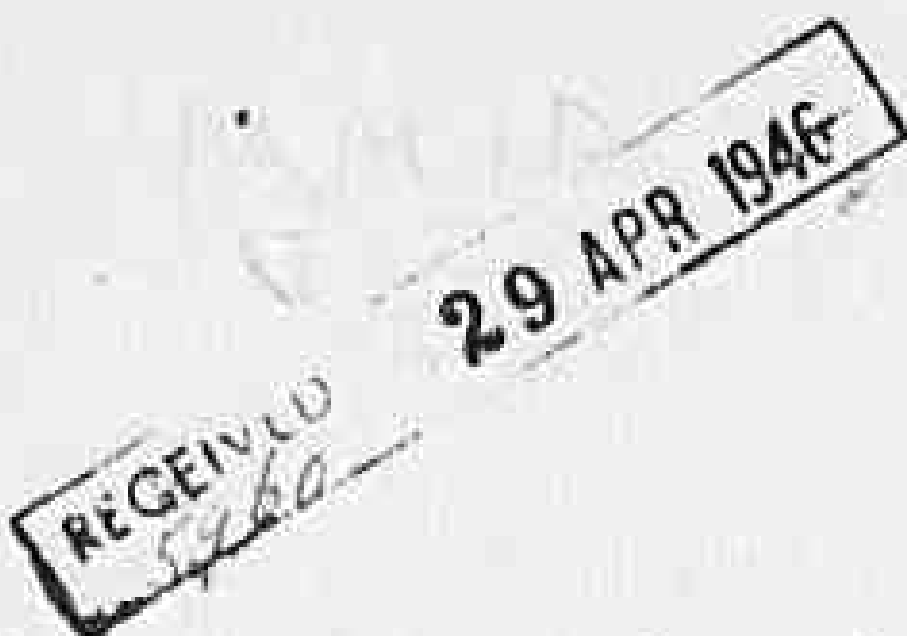

Subject: Malaria Control

To : See Distribution

1. Attention of all Units is drawn to GHQ GRC 252/46 and HQ MTOUSA Circular No. 54 Section IV on Malaria Control. Commanding Officers are responsible that the provisions of these directions are enforced within their respective commands.

2. With effect from 1 May 46, Anti-Malaria measures will be instituted by each Unit and all personnel of Rome Area Allied Command.

3. Individual Measures

a. Bed or Bar Nets

All personnel will sleep under mosquito or sandfly nets. Instruction on the proper use and care of nets will be given by unit anti malaria officers and anti malaria details. Care will be taken to ensure that nets are rolled down before sunset and that they are maintained free from holes.

b. Clothing

Throughout Rome Area Allied Command, including the cities of ROME and FLORENCE, slacks will be worn, sleeves will be rolled down and shirt necks buttoned by 1930 hours daily during the malaria season. Troops going out on duty or recreation before 1930 hours and unable to return to their billet in time to change by 1930 hours will either wear slacks during the period of absence or will take slacks with them and change into these at or before 1930 hours.

b. Clothing (continued)

Anti-Mosquito Clothing for Women's Services in Rome Area Allied Command will not be taken into use except by such personnel as may be stationed in the Coastal Belt.

c. Insect Repellents

Insect Repellent will be applied to all exposed parts of the body at dusk and will be re-applied every four hours.

4. Unit Measures

a. All Unit Billets or tents will be sprayed at least once daily, preferably at sunset, with insecticide, Aerosol/Flit, to kill mosquitoes.

b. Where necessary and on the advice of the Malaria Control Unit operating in the unit area, this spraying may be extended to include neighbouring civilian houses and out-buildings when their proximity is a menace to troops billets.

c. Mosquito breeding places within one mile of all unit lines will be drained, oiled or treated with Paris Green by the Unit Anti-Malaria Details/Squads. Close liaison will be maintained between neighbouring Units and with Malaria Control Unit to ensure co-ordination of effort and to avoid overlap.

d. Units in areas where the volume of work necessary to carry out unit measures is too great will request assistance from the Surgeon (ADMS) this Headquarters.

5. Exceptions to the above measures

a. The danger of transmission of Malaria within the cities of ROME and FLORENCE is considered minimal and therefore the cities are declared to be non-malarious and will be considered "not free" areas unless otherwise prescribed in the future.

b. Static Units and personnel permanently billeted in the cities of ROME and FLORENCE will draw bed nets but will be excepted from the provisions of this order as set

forth concerning bed nets and insect repellents (paragraphs 3a and 3c above). This will not be construed as applying to units and personnel located near the cities of ROME and FLORENCE but who are not actually located in the "built-up" area.

6. Atabrine/Mepracrine

a. Atabrine/Mepracrine will not be taken by static units assigned to this Command except in those cases where the duties of the unit involve regular travelling between ROME and NAPLES at night; e.g., train guards.

b. Atabrine/Mepracrine will be specifically ordered where considered necessary.

7. Coastal Belt

a. The Coastal Belt is highly volcanic and should be cleared of troops not required for operational purposes by one hour before sunset.

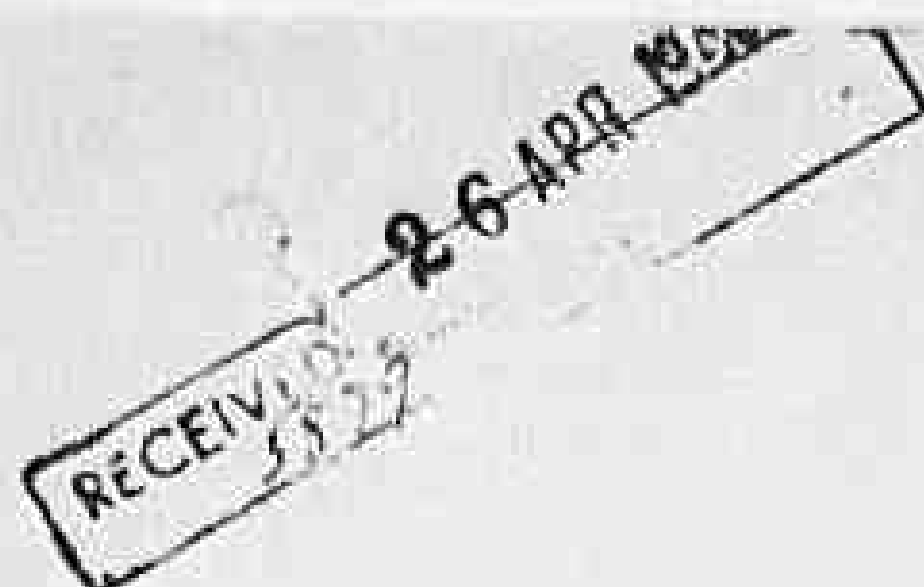

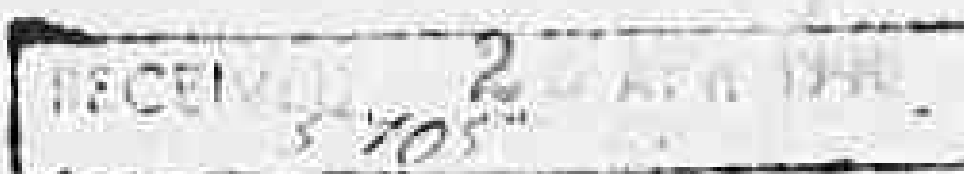

SUBJECT: Malaria Control 1946Distribution "M" British

1. Owing to the shortage of manpower, the number of trained Malaria Control personnel in this area will be insufficient to exercise supervision on the scale practised during 1945.
2. It is therefore of paramount importance that all anti-malaria work done by units should be of the highest order.
3. The following measures of anti-larval and anti-adult control will be carried out by all units, with effect from 1st May 46;

(a) Units located in ROME CITY.

- (I) All billets will be sprayed daily with Flysol preferably at reveille and dusk.
- (II) Static water should not be allowed to accumulate in tins or drums, or in any other receptacle in which mosquitoes may breed.

(b) Units located OUTSIDE ROME CITY.

- (I) All billets will be sprayed daily with Flysol preferably at reveille and dusk.
- (II) All likely breeding places within a 2 kilo radius of the unit should be sprayed with Flysol.

3. The following measures of anti-larval and anti-adult control will be carried out by all units, with effect from 1st May 46;

(a) Units located in ROME CITY.

- (I) All billets will be sprayed daily with Flysol preferably at reveille and dusk.
- (II) Static water should not be allowed to accumulate in tins or drums, or in any other receptacle in which mosquitoes may breed.

(b) Units located OUTSIDE ROME CITY.

- (I) All billets will be sprayed daily with Flysol preferably at reveille and dusk.
- (II) All likely breeding places within a 2 mile radius of unit lines will be controlled. Pools and ~~4500~~ ⁴⁵⁰⁰ will be drained, or oiled if draining is impractical. Vegetation growing beside water stretches will be cut back.

4. Expert advice and assistance will be provided by OC 75 AMCU attached 100 (Br) General Hospital. Application for such advice and assistance should be made to SURGEON, (ALMS) Rome Area Allied Command.

5. So that maximum efficiency may result from unit anti-malaria work, Officers Commanding Units will, appoint a Malaria Officer forthwith.

6. All Unit Malaria Officers will attend a lecture and film show at the cinema HQ RAAC at 1000 hours 16th April 1946.
