object of OCTU Trg is to turn out a fully trained junior officer capable of commanding the most junior officer's sub-unit in war and trg it in field trg.

Candidates who, for one reason or another, are unable to absorb the technicalities involved, will have their cases referred to WOSE for consideration as to which other arm they are suited.

6. RE-ORGANISATION OF OCTU TRG

Completion of the re-organisation shown in Appx A will be carried out as per details given at Appx B.

7. POSTING OF CANDIDATES TO OCTUS

Wef 1 Oct 45 R Sigs candidates will be posted from 1/3 Pre OCTU to Basic OCTU instead of to the 150 OCTU.

8. RE OF RE-ORGANISED OCTUS

On the move of OCTUS, staffs are being adjusted to the new commitments and a new WE will be issued by the War Office. The capacity shown in Appx A will incl increments.

9. TRG AREAS

Commands in conjunction with the War Office are ensuring that the areas are adequate. The Basic OCTU Battle Camp is to be situated at BANGOR.

10. SYLLABUS OF TRG

Based on existing CMT and R Sigs OCTU Syllabuses. Length of courses are to be as shown at Appx A.

1. The conditions under which officers and other ranks may volunteer for service in FAR EAST have been laid down in AFHQ Signal FX 60870 dated 16 Apr 45 addressed to Armies, Districts, Greekmil, IFA & BTNA, with an information copy to 15 Army Group.

2. Briefly the conditions are as follows:-

(a) Volunteers must be in a later age/service release group than 26, or, if in an earlier group, must have applied not to be released until general demobilisation under Para 326, Regulations for Release from the Army 1945, copies of which were distributed with GHOs Serial No 16 dated 20 Apr 45.

(b) If wishing to retain PYTHON rights, volunteers must have not more than two years qualifying PYTHON service; if willing to defer PYTHON rights, they must guarantee to serve a minimum period of one year in FAR EAST. Written guarantees must be submitted with applications.

3. Present policy is that volunteers will not be posted to FAR EAST as individuals, but will be posted to units nominated to proceed to that theatre.

4. It will assist this HQ very materially in making up units and sections if a roll of officer volunteers can be established as early as possible. Addressees are asked therefore to ensure that the conditions of volunteering are brought to the notice of R Signals officers, as well as OR, under their command, and that officers wishing to volunteer are encouraged to submit their applications without delay. 1. A number of R Signals Officers who are candidates for Regular Commissions under ACI 1696/42 have recently been interviewed by the War Office Selection Board which is now in this command. There are also a number of officers who have been interviewed in UK or other commands and placed on the register of candidates recommended for regular commissions.

2. In some cases the President of the WOSB has recommended that the candidate, whether he is being graded 'A' or 'B' and included on the register, or graded 'C' or 'Failed' with a right to appeal, be posted to a Div Sigs.

3. It is considered very desirable that officers who are granted Regular Commissions should obtain experience in action with the types of units in which they are likely to serve most after the war - ie Divisional and Corps Signals, and CSOs are requested to arrange suitable postings for these officers wherever possible. INTRODUCTION

1. There appears to be some doubt as to the methods of recommendation and selection of

(a) Warrant officers and NCOs for Commissions, Emergency or Regular, as Lieutenants Quartermaster or TMC, P. Sigs,

and

(b) Emergency commissioned officers of these classes for Regular Army Commissions.

2.

It should be clearly understood

(a) that the procedures of recommendation and selection for Emergency and for Regular Commissions are entirely different

(b) that the procedure of recommendation and selection for Regular Commissions as Quartermaster or Technical Maintenance Officer is in no way connected with or similar to the procedure laid down in AOI 1696/42 for applications for Regular Combatant Commissions.

EMERGENCY COMMISSIONS3. Lieutenants Quartermaster

(a) Only War Substantive Warrant Officers Class I and Regimental Quartermaster Sergeants are eligible.

(b) Recommendations on AF P. 2065 must be initiated

It should be clearly understood

- (a) that the procedures of recommendation and selection for Emergency and for Regular Commissions are entirely different
- (b) that the procedure of recommendation and selection for Regular Commissions as Quartermaster or Technical Maintenance Officer is in no way connected with or similar to the procedure laid down in ACI 1696/42 for applications for Regular Combatant Commissions.

EMERGENCY COMMISSIONS

3. Maintenance Quartermaster

- (a) Only War Substantive Warrant Officers Class I and Regimental Quartermaster Sergeants are eligible.
- (b) Recommendations on AF B.2065 must be initiated by Commanding Officers and forwarded through the usual channels to this HQ.
- (c) AF B.2065 are filed at this HQ and a roster of recommended candidates is maintained.
- (d) When a vacancy occurs in the theatre which is to be filled by grant of an immediate commission, CSO AFHQ selects a candidate from the roster.
- (e) Selection is normally based on suitability and seniority in that order - i.e. the senior Warrant Officer on the roster is commissioned provided he is suitable for the vacancy which is to be filled. This is not an invariable rule and other factors, such as age, length of service, date of initiation of AF B.2065, medical category, etc may be taken into consideration. In some cases the War Office may stipulate that commissions will not be granted to candidates approaching the end of their PYTHON period of overseas service.

3. Lieutenants Quartermaster (continued)

- (f) It is desired to stress the point that unless AF D. 2065 in respect of a particular Warrant officer is held in this HQ he will not be considered for grant of an Emergency Commission; it is therefore the responsibility of Commanding Officers to ensure that this recommendation has been initiated on any Warrant officer of the required rank or appointment who is considered suitable for a Commission.

- (i) ACI 1645/41
- (ii) GRC 735/1A

- (h) Attached at Appendix 'A' is a copy of the present theatre roster.

4. Lieutenants TMO

- (a) The procedure of recommendation and selection is exactly the same as for Quartermasters, except that only Personnel of Signals, Radio Mechanics, Telegraph Mechanics, Electrician Signals, Instrument Mechanics, Line Mechanics and Vehicle Mechanics are eligible. Where there are exceptional qualifications, a Warrant officer or NCO of any P.S. signals trade may be recommended; in such cases the initiating officer will forward a special report stating fully his reason for making the recommendation.

- (b) Normally if there is a suitable Personnel of Signals on the roster, he will be commissioned in preference to an NCO tradesman.

- (c) Commanding Officers are responsible for ensuring that a recommendation on AF D. 2065 has been submitted on any Warrant officer or NCO whom they consider is

(a) The grant of permanent Regular Commissions as QMs, IHCs and TMOs is confined to Regular soldiers serving on an unexpired engagement. This includes Emergency commissioned officers, either combatant or Q-type, who were serving on such engagements before being granted emergency commissions. Regular soldiers who were discharged to pension before the outbreak of war and subsequently recalled from the Royal Army Reserve are NOT eligible.

(b) The grant of Regular Q-type Commissions is by selection as vacancies occur, from the senior Warrant Officers, Class I or Quartermaster Sergeants (Warrant Officers Class II) on the Corps Roster who are eligible and recommended.
