1. When the allotment was made for LIAP Serial 11 the allotment for Allied Commission was made direct to them by you and not through this Headquarters as was previously the case.
2. It is understood by this HQ that the Land Forces Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission (MMIA) is part of the Allied Commission and that they should have received an allotment from HQ Allied Commission.
3. This however was not done and this HQ did not make an allotment to Land Forces Sub-Commission with the result that the personnel of MMIA who qualified for Leave in UK on LIAP Serial 11 have not been considered.
4. It is requested that a ruling may be given as to whether MMIA should receive an allotment from Allied Commission or be treated as a separate unit in this Command and be given vacancies from the allotment made to this HQ.
