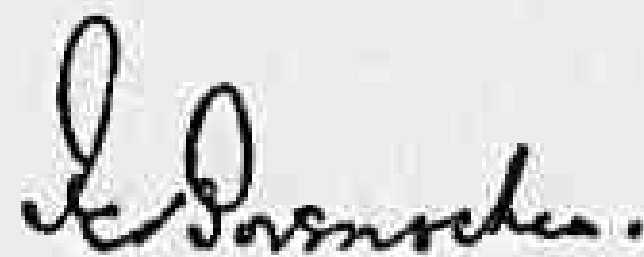

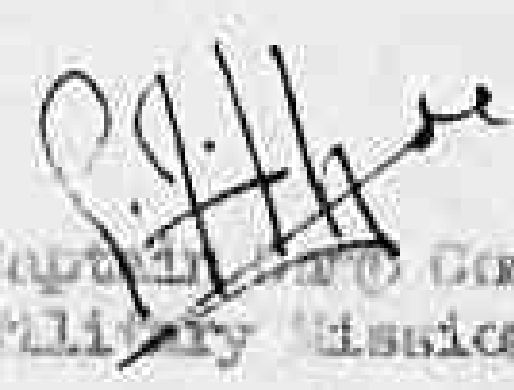

1. Requests for the cessation of Family Allowance on estrangement cannot be accepted unless

A. Reconciliation has been attempted through S.S.A.F.A. and the soldier's decision has been made after being informed of the contents of the S.S.A.F.A. report.

or B. Definite instructions for the institution of Divorce Proceedings have been given, or, where the case is being dealt with through Legal Aid Section, that authority has approved the application.

2. Application *related, then great name, address* *must be* by a

A.F.A. report and under both paras 1a and 1b by the soldier's signed statement as under:

"I hereby request that Family Allowance in issue to my wife ..... be withdrawn. I understand my liabilities under Para. 5 A.C.I. 437/44 and do not wish to avail myself of the provisions of A.C.I. 189/43".

3. The soldier's liability under para. 5 A.C.I. 437/44 is that the withdrawal of Family allowance does not absolve him from his liability to contribute to the maintenance of his family and that he may be placed under stoppages of pay by the Competent Military Authority.

4. The provisions of A.C.I. 189/43 are inter alia, that Family Allowance may remain in issue after estrangement (but not beyond the date of a Decree Absolute) providing the soldier is willing to contribute the appropriate Qualifying Amount.

5. Where there are children of the marriage (if there are none this should be stated) the following alternatives are available.

- If they are in the care of a person other than his wife, the soldier may nominate that person as guardian and Guardian Allowance will be issued.
- If the soldier is willing for the children to remain with his wife, her or Children Allowance plus appropriate Qualifying Allowance may be paid direct to his wife or through a representative of S.S.A.F.A. who will ensure that the allowance is properly expended.

5. Where there are children of the marriage (if there are none this should be stated) the following alternatives are available.

A. If they are in the care of a person other than his wife, the soldier may nominate that person as guardian and Children Allowance will be issued.

B. If the soldier is willing for the children to remain with his wife, normal Children Allowance plus appropriate qualifying allotment may be paid direct to his wife or through a representative of S.S.A.F.A. who will ensure that the allowance is properly expended.

A.P. 04700-2 must be submitted for action under Rules 5A and 5B.

6. A.P. 64 Part II must not be amended until confirmation is received from the Regional Paymaster as the withdrawal of Family Allowance is not now effected until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date of receipt of the application by the S.P. or a decision is reached by the competent Military Authority on the enforcement of a Compulsory Stoppage against the soldier, whichever is the earlier.

7. It is emphasized that the object of A.O.I. 457/84 is to avoid as far as possible the break up of homes through insufficient cause and to give the soldier every opportunity of having an impartial review before making a decision. Advantage should therefore be taken of the facilities offered by S.S.A.F.A.

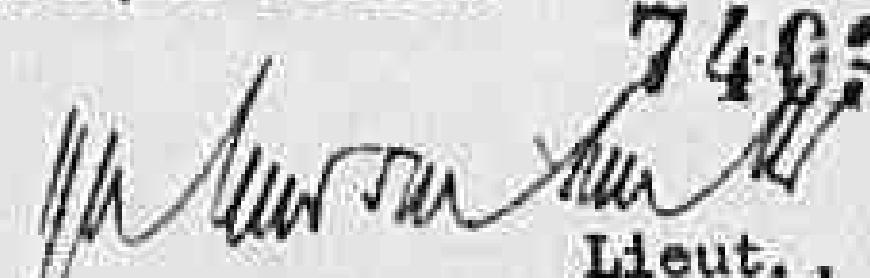

1. Although the normal unit practice is to issue the pay of soldiers weekly in arrear, the experiment has in the past been tried, successfully, of making the normal payments fortnightly instead of weekly.
2. This results in the following advantages and economies:-
  - (a) A considerable saving in clerical work in unit and Paymasters' offices.
  - (b) A considerable saving of stationery (Acquittance Rolls, etc).
  - (c) A reduction in the total weight of pay documents which are sent to the UK.
3. It is not considered that the system of fortnightly pay can be introduced as an invariable practice. Its introduction in any unit must be dependent on the wishes of the men themselves, and it is clear that when a unit is out of the line men may wish to be paid more frequently. Furthermore, casual payments such as those for men going on leave will always be necessary.
4. It is requested that consideration may be given to the advantages of fortnightly pay with a view, subject to the factors mentioned in para 3 above, to the introduction of this practice in ~~the~~ unit/formation under your command.
