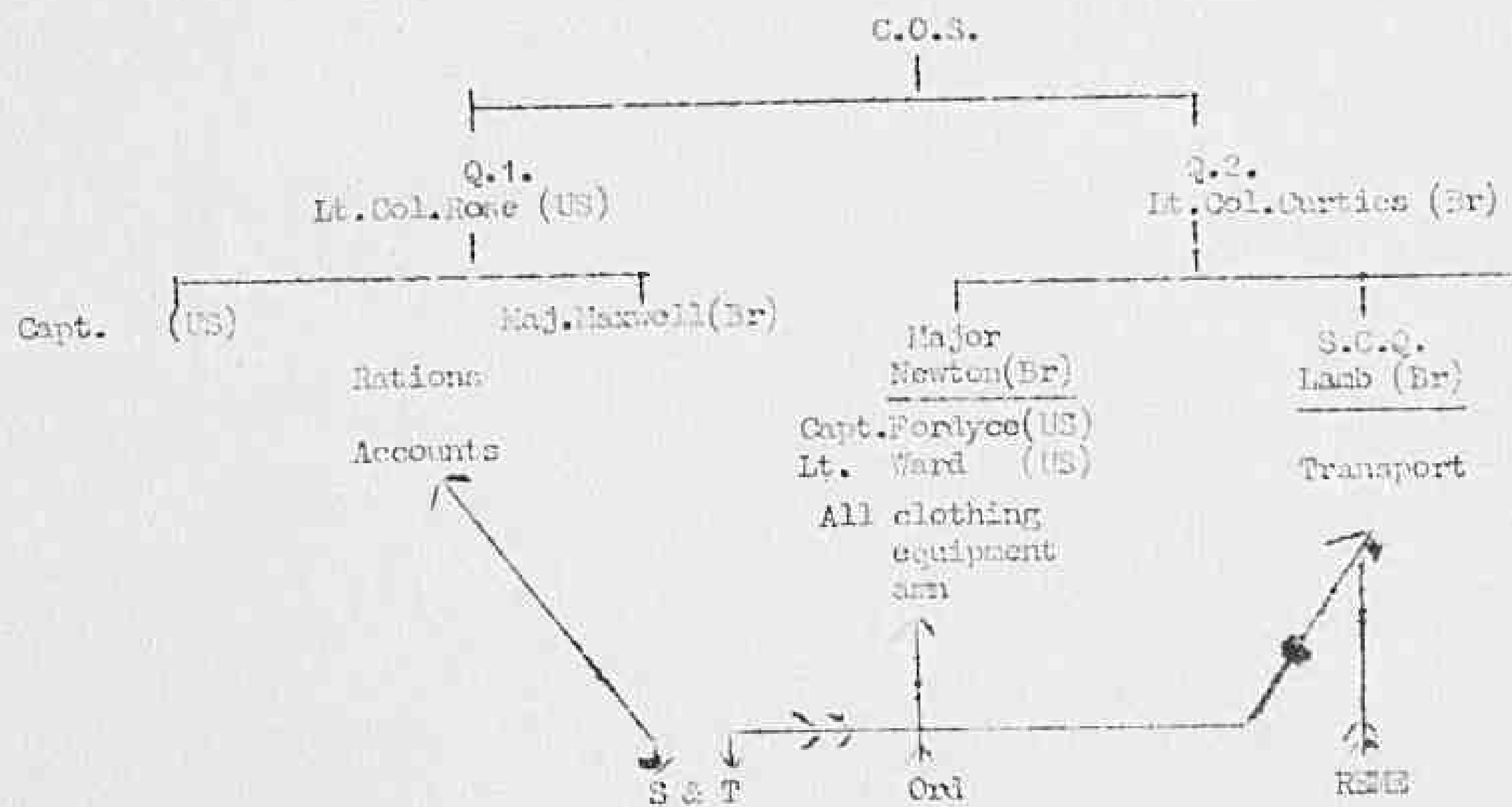

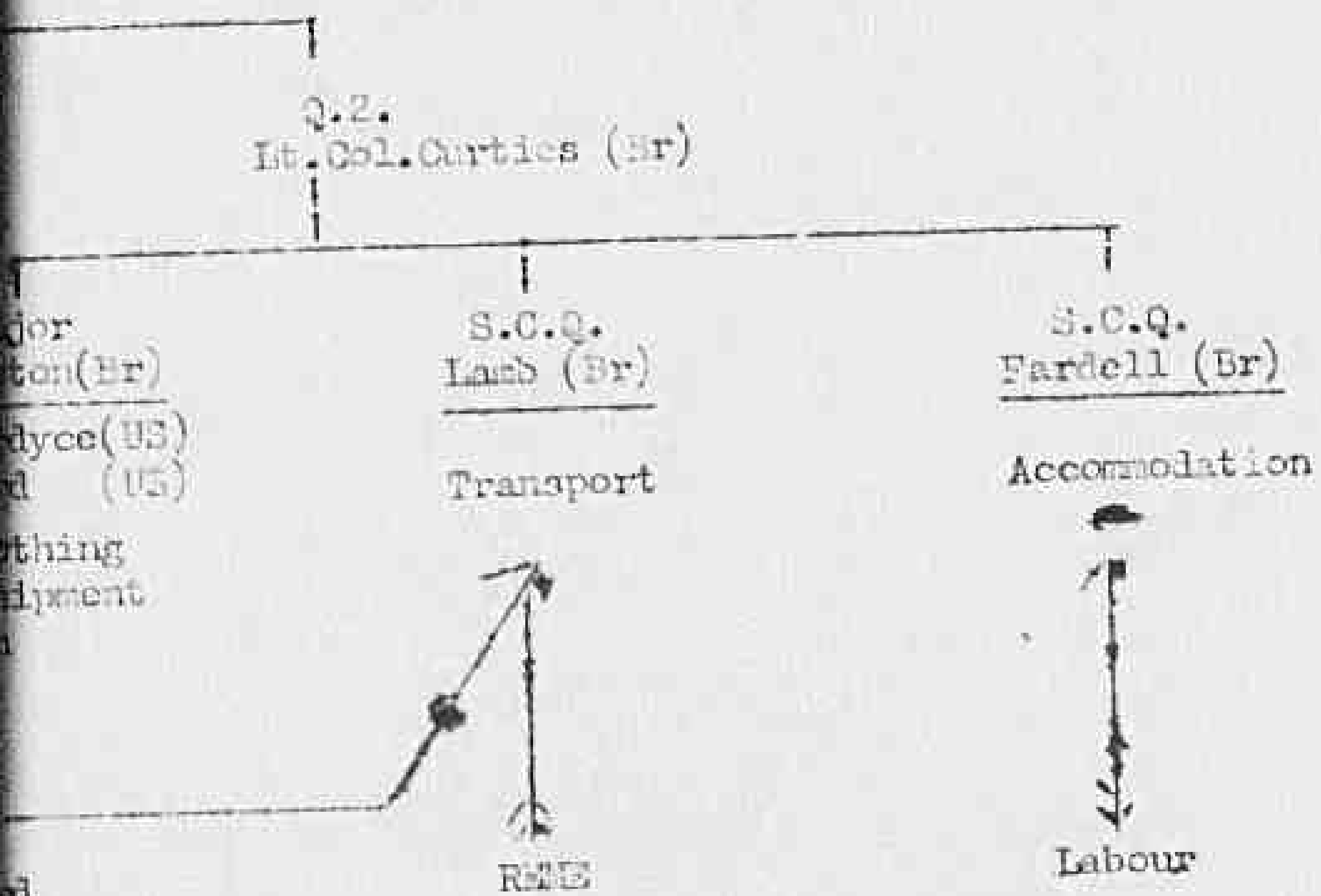

APPENDIX "A" TO INSTRUCTION NO. 4 DATED 11 JULY 1945.

ADDITIONAL PAY - N.C.Os. ARMY FIRE SERVICE (PER. CORPS/F.P.W.).

(a)

With effect from the date of this circular the grant of additional pay under Article 894 of the R.W. for Pay 1940 to N.C.Os. of First Class Army Fire Brigades in this column will cease to be published monthly in Part II Order. In future initial entitlement and cessation only will be published.

(b)

The following instructions will, therefore, be carefully complied with:-

- (i) N.C.Os. already in receipt of such additional pay. Casualties will be submitted reporting entitlement week. day following the last monthly period of entitlement ready published, and will include the following: "To continue in receipt of additional pay until further notice."
- (ii) N.C.Os. who become entitled subsequent to the issue of this instruction. Casualties will be submitted reporting initial entitlement and will include the following: "To continue in receipt of additional pay until further notice."
- (iii) Cessation of entitlement. In all cases immediately the conditions of entitlement cease for any reason units will submit casualties reporting cessation.
- (iv) Entries in A.B. 64 (Part II). Initial Entitlement. Entitlement to additional pay will be recorded as shown below in the soldier's A.B. 64 (Part II) on the Daily Rates of Pay folio on the line immediately following the last rates of pay, etc., entered, and the

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- (ii) Casualties will be submitted reporting entitlement N.C.O. day following the last monthly period of entitlement "ready published, and will include the following: "To continue in receipt of additional pay until further notice." N.C.O. who become entitled subsequent to the issue of this instruction. Casualties will be submitted reporting initial entitlement and will include the following "To continue in receipt of additional pay until further notice." Cessation of entitlement. In all cases immediately the conditions of entitlement cease for any reason units will submit casualties reporting cessation.
- (iii) Entries in A.B. 64 (Part II). Initial entitlement. Entitlement to additional pay will be recorded as shown below in the soldier's A.B. 64 (Part II) on the Daily Rates of Pay folio on the line immediately following the last rates of pay, etc., entered, and the entry authenticated by an officer:-

"Additional pay, 1st Class Army Fire Brigade, amount in figures and words in column headed 'Net Rates to be issued', date from which issued" and signature".

Date of initial entitlement in respect of N.C.O.s already in receipt of this additional pay will be the date reported in accordance with sub-para (b) (i) above.

Cessation of entitlement. When entitlement ceases for any reason, the additional pay entry in A.B. 64 (Part II) will be ruled through, the normal rates of pay, etc., recorded on the line immediately below, the date of cessation and the reason for the change recorded, the entry being authenticated by an officer.

- (c) When an N.C.O. is posted from a First Class Army Fire Brigade to another First Class Army Fire Brigade, the receiving unit will continue from A.B. 64 (Part II) that the N.C.O. is in receipt of additional pay under Article 894 R.W. For Pay 1940 and will include the following on the casualty report taking over strength: "Continues in receipt of additional pay under Article 894 R.W. for Pay 1940."

TRADESMEN - DESPATCH RIDERS (R. SIGNALS) - REVISION OF TRADE TEST.

1. The existing trade test for Despatch Rider (R. Signals) has been revised in certain particulars, the most important of which is the addition of the qualification of ability to driver a 5-wt. car.
2. In accordance with Army Tradesmen Regulations and Trade Tests, 1943, para. 53, the period during which existing tradesmen will be required to re-qualify under the revised trade test has been fixed at 12 months from the date of this A.C.I.
3. Soldiers mustered as Despatch Riders (R. Signals) who, at the expiration of the period referred to in para. 2 above, have not re-qualified under the revised trade test, will revert to normal rates of pay.
4. Supplies of the revised qualification sheet A.F.B. 171-4 may be obtained on demand from the appropriate Army Forms Depot.

6. CORRESPONDENCE.

7. ENLISTMENT - RECORDING OF THE AGE OF SOLDIERS FOUND TO BE UNDER AGE DECLARED ON ENLISTMENT.

In all cases where soldiers, other than those enlisted as boys, who, on production of a birth certificate, are found to be under the age stated on their Attestation or Record of Service prior to the following action will be taken:-

1. Entry as shown below will be made on top of page 2 in A.B. 64 Part I in red ink and will be initialed by an Officer:-
"Actual age claimed on (date)."

Recorded on enlistment will not be amended, and that this age will be regarded as the soldier's age for all Army purposes other than drafting overseas and eligibility for admission to the married establishment and/or issue of family allowances under post-war regulations.

8. VENEREAL DISEASE - TRANSMISSION'S RULES OF PAY.

Para. 2(c) of G.R.O. 161/44 was deliberately omitted from the re-published version under G.R.O. 1658/44.

The contraction of venereal disease is not a ground for traveling a traveller.

9. A.P.P. 22 - NOTIFICATION OF MARRIAGE OR BIRTH - SUSPENSION OF USE IN THEATRES OF WAR.

The use of A.P.P. 22 will be discontinued for the duration of the present emergency.

This type of vacancy will in future, be reverted to G.R.O., and inclusion of notes on A.P.P. W. 5041 or 5042.

- (ii) The following points and examples are set out in order to clarify the position:-
 - (a) When a posting order is received naming a specific effective date, the despatching unit will advise the officer off strength with effect from

10. DOCUMENTATION - OFFICER POSITIONS.

- (i) There appears to be a certain amount of confusion in units as to the correct method of striking Officers off strength when posting orders are received.
- (ii) The following points and examples are set out in order to clarify the position:-
- (a) When a posting order is received naming no specific effective date, the dispatching unit will strike the officer off strength with effect from the date of departure, and the receiving unit takes the officer on strength with effect from the date of arrival. Casualties will be rendered accordingly.

Date of posting for records purposes will, in fact, be the date following the day of departure from previous unit or depot. This date will be ascertained by G.H.Q., 3rd Echelon, and notification will be made in relative Part II Orders subsequently published.

- (b) When a posting order states the effective date of posting, then each unit will record the casualty with effect from that date.

(c) When posting involves promotion, the effective date for promotion is the date of reporting for duty to the new unit. A separate casualty notifying promotion will be published and attached to this Headquarters.

(d) Where posting orders to other theatres contain the words "and will be S.O.S. this theatre W.O.F. the date of embarkation" this information is included for use by this Headquarters only. Units will strike off strength W.O.F. date of leaving to proceed to port of embarkation.

(e) Units are not empowered to post to "X" lists. On receipt of authority from Headquarters competent to issue instructions which will involve the posting of an individual to "X" list, G.O. units will strike personnel off strength of the unit under command by publication of a casualty on the following lines:-

"S.O.S. of.....on posting to "X" (i) List.
Authority....."

10. DOCUMENTATION - OFFICER POSTINGS (CONTINUED).

Such consultation will be published only when specific information is embodied in the posting order to the effect that the individual will be taken on the strength of "X" (4) List.

(iii) Posting Orders, when received, should be acted on quickly and intelligently - see G.R.O. 754/44.

If compliance is impossible, the matter should be reported immediately by telephone or cable to A.F.H.Q. and reported to this Headquarters. (iv) Where a unit receives a posting order stating that an Officer is posted to that unit, if the Officer or Officer concerned do not join within reasonable time, the matter should be reported as in para. (iii) above.

11. UNLOCATED PERSONNEL.

Information is sought in respect of the unaccounted-for personnel who are unlocated in records at this Headquarters. Any unit holding these men on strength, or having knowledge of them, will communicate immediately with this Headquarters.

RECORD INSTRUCTION TO R.SIGNALS UNITS. NO 32.

1. TRADESMEN - DESPATCH RIDERS (R.SIGNALS) - REVISION OF TRADE TEST.

Reference Record Instruction to R.Signals Units, No 32, para 2.

It is noted that to date, very few despatch riders have been requalified under the revised trade test.

In accordance with para 2 of ACI 279 of 1945, the 13 Mar 46 is the last day in which personnel mastered in this trade are allowed to requalify under the revised trade test and any who have not requalified by that date will be reverted to normal rates of pay.

It is important therefore, that steps should be taken for all despatch riders who have not yet requalified in this trade, to be prepared for test and tested as early as possible, and casualty rendered to this HQ in accordance with Record Instruction No 32.

For any men who fail to requalify by 13 Mar 46, a casualty in accordance with the following example should be published :-
