WAGE-RATES OF ALLIED COMMISSION/ALLIED
MILITARY GOVERNMENT CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES

1. The maximum and minimum wage rates payable to civilian employees of Allied Commission/Allied Military Government, together with cost-of-living bonuses, allowances, etc., are governed by AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 34, dated 29 June 1945, entitled "Conditions of Employment, Wage Scales, Bonuses and Allowances for Civilians Employed by the Allied Forces in Italy, Sicily and Sardinia", and its subsequent amendments.

2. In the past, Finance Sub-Commission, through the Audit Division of the Accounting Sub-Section has made a careful check of all Wages paid to civilian employees, from the Payrolls submitted by Sub-accountants with their monthly Reports of Receipts and Disbursements, and where the rates have not conformed to the authorized scale, and Observation has been sent to the Sub-accountant, calling for an explanation of the apparent error.

3. Since the implementation of AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 25, 1945, which authorized Labor and Wages Sub-Committees of the Allied Forces to make further upward adjustments of the Cost-of-Living bonuses locally, it has in fact been found impracticable for the Audit Division to check the rates of pay, as the local variations in authorized rates have become too complex and diverse to follow at this Headquarters. For example, the areas of jurisdiction of the Local Wages Sub-Committees do not necessarily coincide with Regional boundaries; and the directives issued by the Sub-Committees frequently authorize a flat rate of increase in the bonus without quoting a cumulative figure.

4. Nevertheless it is of the utmost importance that Sub-accountants and other Officers responsible for compiling Payrolls ensure strict adherence to the authorized scale, and to give effect to this, ALL PAYROLLS

to the authorized scale, and observation has been sent to the Sub-accountant, calling for an explanation of the apparent error.

3. Since the implementation of AFHQ administrative Memorandum Number 25, 1945, which authorized Labor and Wages Sub-Committees of the Allied Forces to make further upward adjustments of the Cost-of-Living bonuses locally, it has in fact been found impracticable for the audit Division to check the rates of pay, as the local variations in authorized rates have become too complex and diverse to follow at this Headquarters. For example, the areas of jurisdiction of the Local Wages Sub-Committees do not necessarily coincide with Regional boundaries; and the directives issued by the Sub-Committees frequently authorize a flat rate of increase in the bonus without quoting a cumulative figure.

4. Nevertheless it is of the utmost importance that Sub-accountants and other Officers responsible for compiling Payrolls ensure strict adherence to the rates authorized in their area, and to give effect to this, ALL PAYROLLS WILL IN FUTURE BEAR THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL CERTIFICATE, SIGNED BY THE PAYING OFFICER:

"Certified that all above rates of pay are in accordance with existing AFHQ authorized scales, as modified by Local Wages Sub-Committees".

This order is to be strictly complied with.

5. Cabled instructions to this effect have already been sent to Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia, Venezia and Venezia Giulia, under reference Number 4251, dated 25 August 1945.

AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 34, 1945, is amended as follows:

1. Paragraphs 1a and 1b are rescinded.
2. Paragraphs 6b, c and d are rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

"6. b. The following provisions are generally applicable throughout Italy, Sicily and Sardinia at the discretion of District, Base Section or equivalent commanders for the territory under their control.

(1) Italian Civilian directly employed by the Allied Forces may be paid, in addition to the amounts established in Paragraph 4 above, all or part of cost-of-living bonus as set forth in Appendix "H" hereto.

(2) The maximum permissible bonus which may be paid is determined by the basic wage applicable to the individual. For this purpose, the basic wage is the remuneration due to an individual upon completion of eight (8) hours work if paid on a daily basis; 26 days work if paid on a monthly basis, or 30 days work in case of Hotel, Mess and Club

(1) Italian Civilian directly employed by the Allied Forces may be paid, in addition to the amounts established in paragraph 4 above, all or part of cost-of-living bonus as set forth in Appendix "H" hereto.

(2) The maximum permissible bonus which may be paid is determined by the basic wage applicable to the individual. For this purpose, the basic wage is the remuneration due to an individual upon completion of eight (8) hours work if paid on a daily basis; 26 days work if paid on a monthly basis, or 30 days work in case of Hotel, Mess and Club employees. The cost-of-living bonus is not part of the basic wage and will be excluded, for example, from the computations and adjustments for overtime pay and differential.

(3) In the case of an employee who does not work a full pay period the proportion of the bonus which may be paid is to correspond with the proportion of basic wages, excluding overtime, earned during that period."

3. The provisions of AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 25, 1945, are made applicable to the whole of Italy, Sicily and Sardinia.

4. Appendix "A" is amended by the deletion of: "Band Leader 3000 Minimum 5500 Maximum."

5. Appendix "F" is amended by the deletion of:

"Band Leader 55 lire (per hour) plus 20% total cost of band)"
"Band Member 55 lire (per hour)."

6. Appendix "D" is amended by the insertion of the following:

"Musicians Hourly - for engagement not exceeding 4 hours
75-150 lire per hour."

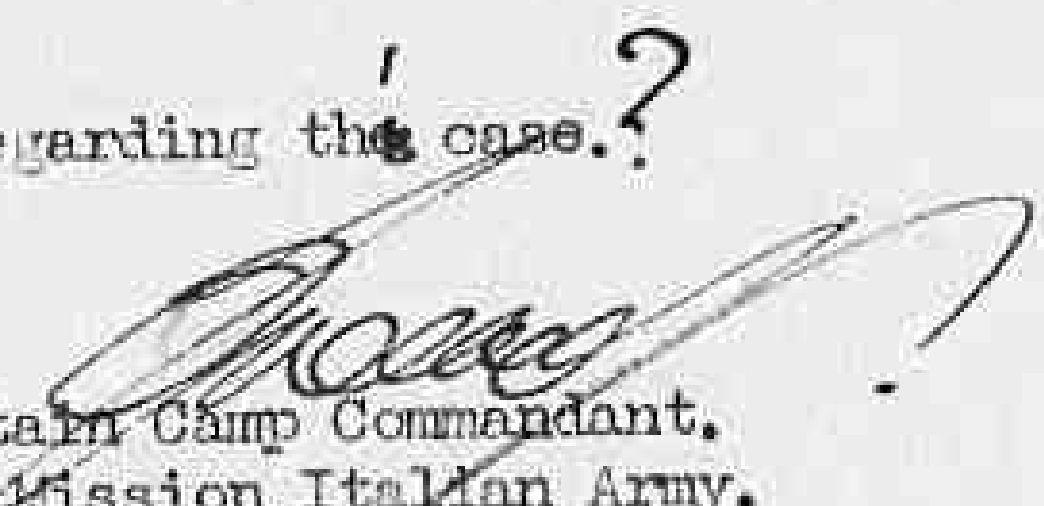

SUBJECT: Accident Report

TO : Establishment Section

1. This is to report as a matter of official record, an accident which occurred at 0826 hours on the morning of 3 August 1945, in front of the ground floor entrance off Via Veneto on the driveway adjacent to the Minister delle Corporazioni Building.

2. Major L. W. Stearns, Staff Officer to the Chief Commissioner, was struck while crossing the driveway to the building entrance by MMIA vehicle No. M55428, assigned to Major Genis and driven by Achille Drei. The truck was travelling at a high rate of speed against the normal flow of traffic on the one-way driveway that extends from the main entrance to the ground floor entrance on Via Veneto. Major Stearns was struck on the left arm midway between the elbow and shoulder and fell on the pavement on his left hip. The force of impact caused him to be overthrown three complete times. Flesh injuries were received, and were treated by Major Belafsky, Regimental Surgeon.

3. It is recommended that MMIA take immediate disciplinary action against the civilian driver. There is no excuse for driving a vehicle at excessive speed against traffic on a one-way street. It is further recommended that the Headquarters Commandant post signs along this driveway, in English and Italian, to the effect that it is open to one-way traffic only.

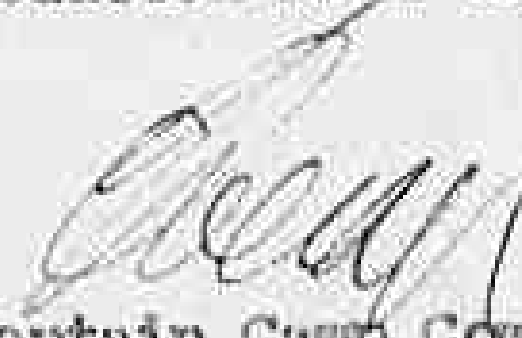

SUBJECT: Leave, Civilian Employees

TO : See Distribution

1. The following rules concerning leave, and travel in connection therewith, are applicable to all Allied civilian employees of AC/AMG:

- a. The concurrence of the section or sub-commission personnel and administrative officer will be required prior to the submission of the leave form to this office. If leave is desired outside the vicinity of Rome, the proper request for orders (request for travel or assignment orders) must be submitted through the normal channels, stating in the blank provided for complete statement of the mission the following purpose: "authorized leave of absence". Travel will not be requested by ATC aircraft or rail unless accompanied by a statement to the effect that cost of the travel will be borne by the individual. Individual motor transport, except travel by the regular courier services, will not be requested, although if the individual transport is scheduled to the destination of the individual, this office has no objection, except as

prior to the submission of the leave form to the office.

If leave is desired outside the vicinity of Rome, the proper request for orders (request for travel or assignment orders) must be submitted through the normal channels, stating in the blank provided for complete statement of the mission the following purpose: "authorized leave of absence". Travel will not be requested by ATC aircraft or rail unless accompanied by a statement to the effect that cost of the travel will be borne by the individual. Individual motor transport, except travel by the regular courier services, will not be requested, although if the individual transport is scheduled to the destination of the individual, this office has no objection, except as laid down by Ltr. Ref. 550/118/EC, Office of the Executive Commissioner, subject "Travel to Northern Towns", dated 21 June 1945. ①

b. Employees who travel contrary to regulations do so at their own risk. Ignorance of the law and/or regulations cannot be considered an excuse.

c. Orders will not be requested for secretarial employees to travel unless concurred in by the Section concerned. Anyone travelling on leave outside the Rome Area without proper military orders is subject to disciplinary action which means placing the individual in a "leave without pay" status.

d. Prior to departure from Rome, arrangements must be made in advance for messing and billeting by the individual. The Army does not accept this responsibility.

2. Travel orders will not be granted for secretarial employees to proceed on temporary duty away from their assigned posts unless the request therefor is accompanied by a detailed explanation of the necessity for the travel.
3. Travel orders will not be issued to locally-employed civilians for leave purposes.
