POSTING TO HOME ESTABLISHMENT

To all British Units in B.N.A.F. and C.M.F.

To be read by all Ranks with $4\frac{1}{2}$ years or more continuous service Overseas

I realise and sympathise with the anxiety of those who have been abroad a long time and who want to know what the prospects are of their getting home. As there is some misunderstanding on this subject, I will try to make the situation clear in this letter which I address to all ranks of the British Army under my command.

I will begin by warning you that I cannot make promises or give guarantees because in War the defeat of the enemy comes first and, if need be, other considerations must give way to that primary task.

At one time the chief factor which limited the numbers that could be sent home was the shortage of shipping. Up till very recently, owing to the uneconomical voyage that our convoys had to make round the Cape, and to the heavy losses that were being inflicted on them by the « U » Boats, shipping throughout the world was very scarce. Every available ship coming from the United Kingdom was needed to keep our forces overseas up to strength and there was seldom any space left over for replacements for those sent home on the grounds of long service overseas. It was for this reason that up to October, 1943, only those who had served overseas for more than six years could be sent home.

In October, 1943 more shipping became available owing chiefly to the opening of the Mediterranean, and shipping space ceased to be the limiting factor. An exchange scheme on a man for man basis between B.N.A.F. and the United Kingdom, known as the « Python » scheme, was started in that month with a qualifying period of five years and nine months. By January 1944 it was possible to reduce it to five years, but eligibility was based on five years overseas service before 1st January 1944. This meant for example that a soldier who completed 5 years continuous overseas service in July 1944 would not be eligible for posting home until January 1945. I have recently decided that during 1944 a soldier shall be eligible for posting home during the month he completes 5 years continuous overseas service. This is a step in the right direction. I had hoped to reduce the qualifying period still further, but a new factor has for the time being prevented this; it is that every available man is now needed at Home for the invasion of the Continent, and very few are available for exchange under the Python scheme. If during 1944 the qualifying period was reduced to $4\frac{1}{2}$ years the numbers to be sent home would be 7,500 and if reduced to 4 or $3\frac{1}{2}$ years the numbers would be increased 16,000 or 30,000 respectively. You will understand that to send such numbers home without replacements is impossible under existing operational conditions. Even by introducing the new method of reckoning based on 5 years overseas service I shall be short of replacements during 1944 as more men will be going home under the Python scheme than are available as replacements from the United Kingdom.

Comparisons are often made between the length of overseas service in the Army, with that in the Royal Navy and the Royal Air Force. The reason for this difference lies not in preferential treatment of one Service over another but in hard realities; the numbers serving overseas in the Army exceed by many times those serving in the Royal Navy and the Royal Air Force. A repatriation scheme which in the case of the other Services might involve a few hundreds of men would, in the case of the Army, involve numbers which could not possibly be sent home or replaced over an equivalent period. The effect of reducing the qualifying period for the Army to the same level as that of the R.A.F. (married men three years: unmarried men four years) would be to increase the numbers qualifying for repatriation at once to 16,000. The numbers that would immediately qualify if the Army were to adopt the Royal Navy's ruling period of $2\frac{1}{2}$ years would be 36,000. It is clear therefore that to bring the Army on to the same qualifying periods as the Royal Navy or the R.A.F. is impossible at present.

I have explained the situation at length in order that you may understand the problems involved, and I have purposely avoided presenting an over-optimistic picture of the future. The question of reducing the period of continuous overseas service is, however, one that I have constantly in mind, and as soon as it becomes possible to increase the homeward flow I shall reduce the qualifying period as much as possible. I promise you that.

Nothing that I have written above affects the existing scheme for compassionate posting to the Home Establishment, which will continue as before, but here again every man who goes home is a dead loss as no replacements are available.

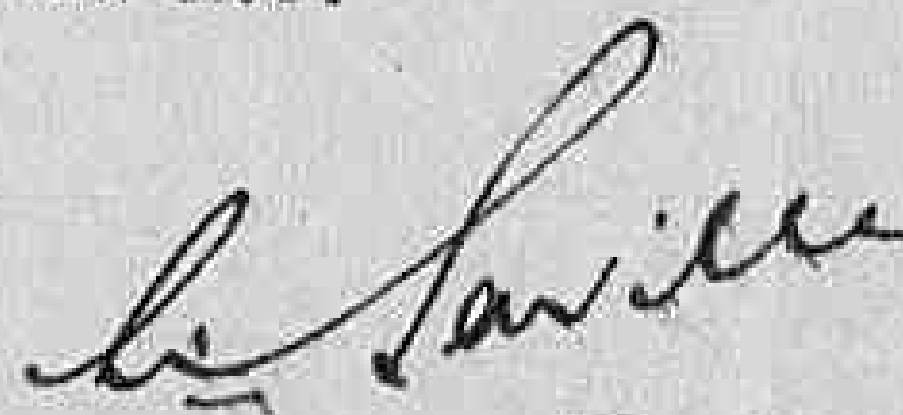

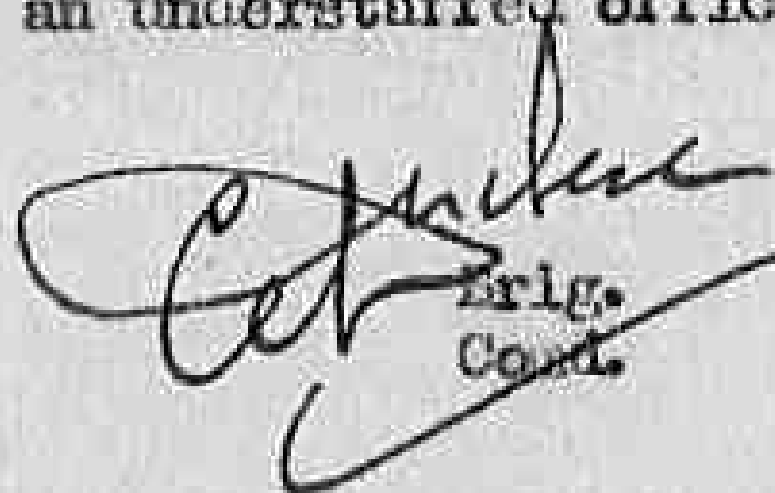

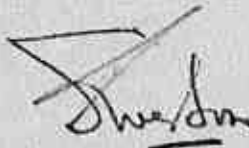
