Dear Sir,

Thank you for your letter of the 6th. September. I have looked into your son's record of service, and note that he went to Egypt on 21st. March, 1941, and has served continuously since that date.

While it is correct that his service towards his regular engagement now reckons from the 15th. March, 1943, he does not for purpose of repatriation under the Pythons Scheme forfeit either his former service or the period which he spent in prison. He has, therefore, completed the necessary period abroad to render him eligible for return to this country on long service grounds, and his name is being sent to the overseas command with a recommendation that he be posted home as soon as this can be arranged.

I cannot say just when this will be as the detailed arrangements must be left to the authorities on the spot, but I do not think you should now have long to wait, and on his arrival in this country your son will be entitled to 28 day's disembarkation leave.

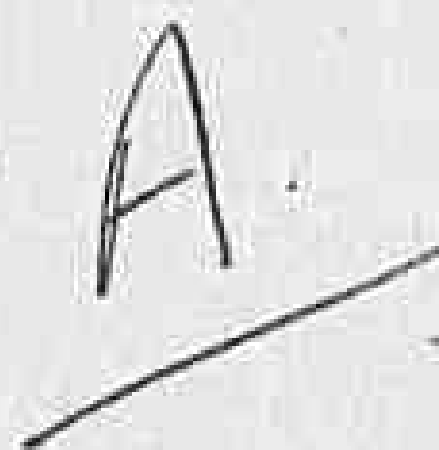
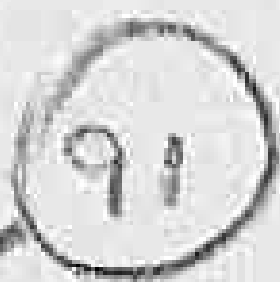

About 3 weeks ago sir, I understand, a request was directed to this HQ from HQ Army Welfare/Newspaper Services for my services (I presume for our Services Newspaper, The Union Jack, in view of the ever-present shortage of trained Newspapersmen). I understand then, sir, that a signal was despatched saying that as I was now a full Corporal an experienced RASC Corporal clerk was required before I would be released.

Quite recently a fresh batch of clerks and learner clerks (among them 2 Corporals) have been assigned to the Mission.

In view of all the above, sir, and as it is now more than 8 months since I first requested a transfer to either PWB or The Union Jack, I take the liberty of requesting that further consideration be given to my application.

I am confident that with my qualifications (before the outbreak of war I was staff journalist with the DAILY EXPRESS (Scottish Edition)) I would be of valuable assistance as reporter or sub-writer/editor. I feel too sir, that since the cessation of hostilities a Services' newspaper is most important during this period and with regard to my civilian occupation I would be admirably fitted to return to a national newspaper, refreshed and armed with new and valuable experience.

Trusting that favourable consideration be given to this request I respectfully await your decision.

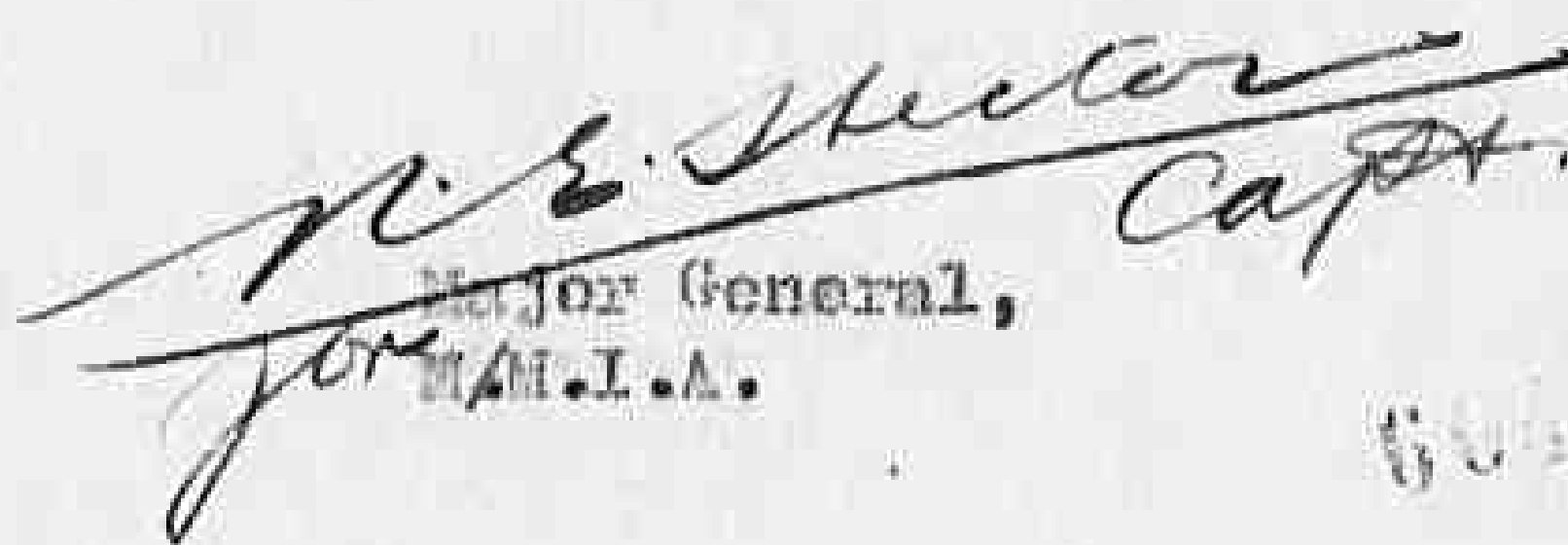

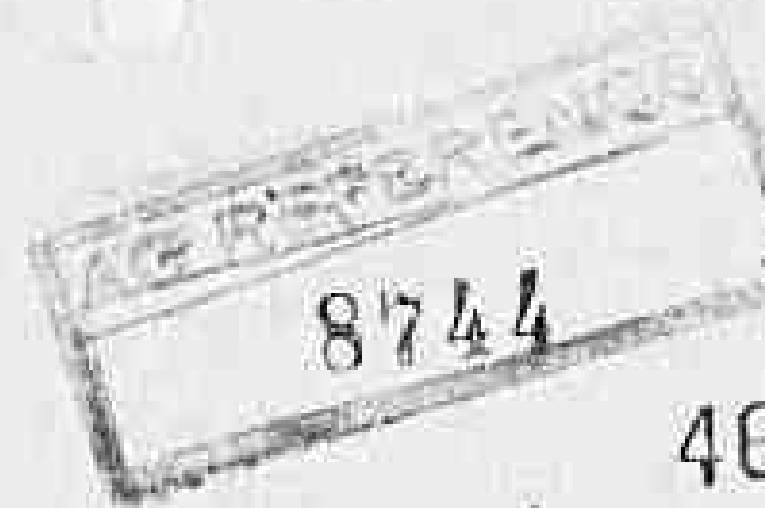
