At ROME on the 4th May 1946 about 1650 hours, I was on duty at CENTRAL POLICE STATION, accompanied by L/Cpl. TULLETT, C.M. Police, when acting on instructions received from the Duty Sergeant, I proceeded to a BARBER'S SHOP in Via REGINA GIOVANNI DI BULGARIA, where I saw the above named soldier.

On my questioning him he admitted to being ABSENT for about 3 WEEKS.

I arrested him and conducted him to the CENTRAL POLICE STATION where I obtained his particulars from his AB 64 and found he was also in possession of a PASS allowing him to circulate in the ROME AREA.

He was later transferred to the CITY GUARD ROOM at 56 REST CAMP and handed over to the NCO i/c Guard to be detained. Handing over receipt attached.
