To sum up, though the AEC is instructed to assist and advise Staffs on how best to advertise and explain the Release and Resettlement Scheme, it has no intrinsic source of information on the subject and can only work on existing directions and pamphlets, copies of which are officially issued to all units in the area.

1. Your action with regard to the Release Period Education Scheme is noted and appreciated.
2. Until decision has been made by the Deputy Commander as to which units will adopt the R.P.E.S. it is impossible to give details of the extra facilities to be arranged at Area level as laid down in GRO 437/42 para 2(3).
3. It is noted that a representative of HQ ALLIED COMMISSION (Capt. R.V. DUDLEY CLARK) attended the Briefing Conference for C.Os at which D.C.E.O. and S.O. I EDN AFHQ explained the R.P.E.S. and it is suggested that he should be approached for answering any minor queries that may arise.
4. With regard to para 6 of your Camp order it will be appreciated that the limited Staff of the Education Branch is working at full pressure and though every effort will be made to meet these commitments, there may be a little delay pending the arrival of a further Sgt. Instructor.

It is pointed out that the two Briefing Conferences held May 21st and 22nd (notified in ARO.528 dated 16 May 45) were arranged in order to give Commanding Officers and UEOs an opportunity of hearing about the R.P.E.S and for discussing their difficulties.

1. The Army Scheme for Education during the Release Period is to be put into effect in the near future.
2. It is obvious that Units which now have no operational role will be able to devote more time to the Scheme, than a HQ, such as M.M.I.A. where there will be as much, if not more work now, than there was before the end of hostilities.
3. Nevertheless, the G.O.C. is most anxious that no man or auxiliary shall suffer or miss any Educational opportunity through being in a HQ which is still as busy as before.
4. Full details will be made known later but meanwhile everyone should be thinking of what he really needs in the way of further Education, so that when the Scheme is made known arrangements can be made accordingly.
5. Anyone who wishes to continue his or her education will be excused other duties for a certain amount of time when possible, but the balance of time required for study must be found from the individual's spare time. This is necessary to

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3. Nevertheless, the C.O.C. is most anxious that no man or auxiliary shall suffer or miss any Educational opportunity through being in a HQ which is still as busy as before.

4. Full details will be made known later but meanwhile everyone should be thinking of what he really needs in the way of further Education, so that when the Scheme is made known arrangements can be made accordingly.

5. Anyone who wishes to continue his or her education will be excused other duties for a certain amount of time when possible, but the balance of time required for study must be found from the individual's spare time. This is necessary to ensure that those who do not require education shall not be over-worked.

6. A lecture on the scope of the scheme will be given shortly by a member of the Educational Staff of R.A.A.C. by which time everyone should have decided what they need in the way of further or re-education.
