Subject:- Monthly Activity Report.

1. At the Italian School of Signals, CECCHIGNOLA, progress continues to be made in all directions. The transport situation is very bad, however, and is making the training of driver-operators and despatch riders very difficult.
2. The consignment of Signal stores received from PONTREAGNANO during July is in process of being distributed. I visited the 557 B.O.D. Sub-Depots at PONTREAGNANO and LA PICCIOLA on 23 and 25 Oct. and 1st and 2nd Nov. with Lt.Col. IANUARINO of the "Direzioe Generale del Genio" in order to earmark the signal equipment which the Italian Army will take before ARAR commences to sell in the civilian market. A working party under an Italian Genio subaltern is now engaged in concentrating this material so that it can quickly be moved to Rome when the release is received.
3. Permission has been received from G.H.Q. to dispose of all messages and letters of classification CONFIDENTIAL and below to the F.L.Us via the Italian Ministry of War Signal Office. The Ministry has already agreed to grant us the necessary facilities. A R. Signals M.C.O. will be on duty at the M. of W. Signal Office from 0800 to 1800 hrs daily in order to maintain a separate Signal Register and to facilitate the rectification of errors in routing etc.

1. Herewith report for June 46.
2. A tour was made commencing on 22 June and ending on 30 June. During this period 4, 2, and 7 B.L.U.'s and the CRUNA, SARROVA, and POLIGNO Italian Inf Divs were visited. It became evident from these visits that the Ministry of War does not make enough effort to keep the Divs "in the picture", by sending them copies of new war establishments, scales of stores, etc and, as far as signals are concerned, at any rate, no Ministry of War representatives ever make liaison visits to discuss problems and obtain the views of the Divisions on signal matters generally. It is appreciated that the Ministry is having considerable printing difficulties, but such work could be done to engender closer liaison than is being done at present. I am taking this matter up with the Direzione and Spettorato del Genio.
3. The Italian Signal School at OSTIGLIA continues to make steady progress and should be very satisfactory and well-organized in time for the arrival of the second batch of recruits.
4. The Signal Controlled stores for the Italian Infantry Army have now been received and are in the hands of the Ministry of War who are accepting my advice regarding distribution. Up to now it has not been possible to commence distribution owing to the closeness of some of the Divs in rendering returns of stores held but these have now all been received and issues will begin in the very near future.
5. The system of British military communications in Italy continued to degenerate throughout the month, and communications to Sicily have ceased to exist. In consequence this H.A. has to rely on the Ministry of War for the despatch of official mail to Sicily. The whole question of external communications for this Mission will be reviewed as soon as possible.

1. Domestic communications within HQ M.M.I.A. Preparation of telephone directories.
2. External communications necessary for M.M.I.A. Up to now these have been provided by the normal R. Signals communications network in Italy and Sicily, but this network is gradually fading out, and the whole matter will have to be reviewed in the near future.
3. Preparation of proposed W.E.'s for Italian Signal formations. Discussion of these W.E.'s with Ministry of War representatives and consideration of the latter's counter-proposals.
4. Preparation of series of Signal Controlled stores for the Italian Interim Army and Carabinieri. The obtaining of releases for these stores from G.H.Q., C.M.F., and the supervision of their distribution.
5. Issue of frequencies and instructions regarding code-signs and "Slidex" to the Ministry of War and to B.I.U.'s for the various Territorial Commands and Italian Inf Divs.
6. Visits to B.I.U.'s, Territorial Commands, and Italian Inf Divs to discuss problems personally with the people directly concerned and to settle as many difficulties as possible on the spot.
7. Supervision of the organization and training at the Italian School of Signals at GENOVA. 1. Herewith report for May 46.
2. Major D.R. Skinner, R. Sigs., Instructor R. Sigs., 12 D.L.U., reported back for duty ex-U.K. on 24 May.
3. Full-scale training at the Italian Signal School duly commenced early in the month. All the stores on the interim demand, lease electrolyte, arrived at the School on 21 May. Progress continues to be made in respect of the works services.
4. A conference was held at this H.Q. a.m. 24 May with regard to my proposed W.E. for an Italian Signal Bn and the counter-proposals of the Ministry of War. The following Officers attended:-

The proposed W.E. produced by Magg. Di Laura was, in my opinion, unsatisfactory and appeared to have entirely ignored my proposed W.E. 3. The proposed W.E. for an Italian Inf Div Sig Bn has been entirely re-written and duly forwarded to G(SD). The latter informs me that the W.E. has been forwarded to the War Establishments Committee for approval.

4. I visited HQ C.M.F. on 15/16 April in order to consolidate and obtain approval for stores demands for:-

- { 1 } The Italian School of Signals - interim demand only
- { 2 } Carabinieri
- { 3 } Italian Interim Army.

(1) and (2) were disposed of at HQ and releases were duly received at this HQ for (1) on 29 April and for (2) on 2 May.

6. I visited 7 BLD and HQ FOLGHE Div. at Florence on 19/23 April. I discussed the proposed new W.E. of an Italian Inf Div Sig Bn with Capt. ZANNANI, OC Sigs Coy of the Genio Bn, and Major ZENNERLI, of the Div General Staff. Capt. ZANNANI also commented on the very serious shortage of specialised signals personnel in the Italian Army as a whole, and especially in his Coy.

7. I visited the British School of Signals, C.M.F., at PADUA, on 25/28 April, with Col. MANCUSO and Major CANTONI of the Italian School of Signals. The visit proved to be highly instructive and enjoyable and the Commander of the British School promised that, when his school closes, as it is expected to do within the next six months, he will hand over all his home-made items of equipment to the Italian School, which will be extremely useful.

8. The U.E. for the Italian School of Signals came up for review late in the month and is, in my opinion, in need of considerable revision. This opinion has been put forward to G I (Trg) at this Hd, who is in agreement. In the meantime, certain essential amendments have been put forward to Col. PIACENTINI of the Ministry of War and approved. These amendments do not alter the numerical strength of the School but only the organization. I wish to state here that Col. PIACENTINI had previously refused permission to Col. MARUSO to make these alterations but, when confronted by the G I and G II (Trg) from this Hd, and myself, said that there was absolutely no difficulty of any kind, that he would be pleased to approve any amendments not altering the numerical strength, and (aside, in Italian, not understood, I think, by any of the British officers present but duly translated for me afterwards by an officer from the Italian School) that he could not understand why so many people had gathered together to discuss a matter of such small importance. The matter was emphatically not of small importance.
