1. RELEASE IN CLASS "B"

(a) It has been decided that officers and other ranks accepting release in Class "B" will be paid their war gratuities and war credits of pay, together with leave payments in respect of overseas service (where applicable), approximately eight weeks after the date of dispersal, instead of waiting until the end of the emergency.

(b) The differences in the conditions of releases in Class "A" and Class "B" are now as follows:-

(i) Class "A" - Fifty-six days' resettlement leave. If they have no jobs to which to return, the employment exchanges will give them every assistance in finding employment and will, not, during the period in which they are receiving regular service payments, regard them as subject to any powers of direction which are otherwise generally operative.

(ii) Class "B" - Twenty-one days' transfer leave.

(a) They will be directed to their reconstruction employments and this will preserve their reinstatement rights. Save, in exceptional circumstances, men will be placed in work near their homes and, as far as possible, with their previous employer. A woman released in Class "B" will be required to take up work in her home area, if suitable employment of the kind for which she is being released is available there; if she so wishes she will be directed to work with her former employer, if he has a suitable vacancy in that kind of work. If, however, suitable employment cannot be found in her home area, she may be directed elsewhere.

Men will be liable to recall in an emergency and, if their leave

(ii) Class "A" - Twenty-one days' transfer leave.

She will be liable to recall in an emergency and, if they leave their reconstruction employment before the time when they would have been released in Class "A" and they remained continuously in the service, after that time, provided not less than six months have elapsed since they were released, they will cease to be liable to recall on account of leaving their employment. They will then be liable only to such civilian controls as may apply to other civilians in that employment.

(b) Personnel who have elected not to be released in Class "B" are to be given the opportunity of reconsidering their decision in the changed circumstances.

2. ADVICE TO OFFICERS AND OFFICERS SERVING HIGHER GRADE APPOINTMENTS IN BUSINESS.

Situations wanted advertisements in the Daily Press are beginning to have notices like this -

"SITUATION WANTED. For Officer 22, good war record. Seeks responsible administrative post, minimum salary \$1,000 a year".

It is not quite as easy for men who have been in the Services for over six years to realize that qualifications and experience that have fitted them for relatively high grade commitments in the armed forces of the Crown are by no means necessarily transferable to corresponding levels in trade and business. Almost inevitably servicemen returning to civil life are out of touch with the very different mechanism of civil organization even if they were/

were old enough to have had any real experience of it before the war. It is, therefore, a necessity for him to relearn what he has forgotten, or to start afresh at an age when he would usually be normally established in his career, to learn the elements of an entirely new business of which values are completely different. Although contemporary conditions make full employment possible for lower grade posts for those involving manual skill, there is bound to be considerable competition for managerial and administrative posts, especially those involving the possession of technical qualifications. Applicants for these posts will, therefore, have to be prepared to face the process of passing through a sieve which may be not only painful but humiliating. The factors which will undoubtedly count in selecting one or two out of each dozen applicants are, previous experience, educational qualifications, and an apparent readiness and capacity for adjustment. War records, which are justly a matter of pride to the applicant, may not command themselves to prospective employers. Indeed, the latter may suffer under a misguided sense of shame at not having taken part in the war themselves, and the fixed idea that military service and an organisation based on military discipline makes a man incapable of obtaining work from his fellow men without these powerful aids.

There are plenty of good jobs in industry and commerce waiting for the ex-serviceman who is willing to learn. This will inevitably, in many cases, involve a lowering of the standard of life which his family has been accustomed to, and it is never pleasant to start again at the bottom when one's personal success has been achieved. The essential matter is, however, to obtain a start and to do this full advantage should be taken of the further education scheme if the applicant is eligible. Although men are found at the top of every industrial organisation who have not at their entry into commerce been the possessors of educational qualifications, it is much easier through such a career to obtain advancement in employment if these qualifications are possessed.
