You see, we are getting a divorce, well, at least, I want one, as you will, no doubt. know. he has a disease, which as he told me, caught off a girl he picked up off the streets.

I have written him 5

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letters, and he has completely ignored them, now, don't you think he is going a bit too far? I am his wife, and I want to know everything about him. You've got to help me. I have been kept too much in the dark. I have every right to know of his health, and also somebody has got to see that justice is done. As his officer, you will know all about him, (not the character you gave him.) you were very much mistaken. Do I have to suffer for his folly? He wrote and told me a few months ago<sup>24/38</sup> to get the divorce, well, I have

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no evidence to prove anything.  
So I wrote to the hospital  
where he received the treatment  
the M.O. wrote back and said  
he has give him the evidence  
why doesn't he do something  
about this divorce? I'm afraid  
it's hopeless for me to get  
one. as I've tried everywhere.  
all they say is, my husband  
must ~~make~~ do it.

What I want to know  
is, Did he have V.D.? and is  
he in hospital? as he is  
due for demob very soon,  
and I want this divorce  
before he gets released from  
the army. It's definitely over  
between us. even if he has

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get rid of the disease, he has still committed adultery. I have a letter to prove that. But he doesn't know the name or address of the girl concerned, so I'm afraid I couldn't get a divorce on those grounds. Sir, if you can help, you are the only person who can make him understand, what a difficult position, he has forced me into.

I will be very grateful if you will answer this letter and please give it every consideration.

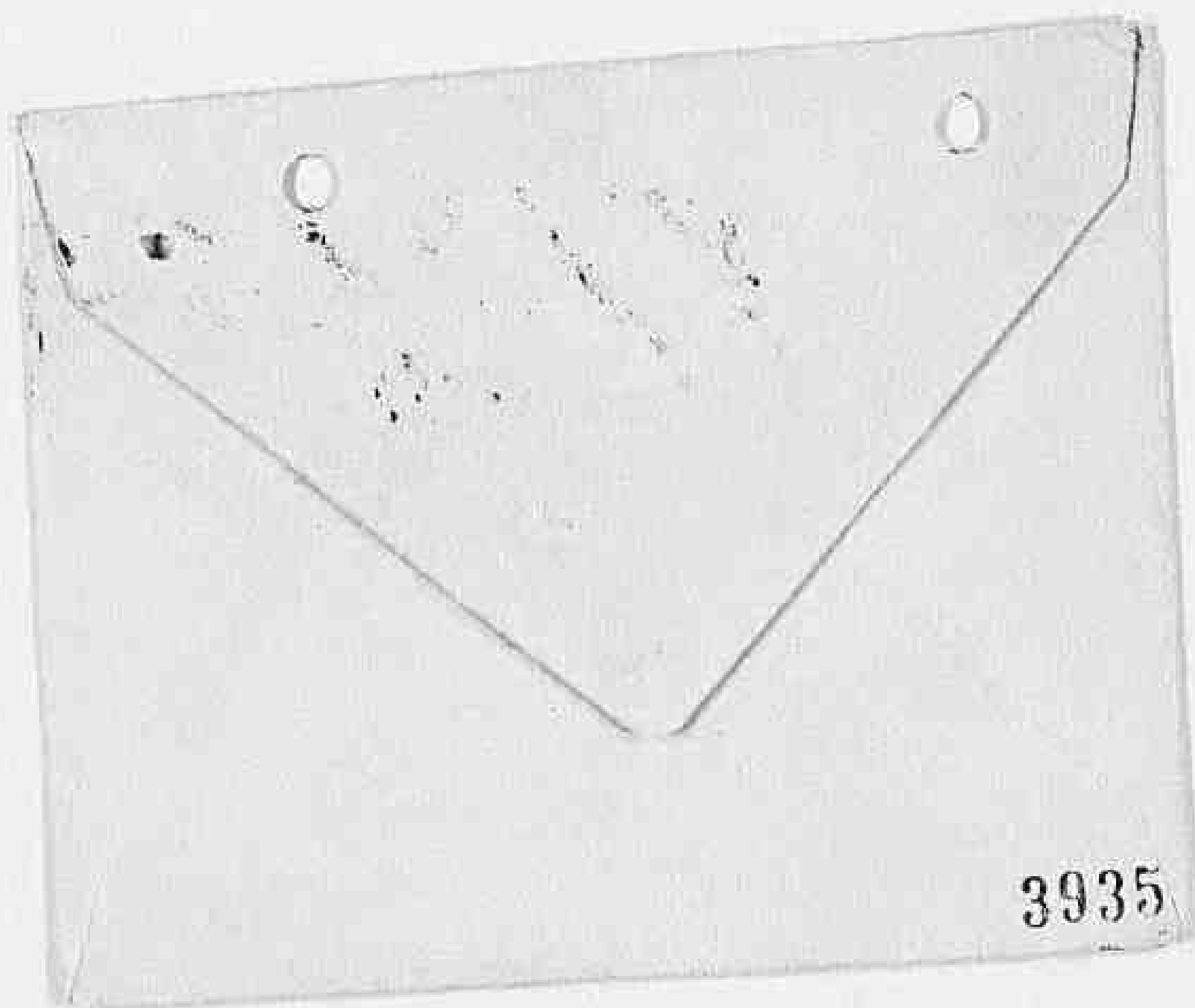
