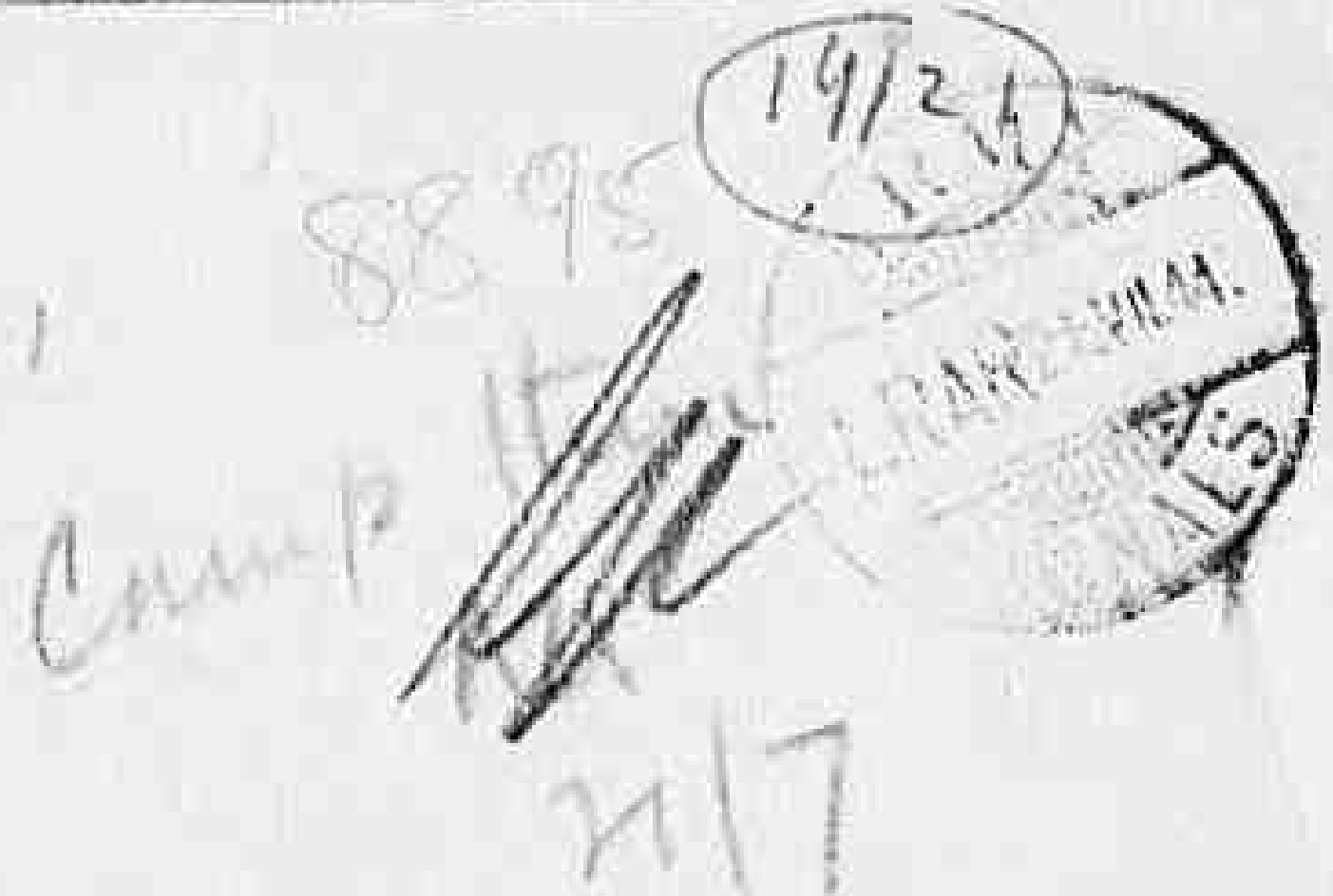

You will be aware of difficulties that are being experienced owing to the extreme seriousness of the existing manpower situation.

In order to ensure the best use of all available personnel, it is essential that every man, whether he be of low medical category for reasons of sickness or wounds sustained in action, or psycho-neurosis as a result of his former service, be employed in the type of employment to which he is best suited.

The purpose of this letter is to ensure that the LMC and PM personnel who are now being posted to the unit under your command receive sympathetic consideration and are not treated as unwanted personnel thrust upon you.

All PMs have undergone a month's training with a view to adjusting their mental outlook. They have been encouraged to feel that they are still useful members of His Majesty's Army and that their services are valuable. They have not been allowed to feel, or given the impression, that they are failures.

In many cases their mental condition has been created because of family troubles. These have been investigated, and in many cases eradicated, with the result that the man's efficiency has greatly increased. It has been proved that if such personnel feel that an interest is being taken in them as individuals, they become enthusiastic soldiers, with a greater determination to prove to the officer or NCO who has given them a helping hand that they are efficient members of that unit.

It has also been proved that where PMs have been made to feel that they are welcome members of their new unit and that their work is essential and valuable, they have proved to be reliable and efficient soldiers. All these factors call for the tactful assistance of both officers and senior NCOs in connection with their mental problems.

Regarding LMC personnel. These soldiers have also to adjust themselves to their new circumstances. In many cases they have been fighting soldiers, a fact of which they are very rightly proud. They do not always take the trouble to analyse for themselves the importance of their new employment,

In many cases their mental condition has been created because of family troubles. These have been investigated, and in many cases eradicated, with the result that the men's efficiency has greatly increased. It has been proved that if such personnel feel that an interest is being taken in them as individuals, they become enthusiastic soldiers, with a greater determination to prove to the officer or NCO who has given them a helping hand that they are efficient members of that unit.

It has also been proved that where PNs have been made to feel that they are welcome members of their new unit and that their work is essential and valuable, they have proved to be reliable and efficient soldiers. All these factors call for the tactful assistance of both officers and senior NCOs in connection with their mental problems.

Regarding LMC personnel. These soldiers have also to adjust themselves to their new circumstances. In many cases they have been fighting soldiers, a fact of which they are very rightly proud. They do not always take the trouble to analyse for themselves the importance of their new employment, and are apt initially to feel some quite unjustifiable sense of inferiority vis-a-vis their late front-line comrades.

Here again they should be made to feel that they are welcome members of their new unit, and that here also there exists that comradeship and esprit de corps which they had formerly known. They must also be made to realise the value which their new employment contributes to the war effort and to the well-being of their former comrades, all of whom are dependent on L of C units.

Before posting, both PNs and LMCs are interviewed by Personnel Selection Staff who assess their qualifications and recommend them for various types of employment. With the exception of General Dutymen, OSC Units must employ men in trades or tasks as recommended by PLS. It has been known that in certain cases men posted to units to perform specific tasks have merely been used as General Dutymen. Naturally as some of these men were probably tradesmen they have tended to develop a low morale.

I am anxious that all PNs and LMC personnel who are now being posted to the Unit under your command shall be given every opportunity to settle down in your unit as efficient soldiers. I look to you to see that no efforts are spared by yourself, your officers and NCOs to ensure that these men are afforded the encouragement and the personal interest which is so necessary to enable them to prove themselves to be efficient members of your unit.

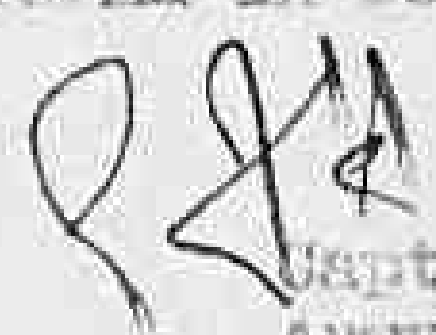

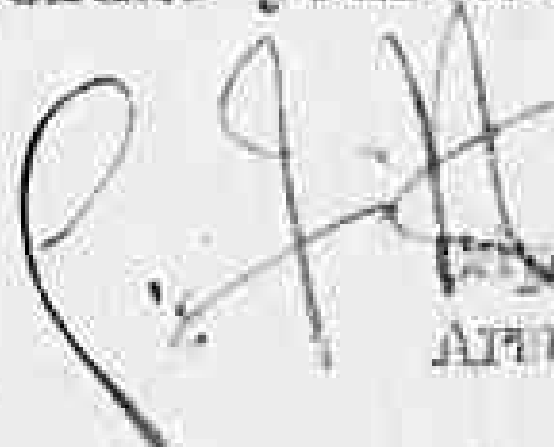

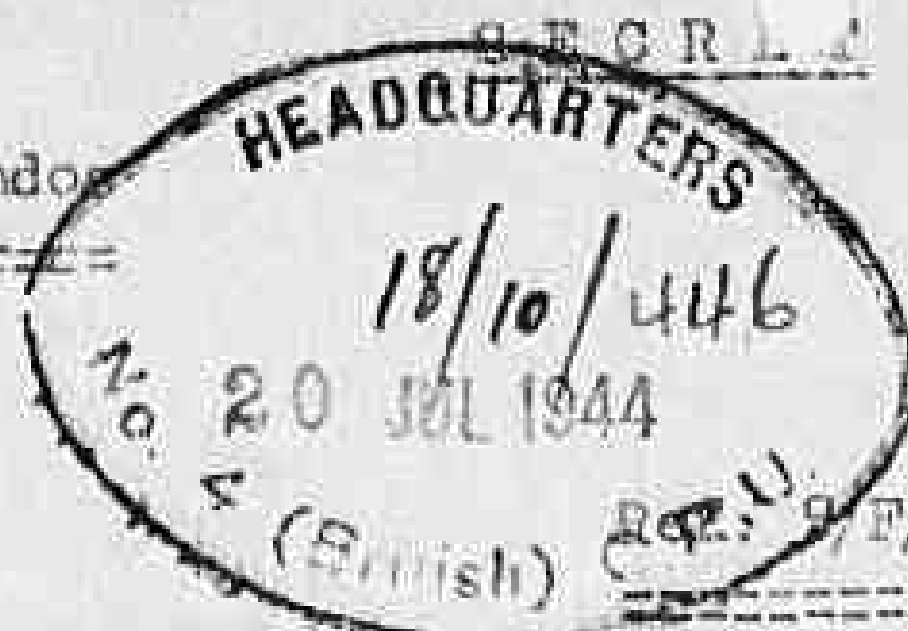

When the Allied Armies in Italy launched the attack on May 11th, the object was twofold:

First: to destroy the German forces opposing us, free Rome and drive the enemy far to the North.

Second: to strike the first blow in the liberation of Europe and give our comrades in arms in the West and in the East a good start by presenting them with a first-class victory.

The first object has been largely achieved. The second has been wholly fulfilled. To you, the soldiers of the Armies in Italy, belongs the honour and glory of this great victory, and I, as your Commander-in-Chief, send to each and every one of you my heartfelt congratulations and deepest appreciation for the magnificent way in which you have carried out your task, and in this hour we do not forget our comrades who have fallen in battle. We honour their name and mourn their loss.

Now we are completing an extensive regrouping in order to bring about the final collapse of the enemy. This is taking place according to plan, and it is my intention to proceed with the second and perhaps final stage of the destruction of the German armed forces in Italy.

These are great days. The Italian campaign has already made history and victory lies clearly ahead of us, but as good and experienced soldiers we know that the path is not an easy one and final success can only be won by fighting for it.

The eyes of the world and the hopes of all at home are upon us—we shall not disappoint them. We shall continue as we have begun to destroy the enemy wherever we find him and to march along the road to the last battles where final victory awaits us.

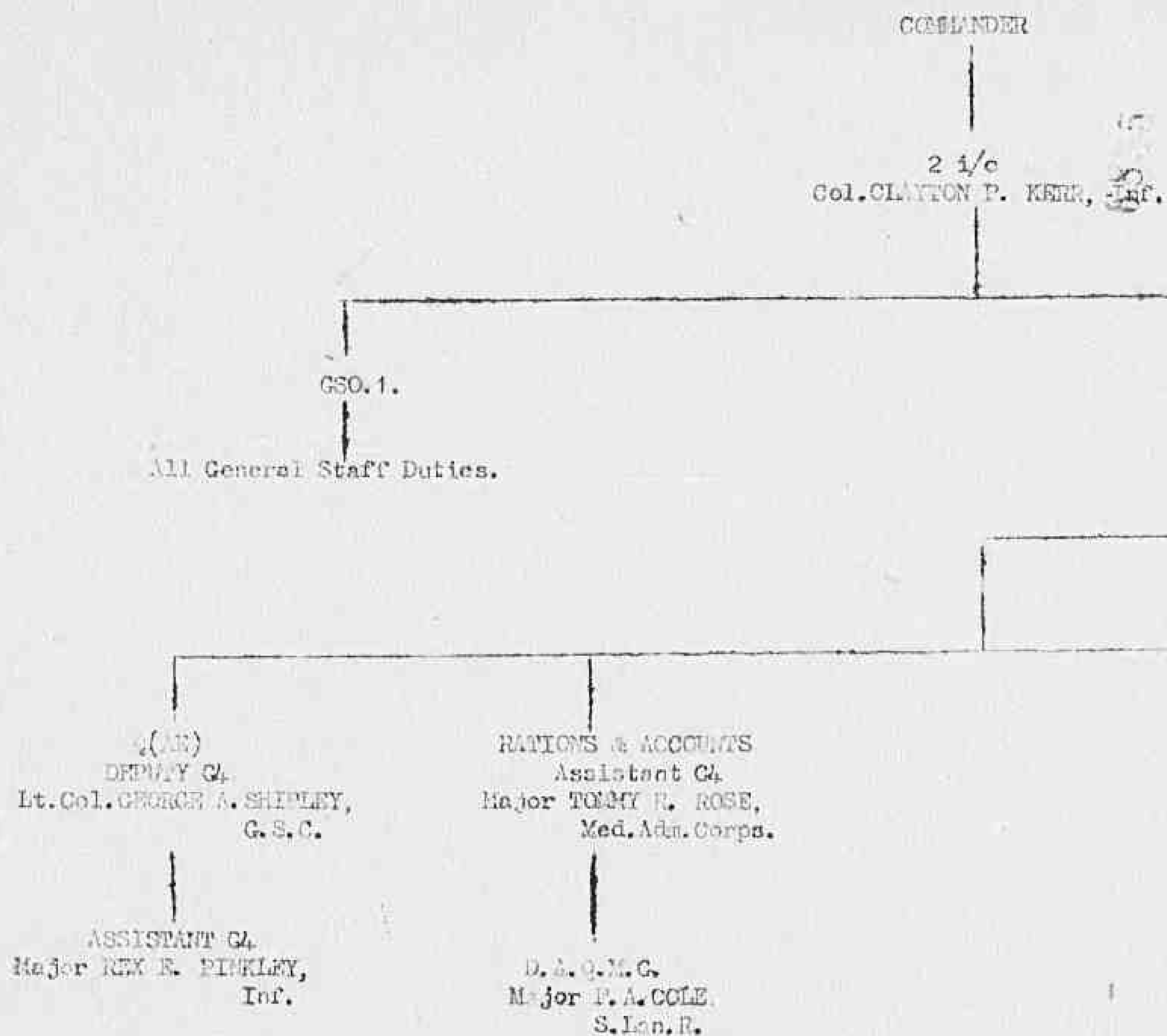

On or about December 28th. 1943 I was posted from 35 Town Major to H.Q. Adv. Rps. H.A.I. and promoted to Cpl. on posting. I have never seen the P.I. II Order showing my promotion to Cpl. (A/V), or to W/Cpl. but P.I. II order posting me to this H.Q. does show me as Cpl.

On Feb. 9th. 1944. I was told by Capt. Marshall of H.Q. Adv. Rps. and the same day by Col. Ellis that I had been promoted to S/Sgt. and posted to this M.M. I.A. in that rank. I was specifically

promoted from 35 Town Major to H.Q. Adv. Rpt. A.A.1. and promoted to Cpl. on posting. I have never seen the Pt. II Order showing my promotion to Cpl. (A/V), to A/Cpl. or to W/Cpl. but Pt. II order posting me to this H.Q. does show me as Cpl.

On Feb. 9th. 1944. I was told by Capt. Marshall of H.Q. Adv. Rpts. and the same day by Col. Ellis that I had been promoted to SpSgt. and posted to this M.M.I.A. in that rank. I was specifically told that I was Travel here wearing the corresponding badges of rank.

My A.B. 64 Pt. I has an entry: "11.2.44 - Staff Sgt." initialed by Capt. Russell, Camp Commandant at H.Q. Adv. Rpt. A.A.1.

My A.B. 64 Pt. II also shows an entry as follows:-

Capt. V/A/S/Sgt. w.e.f. 9.2.44.
Authy: Letter H.Q. Adv. Rpts. AF1/2017 dated 9.2.44 and the entry is also signed by Capt. Russell

In the case of this promotion I have also been unable to see any Pt. II order either for V/A/S/Sgt. promotion or for the

A/Sgt. 21 days later.

On several occasions I have asked the Camp Office to enquire regarding PR-II Orders in order that by Pay book may be brought up to date. I also asked Major Butterworth (then Capt.) and he, himself, requested Camp Office to make enquiries.

Not having had any satisfaction in nearly 4 months I finally decided to write to Capt. Russell direct.

I have now received a reply from this Officer to the effect that casualties for my promotion to Cpl. were duly submitted and certified extract of PR-II Order may be obtained from G.H.Q. Ind. Liaison on application.

As regards promotion to S/Sgt. he states casualties should have been submitted by this H.Q.

I would like to point out the serious shortage of trained cooks at this H.Q. At present we have one A.C.C. Corporal and four Italian labourers working in the cookhouses.

There are 30 Officers and 80 O/Ranks feeding here and they are distributed as under :-

Officers Mess- A. & B. Mess (Two Messes)	30
Sergts Mess	One Cookhouse. 10
O/Ranks Mess.	One Cookhouse. 70

It will be seen that it is impossible for one trained cook to supervise in all cookhouses and cook as well.

The authorised establishment is 7 Cooks, these deficiencies have been reported on A.F. 3000 H. for several weeks without results. I should be glad if this matter could be represented to higher authority with a view of obtaining 6 suitable men and attaching them to a Cookery School to be trained and posted here.
