ARMY COUNCIL INSTRUCTION No. 74 of 1944

Circulated down to Companies, Batteries and Equivalent Units

THE WAR OFFICE,

15th January, 1944.

74. Movement of Troops.—Individuals and Parties (other than complete units) Arriving by Sea in the United Kingdom from Abroad—Procedure for Disposal and Taking on Strength.

1. *Application.*—This A.C.I. does not apply to personnel returned from West Africa on recuperative leave or from Iceland (C), or the Faroe Islands on privilege leave; the arrangements already existing for these categories will continue in force. Nor does it apply to special classes for whom separate instructions have been or may be issued, e.g., escaped and repatriated prisoners of war, long service personnel reverting to the Home Establishment, etc.

2. *Duties of ship's staff.*

- (a) It will be the duty of the O.C. troops to ensure that every officer and other rank (including those invalided) is in possession of a document of authority for personnel proceeding to the United Kingdom (A.F. W 5133), Part I of which will have been completed before embarkation, and Part II of which will be completed and signed on board. Where an individual embarks without A.F. W 5133, the O.C. troops will provide a form and ensure that Part II is completed and signed by the individual. Documents of authority will be kept in safe custody (with A.Fs. W 5169) during the voyage.
- (b) The O.C. troops will ensure that every officer completes and signs an arrival report (A.F. B 174A).
- (c) (i) On arrival, it will be the duty of the O.C. troops to hand over to the embarkation staff a document of authority for every officer and other rank and an arrival report for every officer disembarking.
- (ii) Documents of authority will be collated by corps and regiments; those which have not been completed in respect of Part I being handed over separately with a covering nominal roll to the embarkation staff for transmission to the security control officer.
- (iii) Arrival reports will be handed over separately (in bulk) to the embarkation staff for immediate transmission to the War Office.
- (d) O.C. troops will also be responsible for assembling and marshalling personnel in the order they are required by the embarkation staff.

Duties of embarkation staffs and security control officers.

3. *Security measures.*—Where an A.F. W 5133 is not completed in respect of Part I, the individual concerned will be interviewed by the security control officer, who will make enquiries regarding his *bona fides*. If the security control officer is satisfied, he will suitably endorse Part I of the document and pass it to the embarkation commandant, who will dispose of the individual in the normal manner. If not satisfied, the individual will be held at the port of disembarkation under arrangements to be made by the embarkation commandant and the matter will be referred by the security control officer to the War Office (A.G. 1 (B)), stating the overseas command from which the individual is alleged to have returned.

4. *Disposal of individuals.*—Individuals will be dispersed from port of disembarkation as follows:—

- (a) The following will be despatched direct to their leave addresses, for periods of leave in accordance with para. 12 below:—
 - (i) All officers *above* the rank of lieutenant-colonel (including war substantive, temporary and acting ranks).
 - (ii) All members of the R.A.Ch.D.
 - (iii) All nursing officers and V.A.D. members.
 - (iv) All Queen's Army Schoolmistresses.
 - (v) All married officers and other ranks accompanied by their families.
- (b) Invalids and other personnel requiring immediate hospital treatment will be despatched to the appropriate hospital (see para. 5 below).
- (c) Officers of regiments and corps, other than the Intelligence Corps, who held intelligence appointments overseas immediately before embarkation will be despatched direct to the Intelligence Corps Depot, Rotherham, Yorks. Similarly, officers who were employed with the C.M.P. overseas immediately before embarkation will be despatched direct to the C.M.P. Depot and Training Establishment, Mytchett Camp, Aldershot.
- (d) Officers, soldiers and A.T.S. auxiliaries, other than those mentioned in sub-para. (a), (b) and (c) above, will be despatched to their appropriate receiving unit, in accordance with the schedule issued to embarkation staffs.
- (e) (i) Former officers arriving from abroad after having been cashiered or dismissed the Service will be permitted to proceed to their homes or selected places of residence on satisfactory proof of identity. Attention is drawn to A.C.I. 1964 of 1942, para. 2.
- (ii) Nursing officers arriving from abroad for relegation to the unemployed list or for termination of services with effect from the day following the date of disembarkation will proceed direct to their home address.
- (f) *O.C.T.U. candidates from overseas.*—Personnel who are returned to the United Kingdom for O.C.T.U. training will be disposed of in accordance with para. 4 (d).
 Personnel returned to the United Kingdom from West Africa for O.C.T.U. training and recuperative leave will also be disposed of under para. 4 (d) and will be granted recuperative leave in accordance with the Leave Manual, 1943, *after* they have reported to the appropriate receiving unit. The personnel concerned will take leave certificates to their receiving units.

Note.—The list of units mentioned in the pamphlet "Selection of Potential Officers—Their Preliminary Training and Commissioning", notified in A.C.I. 2623 of 1941, Appendix J, is hereby *cancelled*, and will be replaced by the receiving units mentioned in the schedule referred to in para. 4 (d).

- (g) *Survivors from shipwreck.*—Individuals who are shipwrecked on their voyage to the United Kingdom will receive seven days "survivor's" leave in addition to disembarkation leave as laid down in para. 13 below. Survivors who are landed in the United Kingdom following recent embarkation for service overseas will receive seven days' "survivor's" leave only. Survivors will be clothed by the unit or ordnance depot nearest the port under instructions issued by the embarkation commandant, and they will then be despatched to their appropriate receiving unit, where they will be granted leave as above.
- (h) British officers and other ranks belonging to the Indian Army, if not requiring immediate hospital treatment, will be instructed to proceed to their homes and to report in writing to the India Office within seven days of arrival.
 They will be issued with A.F. B 2606 in the case of officers and food ration cards for *one week only*, by the embarkation staff officer.

5. *Invalids and other personnel requiring immediate hospital treatment.*

Personnel invalided to the United Kingdom (i.e., those in medical categories D or E) and other personnel who, on disembarkation, are in need of immediate hospital treatment will be admitted direct to hospital under arrangements to be made by the embarkation medical officer at the port under instructions from the D.D.M.S. of the command or district concerned.

Their subsequent disposal (i.e., when fit to travel on leave or on transfer to another hospital nearer to their home addresses) will be in accordance with instructions issued separately to D.Ds.M.S. of commands.

6. *Personnel despatched direct on leave.*—Where personnel are despatched direct on leave (see para. 4 (a) above) embarkation staffs (assisted when necessary by additional personnel provided by command headquarters on demand) will:—

- (a) (i) Issue the appropriate travel documents, in accordance with the instructions contained in the Leave Manual, 1943, para. 192, for the journeys to the leave address and thence to the appropriate receiving unit. Documents for return travel will *not* be issued to officers above the rank of lieutenant-colonel, chaplains, nursing officers, V.A.D. members and Queen's Army Schoolmistresses, for whom see sub-para. (f) below. Attention is drawn to instruction (11) on the covers of A.Fs. W 4099 and W 4098.
- (ii) Issue baggage consignment notes (A.F. G 980 (War)) for the conveyance by merchandise train of the regulated quantity of baggage.

(b) Issue ration cards.

(c) Arrange for embarkation paymasters to issue advances of pay and ration allowances at leave rates to other ranks.

(d) Issue officers' clothing coupons except to officers detailed in paras. 4 (e) (i) and (ii) in accordance with A.C.I. 244 of 1943, para. 2 (d) first sub-paragraph, and obtain signed receipts which will be forwarded to the War Office, London, S.W. 1 (M.S. 1 or personnel branch concerned).

To enable him to bring his kit up to Home scale each officer will be given an A.F. H 1124, 1125 or 1126, as appropriate, to complete and forward in due course to the C.O. of his unit.

(e) Issue A.Fs. B 2606 to officers where photographs are available. In this connexion attention is directed to A.C.I. 1523 of 1942, para. 13 (a).

(f) (i) Issue to all personnel a movement order (A.F. W 4049) showing the period of disembarkation leave granted and, except for officers above the rank of lieutenant-colonel, chaplains, nursing officers, V.A.D. members and Queen's Army Schoolmistresses, the unit to which they will report on the completion of leave in the absence of instructions to the contrary. This unit will be in accordance with the schedule of receiving units issued to embarkation staffs.

(ii) Officers above the rank of lieutenant-colonel, chaplains, and Queen's Army Schoolmistresses will be instructed to report immediately in writing to the War Office (M.S. 1 or personnel branch concerned) who will issue posting instructions and a travel warrant direct to each individual at the leave address.

(iii) Nursing officers will be instructed to report immediately in writing, to the War Office (A.M.D. 4) and to the O.C. Military Hospital, York, except for those arriving from abroad for reintegration to the unemployed list or for termination of services, who will report in writing to the War Office (A.M.D. 4) only.

(iv) V.A.D. members will be instructed to report immediately, in writing to the O. i/c Records, R.A.M.C., Colet Court, Hammersmith, London, W.6, who will issue posting instructions and travel warrants to each member at her leave address.

(g) (i) Warn personnel proceeding to destinations in Eire that they must travel in both directions in plain clothes and that the following must not be taken with them:—

Uniform,* arms, ammunition, or letters, documents or printed matter that has not been declared for censorship.

* Suitable stocks of civilian clothing are held at transit camps for such personnel.

- (ii) Warn personnel proceeding to destinations in Northern Ireland that the following must not be taken with them:—

• Letters, documents or printed matter that has not been declared for censorship.

In this connexion, attention is directed to the Leave Manual, 1943, Section X.

7. *Prior notification to receiving units.*—Embarkation commandants will advise movement control of the district in which the receiving unit is located, by teleprinter, of the impending arrival of personnel. This notification will include the number of the party, the date and time of departure, and the date and time of arrival. District movement control will pass the particulars by the quickest means possible to the receiving unit.

Duties of Receiving Units.

8. *Despatch on leave.*—All ranks will be despatched on leave in accordance with para. 12 below.

After satisfying himself as to their *bona fides*, in accordance with A.C.I. 1523 of 1942, para. 13 (a), the O.C. unit will issue officers with A.F. B 2606, and officers' clothing coupons in accordance with A.C.I. 244 of 1943, para. 2 (d). He will also carry out such clothing replacements as may be necessary to despatch personnel on leave.

9. *Parachutists.*—Receiving units will notify the Airborne Forces Depot, Hardwick Hall, Hardwick, Chesterfield, of the arrival from overseas of personnel, other than those belonging to the A.A.C., whose documents show that they have served in parachute units.

(10. Documentation.

(a) All ranks reporting direct to a receiving unit from port or ordered to report to a receiving unit on the completion of leave, will be taken on the strength of that receiving unit with effect from the date of disembarkation. The appropriate casualties will be published in unit Part II Orders (Officers) and Part II or Part III Orders (Other Ranks); the former will show the period of leave granted to each officer. The period of leave granted to other ranks will be notified to regimental paymasters on A.F. O 1865 by the receiving unit.

(b) Where personnel, who are due to arrive, fail to report at their receiving unit, the same procedure for taking on strength will be adopted, followed by the normal procedure for absence without leave.

(c) Where officers are sent direct on leave or to hospital from port or for any other reason do not proceed direct to their receiving unit, the War Office will post the individuals to the appropriate receiving unit with effect from the date of disembarkation, notifying the period of leave granted as shown on the document of authority. The receiving unit will then publish Part II Orders (Officers) as in sub-para. (a) above.

Completion and Disposal of Documents.

11. *Documents of authority (A.F. W 5133).*—Part I will be completed and disposed of by the embarkation staff as follows:—

(a) In the case of invalids and casualties (*see* para. 4 (b) above), the date of disembarkation and the period of leave granted together with leave address, or name of hospital (where known) will be entered in Part I. Parts I will then immediately be despatched in bulk, in the case of officers, to the Under-Secretary of State, The War Office, London, S.W. 1, and in the case of other ranks to the O. i/c records concerned.

(b) Where individuals are despatched direct on leave (*see* para. 4 (a) above), or direct to a receiving unit (*see* para. 4 (d) above), the name of the receiving unit and the date of disembarkation will be entered in Part I, which will then be disposed of as follows:—

(i) *Officers.*—Officers proceeding direct to the receiving unit will take their documents of authority with them and hand them to the C.O. on arrival. Documents of authority for officers despatched on leave will be sent to the War Office, London, S.W. 1.

- (ii) *Other ranks conducted by an officer.*—The documents of authority will be taken by the draft conducting officer and handed to the C.O. of the receiving unit on arrival.
- (iii) *Other ranks proceeding direct to a receiving unit, but not conducted, and those despatched on leave.* The documents of authority will be despatched by the embarkation staff by post to the appropriate receiving units.
- (c) After the necessary information has been extracted by receiving units, documents of authority will be despatched immediately in bulk to the Under-Secretary of State, The War Office, London, S.W.1, in the case of officers, and to the O. I/c records concerned in the case of other ranks.
- (d) In the case of British officers and other ranks belonging to the Indian Army, Part I of A.F. W 5153 will be despatched by the embarkation staff officer direct to the India Office.

Part II of all documents of authority will be retained by the embarkation staff.

12. *Disembarkation leave.*

- (a) Whether leave is granted direct from ports or from units, personnel on return from overseas commands will be eligible for leave in accordance with the Leave Manual, 1943, para. 33. Current scales are as follows:—

With less than two years' continuous service abroad	...	...	14 days.
With two years', but less than four years' continuous service abroad	...	...	21 days.
With four years' or more continuous service abroad	...	...	28 days.
- (b) To enable them to dispose of their families married personnel accompanied by their families will be granted their full period of leave direct from port. Free travel is admissible and will count against normal entitlement.
- (c) Disembarkation leave is inadmissible in respect of personnel reverted to the United Kingdom for the purpose of leaving the Service, nor will it be granted additionally where there is already an entitlement, grant or recommendation involving a period of leave of 14 days or longer.

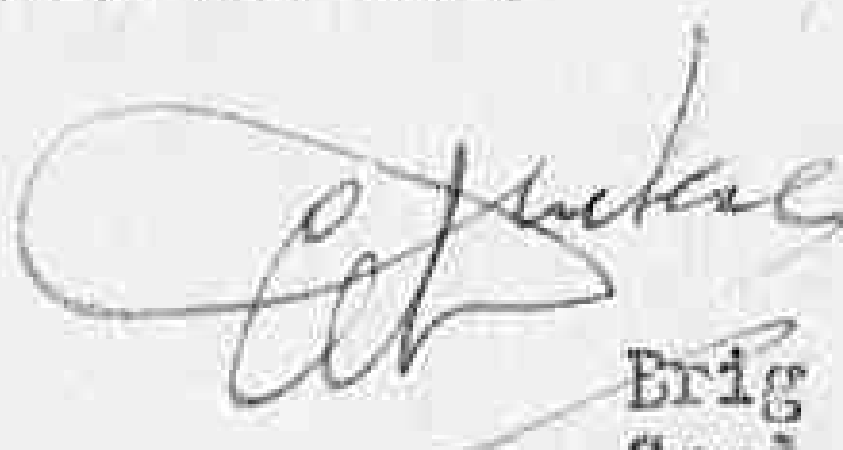

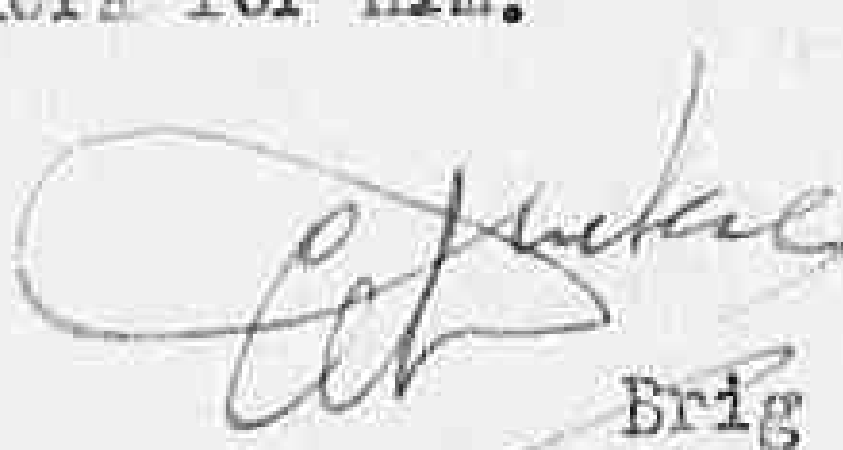

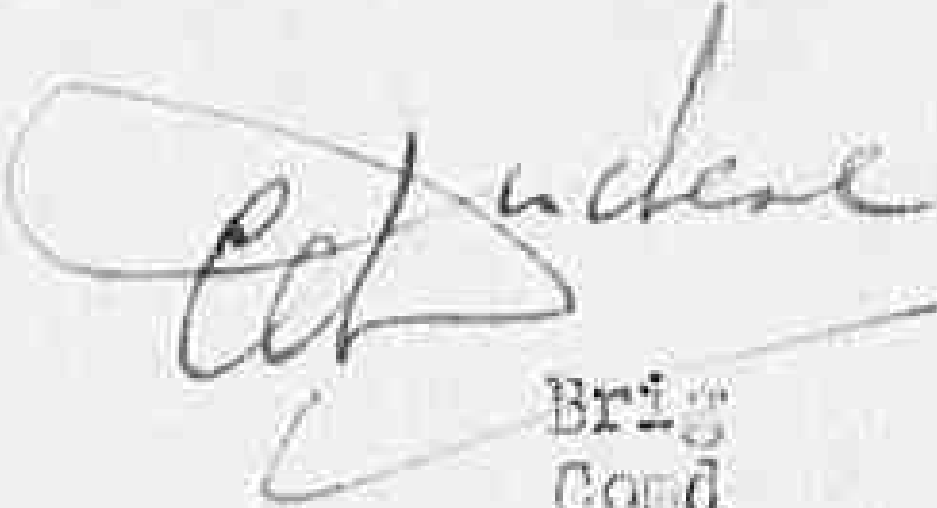

Two or three D.Rs - these may probably be replaced at a later date by Italians, but at the moment we have been unable to get hold of Italian D.Rs - but even if we had got them this method of comm between this HQ and you at Tac Army would be unsatisfactory, as at any time Italian DRs may be stopped by British troops and their M/Cs taken away from them.

I doubt if the Italians could ever be able to provide road-worthy cars for use of the Mission, but it may be that later something may turn up. I consider that they should have on loan say two Jeeps - and if you agree I will leave two Jeeps here when we go.

Brigadier Duchesne will presumably also want a car, I cannot leave one, but could of course supply one in due course from SICILY.
