Reference this HQ letter SD/103 dated 19 Nov 45 and your letters 168/Ord/II di prot dated 12 Jan 46 and 605/Ord/II dated 1 Feb 46.

1. Owing to the poor availability of British OR reinforcements, great difficulty is being experienced by Type 'A' BLUs to Territorial Com-mands as personnel become due for demobilisation and replacements are difficult to obtain.

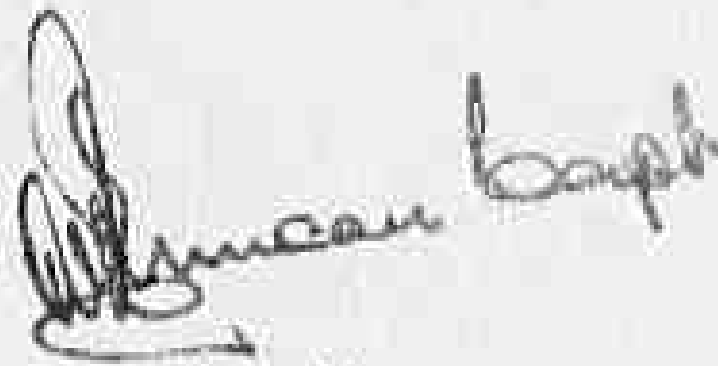

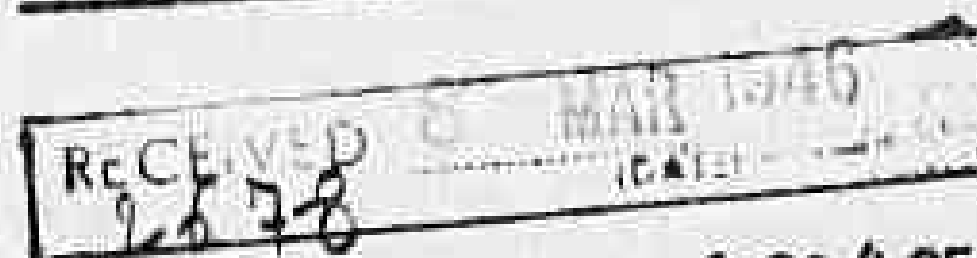

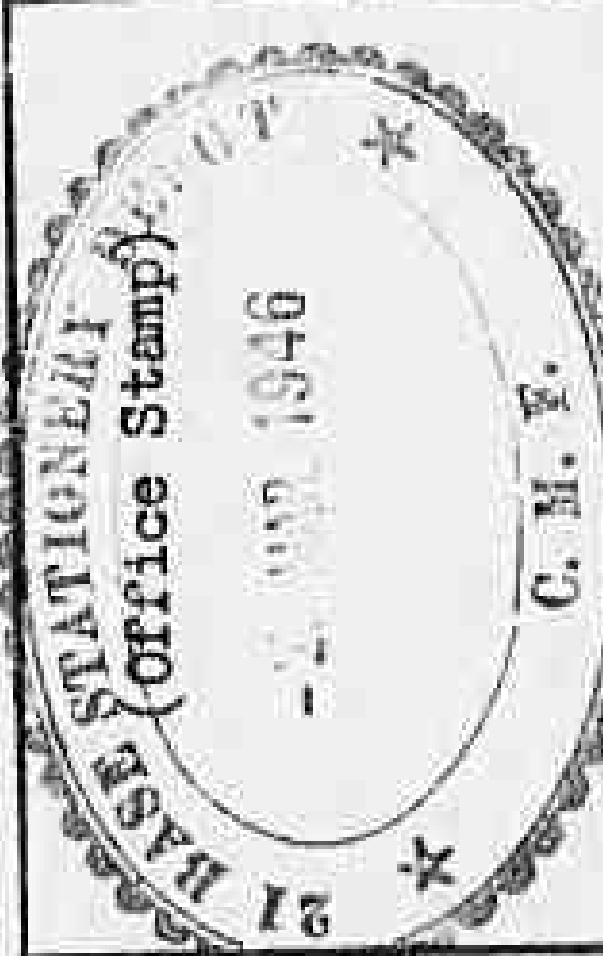
